O R D E R (Oral)

M.P.No.774/2000 for condonation of delay is
granted. Delay in filing the O.A. is condoned.

2. Applicants who are Group 'D' employees of the
Western Railway have challenged the seniority lists
prepared and published on 16.6.1998, 10.9.1999 and
27.9.1999 as being arbitrary and illegal. A direction is
sought to prepare a seniority list covering both the
disciplines of Khalasis working in Carriage and Electrical
Units.

3. Heard Shri R.D. Deharia, the learned counsel
appearing for the applicants and Shri V.S. Masurkar, the
learned counsel appearing for Respondents No.1 to 3. On




application made by Shri Deharia, respondents No.4 to 19 are deleted.

4. In respect of the seniority lists which are impugned, this is what has been stated by and on behalf of the respondents:—


"9. With reference to paragraph 4.2 of the application, as per the decision taken in Joint Meeting of Both the Recognised Unions on 14th Sept, 1994, it has been unanimously decided for merger of Khalasis working in the Carriage and Electrical Units. That cut off date as 3rd August, 1990. Accordingly the seniority of Khalasis appointed after the cut off date is maintained separately and therefore the promotion also be made according to the decision taken in Joint Meeting after exhausting of 44 Helpers of both the Unions. Further the seniority of Electric Unit has also been published on 10.9.99".


5. Aforesaid averments, as we can fathom seek to imply that Khalasis, both working in the Carriage Unit as also working in the Electrical Unit have been sought to be merged. So far so good. However, what has been sought to be done thereafter is difficult to fathom. Similarly, how different seniority lists which are prepared are to be worked out for ^{the} purpose of granting promotions etc. is also difficult to fathom. The simplest way of merging the two units is to prepare a combined seniority list in respect of all Khalasis working in both the units. Such a seniority list be prepared without ^{fixing} ~~offering~~ any cut



off date as has been sought to done in the present case. The seniority list be prepared strictly on the basis of the date of joining of each of the Khalasis in both the units. We order accordingly. Aforesaid exercise be completed within a period of three months from the date of service of this order. It follows without saying that the trade test which had been held from 27th to 31st August, 2000 based on the impugned seniority lists will stand vitiated. After a provisional seniority list is prepared within the aforestated period of three months, and objections are invited thereto and a final seniority list is prepared, ^{after a} ~~therefore~~ the trade test based on the seniority list now to be prepared will be conducted.

6. Present OA in the circumstances is allowed in the aforestated terms. No costs.
