Reserve Trained Pool Postal Assistants in the


Malappuram Postal Division is to direct the

Respondents 1 to 3 to appoint them in the existing vacancies of the Postal Assistant in the Malappuram Postal Division. It was submitted by Advocate Mr K.Karthikeya Panicker, ACGSC appearing on behalf of the Respondents 1 to 3 that as and when vacancies arise in Malappuram Postal Division, the applicants will be appointed as Postal Assistants in preference to outsiders. We record this submission.

2 It is pointed out by the Counsel of Applicants that even at present there are existing vacancies. The Respondents 1 to 3 will consider the question of appointing the applicants in case vacancies exist as stated.

3 Since the 4th Respondent has already been appointed, in case the applicants are appointed the interse seniority as between the 4th Respondent on the one hand, and the applicants on the other shall be determined for which this order will be no bar.
