By means of this application, the applicant has prayed that a direction may be issued to the respondents to permit him appear in Civil Service Examination, 1992. The interim order was granted on 31.1.1992 to appear in the examination if he has not exceeded the age of 33 years on 01.1.91 and the forms shall also be given to him.

2. From the short counter affidavit, it appears that on 1st August, 1992, the age of the applicant is 33 years two months. As such he could not appear in the examination. Accordingly, this application has become infructuous and is dismissed as such, and is not necessary to adjudicate the pleas in the case.



1. By means of this application, it has been prayed that a direction may be issued to the respondent No.2 to accept application of the petitioner for the Civil Services Examination, 1992 irrespective of the prescribed upper age limit and to permit him to appear in the examination.

2. The interim order was granted on 31.1.92 to entertain the application and to allow the applicant to appear in the Civil Services Examination without prejudice if he has not crossed the age of 33 years on 1.8.92.

3. On 1-8-92, the applicant has attained the age of 33 years, 2 months and 23 days. This application, accordingly, has become infructuous and is dismissed at this stage.
