2. The grounds stated are: (1) the applicant is illiterate and (2) the applicant is poor. Poverty and illiteracy are no grounds for condoning the delay.

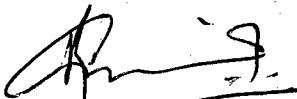
3. In the M.A. it is stated that "As a matter of fact the O.A. ought to have filed on 10.10.1998, but it could file the O.A. only today i.e. 19.11.1999". Thus the O.A. was not filed on 19.11.99 but only on 18.1.2000. The statement made in the M.A. is factually incorrect.

4. The Tribunals and Courts have no power to extend the period of limitation on equitable grounds. So also the Tribunal cannot confer benediction impelled by sympathetic considerations.

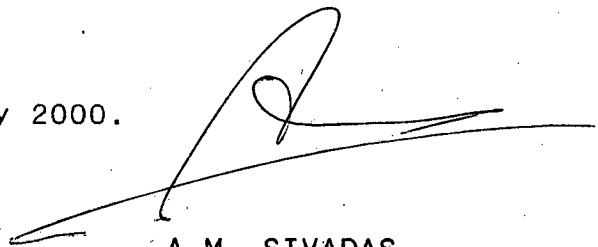
5. M.A. is accordingly dismissed.
