HON'BLE MRS SATHI NAIR, VICE CHAIRMAN.


The relief sought in the application is to permit the applicant to apply for the post of Postal Assistant/Sorting Assistant ^{selection for which was} scheduled to be held on 12.5.2002. The respondents filed their reply stating that the applicant is a Gramin Dak Sevak Sub Postmaster working at Pallichal Post Office and he was not a Departmental Lower Grade Official. The examination held was for promotion of Lower Grade officials of the department like Postmen and Group-D officials as Postal Assistant. Being a Gramin Dak Sevak, the

applicant was not eligible to take the particular examination and therefore his application was not considered. On various dates of hearing fixed the applicant has not been represented. The O.A was filed on 3.5.2002 and the relief sought in the application has become infructuous in view of the reply filed by the respondents. The O.A is dismissed.
