The applicant complains in this contempt application is that the order dated 28.12.1990 in O.A. No. 419 of 1990 the tribunal directed the respondents to declare the result of Scientist Selection Grade-III and to dispose of the representation dated 31.7.1990 with speaking order and to consider the applicant for the post of Scientist Selection Grade IV, if eligible, in accordance with the rules, and further directed to settle the dues, if any, of the applicant before his retirement. In the order no time for compliance is mentioned.

2. It appears that the matter was delayed at the level of the respondents. It may be that they took benefit of absence of any period in the order. In the counter-affidavit it has been stated that the order of the tribunal has been complied with. It has been stated that the result of Scientist Selection has been declared on 22.5.1989 and in the absence of any specific instructions from the Tribunal, therefore, the respondents could not be held liable to the applicant as it has been communicated only
