Heard the arguments of the applicant.

The applicant was working as Extra-Departmental Agent and his services were terminated from 01.05.91. The counsel submits that his services have been terminated without any notice and his work was satisfactory. He states that there are vacancies and he may be reinstated in one of these vacancies.

As services were terminated in the year 1991, according to us, the O.A. is barred by time. However, in the aforesaid Statement, if there is a vacancy and till a regular appointment is made, the applicant may be absorbed in one of the vacancies and he may be asked to continue till a regular employee is appointed. The O.A. is disposed of.
