The grievance of the applicant in this case is that he was promoted as Junior Accounts Officer on regular basis w.e.f. 9.5.87 alongwith his junior Shri Abu Zaheer Mahbub Alam. The fact of the case is that the applicant volunteered to work as Junior Accounts Officer in P&T Civil Division, Rajkot, from July, 1981 to June, 1989, whereas his junior, Shri Abu Zaheer Mahbub Alam, who was available locally seems to have been given a series of short spells of adhoc promotion in local vacancies. The applicant now requests for a proforma adhoc promotion to Junior Accounts Officer with effect from the date the said Shri Abu Zaheer Mahbub Alam was promoted on adhoc basis.

2. The matter was considered by the Chief Postmaster-General and a detailed reasoned reply was furnished to the applicant vide annexure I. The purport of the decision is that no provision exists for proforma promotion in short term leave vacancies arising purely locally. This reason is considered adequate and covered by rule.

3. The applicant has no ground to claim the relief prayed for. The O.A. is therefore dismissed at the admission stage. No costs.


