O R D E R

HON'BLE MR A.V. HARIDASAN, VICE CHAIRMAN

The applicant has applied for selection to the post of Extra Departmental Branch Postmaster, Kalaparamba Post Office alongwith other candidates sponsored by the employment exchange. Her candidature has been rejected by the respondents on the ground of non-sponsorship by the employment exchange. She has, therefore, filed this application for a direction to the respondents to consider her candidature also for selection and appointment to the post of Extra Departmental Branch Postmaster, Kalaparamba Post office though her name has not been sponsored by the employment exchange.

2. When the application came up for hearing today, learned counsel for the respondents submits that in view




of the Supreme Court ruling in Excise Supdt., Malkapatnam, Krishna Dist., A.P. Vs. KBN Visweswara Rao & Ors. reported in 1996 (6) SCC 216, the respondents would consider the candidature of the applicant also for selection and appointment to the post of Extra Departmental Branch Postmaster, Kalparamba P.O. without her name being sponsored by the employment exchange.

3. In the light of what is stated above, this application is disposed of, directing the respondents to consider the candidature of the applicant also for selection and appointment to the post of Extra Departmental Branch Postmaster, Kalparamba P.O. without the employment sponsorship.
