Tribunal on the same day delivered the following:

ORDER

HON'BLE MR AM SIVADAS, JUDICIAL MEMBER

The applicant seeks to declare that he is entitled to reckon 50% of his casual labour service for the period from 2.12.61 to 1.4.73 as qualifying for pensionary benefits and to direct the respondents to recalculate and pay him the pension and other retiral benefits accordingly including arrears.

2. , When the O.A. was taken up, the learned counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that it is suffice to permit the applicant to submit a representation to the 3rd respondent for redressal of his grievance. The learned counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that there is no objection in adopting such a course.


