

ORDER

Mr. Justice P.K. Shyamsundar, Vice-Chairman:-

The applicant who was aggrieved of his non-selection to the post of Assistant Station Master was subsequently mollified by the offer of the post of Enquiry-cum-Reservation Clerk. We are now told that he has accepted that job, quite happy with it and right now he is undergoing training to equip himself to discharge the duties in the said job. Under the circumstances there is little reason to persist with this application. However, we also find a letter/communication from his lawyer Sri *Kaleemulla Shariff* issued on 28-7-1994 addressed to the Office Superintendent, Southern Railways, Bangalore Division, Bangalore stating that the applicant Sri S.H. Vijayakumar will be withdrawing the petition filed before the Central Administrative Tribunal


