1. That the above writ petition is directed against the notice dated 19.3.1985 issued from the office of the Divisional Railway Manager, Lucknow, to the Divisional Superintending Engineer (Coordination), Northern Railway, Lucknow, Senior Civil Engineer (Construction), Lucknow and Assistant Engineer, Faizabad and Banaras to direct the petitioner concerned working under them to appear in the written suitability test on 1.4.1985 in Divisional Railway Manager's office, Lucknow, for their regularisation as Draughtsman in the grade of Rs.330-560 (Revised Scale).

2. That the aforesaid notice was received by Asharfi Lal, petitioner No.1, working under the Assistant Engineer at Faizabad on 26.3.1985 and it was also served on Suresh Kumar working under the Assistant Engineer at Banaras on the same date, i.e., 26.3.1985. It has, however, not been served on the other three petitioners, namely, Sunil Kumar Shukla, Ajay Kumar Singh and Vishnu Kumar Gupta. They derived knowledge of the said notice on 27.3.1985 from Asharfi Lal and Suresh Kumar. The said notice was neither served nor circulated or got noted by the petitioners Sunil Kumar Shukla, Ajay Kumar Singh and Vishnu Kumar Gupta officially through the Divisional





3. That in the aforesaid notice all the petitioners have been wrongly referred to as Tracers. However, it is indicated in brackets that the petitioners are now working as Senior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.425-700. They have been required to appear in the written suitability test for their regularisation as Draughtsmen grade Rs.330-560. This is wholly illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction for the facts and circumstances indicated hereinafter. A true copy of the notice dated 19.3.1985 is filed as Annexure No.1 to this writ petition.

Annexure No.1

4. That petitioner No.1, Asharfi Lal, was appointed as Tracer on 24.12.1973 in the grade of Rs.260-430 (RS). He was thereafter promoted as Junior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.330-560 on 24.6.1980. He was promoted after due assessment of his suitability on the basis of his service record and confidential report by the Divisional Senior Engineer Hqrs. on 9.6.1980. The promotion was also approved by the Senior Divisional Personnel Officer on 10.6.1980.

5. That Sunil Kumar Shukla, petitioner No.3, was appointed as Tracer on 14.4.1975 in the grade of Rs.260-430 (RS) and was thereafter promoted as Junior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.330-560 on 27.6.1980. Ajay Kumar Singh, petitioner No.4, was appointed as Tracer on 1.4.1975 in the grade Rs.260-430 and was

thereafter promoted as Junior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.330-560 on 27.6.1980. <sup>Both</sup> ~~Although~~ Sunil Kumar Shukla and Ajay Kumar Singh were found fit after assessment of their suitability on the basis of their service record and confidential record by the Divisional Senior Engineer on 2.7.1980. Their promotion was approved by Senior Divisional Personnel Officer on 7.7.1980.

6. That Suresh Kumar, petitioner No.5, was appointed Tracer on 14.9.1979 in the grade Rs.260-430. He was thereafter promoted as Junior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.330-560 on 4.2.1981. On the basis of suitability test and confidential report he was found fit for promotion by Senior Divisional Engineer on 17.3.81 and his promotion was approved by the Divisional Personnel Officer on 17.3.1981.

7. That the aforesaid petitioners, namely, Asharfi Lal, Sunil Kumar Shukla, Ajay Kumar Singh and Suresh Kumar were brought on the provisional seniority list of the staff of Drawing Section issued by the Divisional Railway Manager, Lucknow, dated 21.5.1982. These petitioners are shown to be working on the post of Junior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.330-560 in the said seniority list at Sl. Nos. 26, 27, 28 and 29 respectively. A photostat copy of the seniority list dated 21.5.1982 issued by the DRM is filed as Annexure No.2 to this writ petition.

Annexure No.2

8. That Vishnu Kumar Gupta, petitioner No.2, was appointed as Tracer on 29.3.1975 and is working

in the Dy. Chief Engineer's office, Lucknow, and has his lien in the Lucknow Division. When persons junior to him were promoted as Junior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.330-560 and thereafter as Senior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.425-700 the petitioner No.2 made a representation to the Divisional Railway Manager, Lucknow, opposite party No.2. This representation was allowed and he was ordered to be regularised on the recommendation of the Senior Civil Engineer (Construction), Northern Railway, Lucknow on the basis of his satisfactory work. On the basis of assessment of suitability and satisfactory work by the Senior Civil Engineer on 2.7.1984 the petitioner was promoted and regularised as Senior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.425-700 by the order of the Chief Engineer (Construction) dated 5.9.1984. A true copy of the order dated 5.9.1984 of the Chief Engineer (Construction) Hqrs. office Delhi is filed as Annexure No.3 to this writ petition. The letter of recommendation of the Senior Civil Engineer (Construction) dated 2.7.1984, which is the basis of promotion of petitioner No.2 as Senior Draughtsman, is filed as Annexure No.4 to this writ petition.

9. That Asharfi Lal, petitioner No.1, was promoted as officiating Senior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.425-700 on 18.9.1982. Sunil Kumar Shukla, petitioner No.3, was promoted as officiating Senior Draughtsman in grade Rs.425-700 on 25.9.1982. Ajay Kumar Singh, petitioner No.4, was promoted as offi-

ciating Senior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.425-700 on 10.10.1983.

10. That on the basis of their suitability and satisfactory work Asharfi Lal and Sunil Kumar Shukla according to the seniority were regularised from the date of their promotion as Senior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.425-700 by the order of the Divisional Railway Manager, Lucknow, as circulated by notice dated 22.4.1983. A photostat copy of the said notice dated 22.4.1983 issued by the Divisional Office is filed as Annexure No.5 to this writ petition.

Annexure No.5

11. That Ajay Kumar Singh, petitioner No.4, was likewise regularised as Senior Draughtsman on 29.12.1984.

12. That for the purpose of selection to the post of Chief Draughtsman (Civil) in the grade of Rs.700-900(RS) an approved copy of seniority list of Head Draughtsmen in the grade of Rs.550-750 (RS) and Senior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.425-700 (RS) working in the above mentioned grades in regular measure in Lucknow Division as on 1.1.1984 was furnished from the office of opposite party No.2 to the General Manager (Personnel), Northern Railway, New Delhi. According to the said seniority list the petitioners, namely, Asharfi Lal, Vishnu Kumar Gupta, Sunil Kumar Shukla and Ajay Kumar Singh are shown respectively at serial nos. 20, 21, 22 and 23. A photostat copy of the letter dated 29.12.1984 along

with seniority list of regularised Head Draughtsmen and Senior Draughtsmen is filed as Annexure No.6 to this writ petition.

13. That Suresh Kumar, petitioner No.5, is still working as Junior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.330-560. He has been duly regularised on that post. But according to his seniority position he has not been promoted as Senior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.425-700 as in the case of petitioners 1 to 4.

14. That as already indicated above, the notice for the written suitability test of Tracers dated 19.3.1985 wrongly mentions Suresh Kumar, petitioner No.5, as working on the post of Senior Draughtsman grade Rs.425-700.

15. That there is no provision for written suitability test of tracers. The basis for promotion to the next higher grade of Junior Draughtsmen is seniority-cum-suitability. The suitability is to be assessed on the basis of the work as evident from the service record including confidential report by the authority concerned under whom the employee is working. All the petitioners were accordingly tested for suitability on the basis of assessment of their work as evident from the service record and confidential report by a competent authority and were also approved for promotion on the basis of this assessment by the Senior Divisional Personnel

Officer. The petitioners having thus been tested for suitability and found fit for promotion were duly promoted to the next higher grade of Junior Draughtsmen where they continued to work satisfactorily. Petitioner Nos. 1, 3 and 4, namely, Asharfi Lal, Sunil Kumar Shukla and Ajay Kumar Singh, were thereafter promoted as Senior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.425-700 respectively on 18.9.1982, 25.9.1982 and 10.10.1983 and subsequently regularised as Senior Draughtsmen respectively on 22.4.1983, 22.4.1983 and 29.12.1984. Vishnu Kumar Gupta on the basis of the representation and the recommendation of the Civil Engineer (Construction) Lucknow was assessed for his suitability and his work having been found satisfactory was recommended for promotion as Junior Draughtsman as well as Senior Draughtsman in grade Rs.425-700 by the Civil Engineer (Construction) under whom he is working. On the basis of this recommendation Vishnu Kumar Gupta by the order of the Chief Engineer (Construction) Delhi was given regular promotion as Senior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.425-700.

16. That the requirement of the petitioners to appear in the written suitability test of Tracers is, therefore, wholly arbitrary and without jurisdiction as petitioners Sunil Kumar Shukla, Ajay Kumar Singh and Vishnu Kumar Gupta, although posted at Lucknow, have so far not received any notice of the written suitability test to be held on 1.4.1985.

17. That the aforesaid notice dated 19.3.1985 implies double reversion of the petitioners 1 to 4 from the post of regular Senior Draughtsmen in the grade Rs.425-700, on which they are ~~provisionally~~ <sup>presently</sup> working, to that of Tracers in the grade Rs.260-430 on which they were originally appointed and in the case of petitioner No.5 it amounts to reversion from the post of Junior Draughtsman in the grade Rs.330-560, on which he has been regularised after being duly assessed and tested for suitability. No notice to show cause whatsoever was ever given to any of the petitioners before the aforesaid notice dated 19.3.1985 to appear in the written suitability test of Tracers. The said notice is, therefore, wholly arbitrary and malafide and in violation of the principles of natural justice.

18. That the petitioners having already found suitable by the competent authority and having been promoted from the post of Tracers to the next higher grades cannot be forced to appear in the written suitability test on 1.4.1985.

19. That aggrieved by the notice dated 19.3.1985 directing the petitioners to appear in the written suitability test of Tracers on 1.4.1985 and having no alternative efficacious and speedy remedy available to them, the petitioners have preferred this writ petition on the following amongst other :-

G R O U N D S

- (A) Because the notice dated 19.3.1985 is wholly illegal, arbitrary and without jurisdiction.
- (B) Because the said notice implies double reversion of the petitioners from the post of regular senior Draughtsmen, on which petitioners 1 to 4 are working, to the post of Tracers, on which they were originally appointed.
- (C) Because the aforesaid direction to appear in the written suitability test of Tracers is wholly arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice inasmuch as no notice to show cause whatsoever was given to them before their reversion to the post of Tracers on which they were originally appointed.
- (D) Because no notice of the said written suitability test on 1.4.1985 has been served on petitioner Nos. 2, 3 and 4.
- (E) Because the notice is wholly malafide as the notice period for the written suitability test is extremely short and inadequate.


WHEREFORE it is most respectfully prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to :-




