ORDER



Applicant is aspiring for the post of EDDA, Vellora Post Office, pursuant to notification published in the Mathrubhoomi daily on 24.2.94 inviting applications from eligible candidates for selection and appointment to the above post. The applicant was not considered by the respondents. Hence, he filed this application under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act mainly for a direction to the respondents to consider him also in the regular selection to the post of EDDA, Vellora Post Office, taking into consideration his prior service in the same Post Office as provisional EDMC w.e.f. 1.2.91 till 31.7.92.

2. We have heard the learned counsel for respondents also at the admission stage. After hearing the learned counsel for both sides, we are satisfied that the application can be disposed of with directions. Accordingly, we admit the application and dispose of the same directing first respondent to consider applicant also in the regular selection to the post of EDDA, Vellora Post Office, along with other candidates sponsored by the Employment Exchange. It goes without saying that the applicant is entitled to weightage for his past service, if he is eligible for the same in accordance with law, while considering him in the regular selection as directed above.

3. The application is disposed of as above. There will be no order as to costs.
