
2. Admit.

3. This OA is filed praying for a direction to the respondents to consider the case of applicant for promotion to the post of Office Superintendent, SGO Superintendent and Establishment Account Officer with effect from the date on which his junior has been promoted by keeping in view the revised seniority list dated 20-8-93 and 28-3-1994 of UDCs and Head Clerks respectively with all attendant and consequential benefits including arrears of difference in pay.

4. It is stated that pursuant of the orders of the Karnataka High Court, the seniority lists in regard to UDCs and Headclerks were revised, and the revised seniority lists in regard to UDCs and Head clerks are as on 20-8-1993 and 28-3-1994 respectively. On the basis of the written instructions for the respondents, Sri N.R. Devaraj, learned Standing counsel submitted that some surplus staff of Rehabilitation Department were also transferred to Geological Survey of India and at their instance, the Allahabad Bench, <sup>AT</sup> had given some directions in February, 94 <sup>and then</sup> that <sup>when</sup> provisional UDC Seniority list was prepared, and there were numerous representations as against the said provisional seniority list for UDC, a

Committee was ~~going to be~~ constituted for the same and that committee submitted a report on 16-8-94 and the final decision would be taken within three months.


