
Heard. Reply has been filed today itself on behalf of Opposite Party No. 1 saying that all the needful has been done on behalf of the Director (Pension), State of U.P. which is taken on record. The perusal of the order in question reveals that there was a direction in respect of revised pension/family pension which has been complied with by Respondent No. 4. Sri Surendran P., learned counsel for the applicant says that arrears of leave encashment be also paid to him.
