


Applicant submits that he is entitled to continue as a Khalasi. He also seeks to restrain respondents from posting him out of that category, as a Gangman.

2. Mr K Karthikeya Panicker, learned Counsel for Railways, submitted that the "decasualised posts" will be filled up only by appointing Khalasis, according to their seniority, and not by inducting Gangmen. We record the submission. In the light of this, the apprehension of applicant is unreasonable.
