After the matter was argued at length, learned counsel for applicants submitted that applicants would be satisfied if representations, to be made by them, are considered by the second respondent. We direct second respondent to consider the representations and pass appropriate orders thereon within three months from the date of receipt of the representations, if representations are made within three weeks of today.

2. We make it clear that we have not examined the question of limitation or tenability of the claims. The aforesaid direction will not give a fresh cause of action to applicants nor take the applicants out of the operation of the rule in S.S. Rathore vs. State of Madhya Pradesh, AIR 1990 SC 10.

3. Application is disposed of as aforesaid. No costs.
