Madhya Ganga Mandal-Pratham (Mukhyalaya) Kendriya Jal Ayog, Lucknow to Paliakalan Sthal (Madhya Ganga Mandal-Pratham) with all consequential benefits. At this stage, the learned counsel for respondents has filed a copy of the order dated 13.08.2008 issued by Respondent No.3, stating that the transfer order of the applicant covered under Annexure-A-1 Dt. 05.06.2006 has been cancelled and the same has been recorded. In view of the cancellation of the impugned transfer order of the applicant covered under Annexure-8 Dt. 13.08.2008, the OA has become infructuous.
