The order does not show the application of mind and on what factors the applicant's case has not been found apt for consideration and grant of compassionate appointment., the basis has not been reflected. It is trite that any order passed by the Govt. where consideration takes place cannot be supplemented by a reply filed in the O.A. This O.A. is partly allowed. Impugned order is set aside. The respondents are directed to reconsider the claim of the applicant for compassionate appointment by speaking order to be passed within a period of two months from the date of receipt of this order.
