O R D E R (ORAL)

The applicant has retired from service from 31.7.96. Prior to his retirement the applicant has O.A. 1451/95 for change of date of birth which was dismissed on 30.4.96. The contention of the applicant is that he has been paid GPF, Insurance, HRA and wages amounting to Rs. 47,136/- on 31.7.96. The respondents have not paid the commutation, DCRG, Leave salary, pension pay order till January 1997. There is considerable delay in making the payment though the applicant has signed the papers.


The learned counsel for the respondents Shri Zare draws my attention that the applicant has signed the papers only on 29.4.97. Thereafter the papers forwarded to D.R.M. concerned on 30.4.97.

Thereafter forwarded to Accounts Officer on 13.5.97. Pension order was passed on 20.5.97. Commutation, D.C.R.G. and leave salary has been passed on 3.6.97. Therefore there is no delay in making the payment to the applicant.

The prayer made in O.A. is that retiral benefits has not been paid to the applicant till date and he should be paid 18% interest. However after hearing the rival contention of the parties, I am of the view that there is no deleberate intention of the respondents in delaying the payment and the applicant has singned the papers only on 29.4.97. There is no merit in the O.A. Accordingly O.A. is dismissed at the admission stage itself.
