


Applicant challenges A2 rejecting his request for engaging him as a Casual Driver. Respondents found that his casual engagement commenced on 16.7.90 and that inspite of 214 days of experience

(after 1.4.85), he was not eligible for appointment. By judgement in OA-1402/93 and connected cases, we have directed the Department to prepare a panel of casual employees for future engagement after inviting claims. Applicant will be free to raise his claims and seek inclusion. We see no justification for entertaining this application.

2. We dismiss the application. No costs.
