BY HON'BLE SHRI S.P. ARYA, MEMBER (A)


The present Review Application has been filed by the respondent in O.A. No. 558/99 against the judgement and order dated 19.11.2003 passed in O.A. No. 558/99.

2. Since no hearing is considered necessary, the present review application is being disposed of under circulation rules.

3. We have gone through the review application and found that no mistake apparent from record has been pointed out in the order dated 19.11.2003 passed in O.A. no. 558/99. The scope of a review application, as defined, in the order XLVII of the CPC, is very limited and is confined only to rectification of mistakes apparent from record. While delivering the judgement, both the parties were duly heard, because the judgement was given orally, as such Review Application has no merit. Reassessment of evidence and rewriting of judgement is not possible while disposing of Review Application. Since no mistake apparent from record has been pointed out,
