

This is a Review Application in context of the  
OA No. 374/96 which was dismissed as totally time barred  
and non maintainable at the admission stage itself.

2. The agitation in the OA was regarding the  
selection of EDDA made as far back as 18.12.92. Though  
it was a DB matter, it was placed before a Single Bench in  
view of the urgency involved as per the request of the  
counsel for the applicant. The learned counsel for the  
applicant at no point of time during the admission stage  
stated that this matter be remitted to a DB if the Single

Member Bench was not inclined to admit it or grant any interim relief therein. In any case, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in a recent judgment has held that there is no inherent lack of power in a Single Bench to dispose of any matter which is within the jurisdiction of the Tribunal. However, in case the learned counsel for the applicant had canvassed that this matter should be put up before an appropriate DB for admission purposes, there could not have been any difficulty in this regard. However, the same plea has been take up now. The RA is allowed accordingly. Let the matter be put up before an appropriate DB for admission afresh. The RA is disposed of accordingly.
