



DETAILS OF THE APPLICATION:

1. PARTICULARS OF THE IMPUGNED ORDER:-

The applicant herein assials the seniority list prepared and circulated by the respondents 1 & 2 along with covering letter dt. 15-9-92 as circulated by CPO covering letter dt. 28-9-92 (A-1.P.70) and for proper fixation of his seniority in the cadre of Jr. Scale of Group A service.

2. JURISDICTION OF THE TRIBUNAL:-

This Bench of this Central Administrative Tribunal alone has got jurisdiction under Section 14 of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 since the applicant is working under the respondents at Secunderabad.

3. LIMITATION:-

This application is not within the period of limitation prescribed under Section 21 of the Administrative Tribunal Act 1985, since the impugned list was circulated under letter dt. 28-9-92 CPO/SC Rly. Separate petition is being filed.

4. FACTS OF THE CASE:-

a) The applicant submits that he worked as TCI from 1966 to 1980. He was appointed to Group "B" service in the very early batch of Limited Departmental Examination in 1980. Though he belongs originally to the Telecom, he was posted to the Signalling cadre as Asst Officer with independent charge at Bitragunta. Subsequently he was posted as ASTE, Microwave Maintenance at Vijayawada to maintain the Microwave installation on Hubli, Guntakal and Vijayawada. Later he was posted as ASTE/Con. 1982. Throughout his service he rendered loyal and unblemished service and won the appreciations of one and all.

b) His promotion to Senior Scale in 1984 also was accompanied by conferment of independent charge in the Construction organisation as DSTE/Con. When the applicant thus rendered such a meritorious services in the light of the appreciations from all the quarters about the quality of his work, suddenly a seniority list was circulated along with the Board's notification together with CPO/SC Lr. No: P.185/Gaz/S&T Dt. 28-9-92 (A-1 at P.7), where under he was pushed down and 14 of his juniors have been placed above him. No notice has been issued before changing the seniority position and no reasons have been given for such a decision.

c) The applicant submits that the seniority list as circulated is arbitrary, illegal and is not in accordance with the Rules in force. The modus-operendi that was followed while conducting the DPC and fixing the seniority was not made known to the applicant at any time. The applicant submit that he was never served with any adverse report so far and he earned better reports in the hands of his Superiors. His work as well as the appraisal reports of his performance are qualitatively superior when compared to the other officers who have been shown as respondents. The other officers who are shown in the seniority list have not been shown as respondents since some of them retired and some of them have died.

d) The applicant submit that the seniority as reflected is totally illegal all the unofficial-respondents were juniors to him at every stage. The applicant waited all along under a bonafide impression that the said seniority list is the subject matter of the lis before various Tribunals and he was informed that the same was also one of the issue. After noticing the judgment of the CAT, Principal Bench in OA 574/93, he noticed that the said point has not been raised in those cases and he made a rep. dt. 20-4-95 followed by a remainder dt. 6-9-95 to the 1st respondent and they remain undisposed. Now having seen the judgment dt 4-8-95, he noticed that it is a case of seniority between the direct recruits and departmental promotees and also the question of quota and excess filling up of the vacancies and consequential action. This question has not been raised.

e) The applicant submits that the committee which was responsible for arranging the seniority and drawing the panel had not applied their judicious mind to the personal records in proper perspective. When the applicant is more meritorious and earned higher ratings in the hands of the responsible officers it is not known as to how he had been pushed to downwards. He sus-

pects that some unfair treatment had been extended to him and extreme consideration prevailed in the minds of the authorities concerned or the concerned records together the personal file of the applicant had not been placed before them. In the absence of any adverse remarks and pendency of any disciplinary action the applicant is entitled to get the same position as was prevailing before publishing the present seniority list in the light of the meritorious record of service. In the cadre of DSTE his name appeared immediately after Murthy A.S.N. Now in the impugned list 14 persons names have been inserted in between these two names while drawing the panel for the Group A. Hence this application seeking interference of this honourable Tribunal.

5. LEGAL SUBMISSIONS IN SUPPORT THE PLEADINGS:-

i) The action of the respondents 1 and 2 in altering the seniority of the applicant to the disadvantage of the applicant is arbitrary, illegal and violative of Art. 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India. The drawal of panel by not considering the relative merits of the candidates in proper perspective basing on extreme reasons is vitiated.

ii) The respondents 1 and 2 have committed material illegality in not considering the applicant's case in the light of his meritorious record. Further the DPC should not have simply acted on the reports written by various individuals concerning various individuals. They will never supply any basis uniformly about the relative merit.

6. DETAILS OF THE REMEDIES EXHAUSTED:-

The applicant submits that he made representation dt. 20-4-95 (A-4.P.12) followed by a remainder dt. 6-9-95 (A.5.P.14) but the same remain undisposed. Thus he is left with no other alternative except to approach this Tribunal. He has no other remedy under any other law.

7. MATTERS NOT PREVIOUSLY FILED OR PENDING WITH ANY OTHER COURT:-

The applicant further submits that he has not previously filed any WP.OA or suit regarding the same relief or substantially the same relief that is sought for in this OA.

8. MAIN RELIEF:-

It is therefore just and necessary that this honourable Tribunal may be pleased to declare the seniority position as reflected in the Board's notification NO:E(GP)92/1/55, Dt. 15-09-92 circulated under CPO/SC's Lr.No:P.185/Gaz/S&T Dt. 28-09-92 as arbitrary, illegal and consequently by quashing the same to the extent of the applicant and the unofficial respondents, direct the respondents 1 and 2 to fix the seniority of the applicant immediately below the name of Sri A.S.N. Murthy and above the unofficial respondents and consequently base the same for all consequential and attendant benefits including promotion to the next higher ranks etc., and pass such other relief or reliefs as this honourable Tribunal may deem fit just and necessary in the circumstances of the case.

9. INTERIM RELIEF:-

Pending disposal of the main OA it is also just and necessary that this honourable Tribunal may be pleased to fix an early date for final hearing and pass such other relief or reliefs as this honourable Tribunal may deem fit just and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Board's kind reference is invited to the Notification cited above wherein the seniority list of officers inducted into Group 'A' IRSSE had been furnished. In this connection, I wish to submit the following for the Board's kind consideration.

2. Having worked as TCI from 1966 to 1980, I was appointed to the Group 'B' Service in the very early batch of Limited Departmental Examination, through a very stiff competition. Even though I belong originally to the Telecom. Cadre, I was posted to the Signalling Cadre as Asst. Officer with independent charge at Bitragunta. This confidence reposed by my superiors in my abilities was fully vindicated as I completed my work to the total satisfaction of all. Subsequently, I was posted as ASTE, Microwave Maintenance at Vijayawada to maintain the Microwave installation on Hubli, Guntakal and Vijayawada. It is not out of place to mention that I am the very first Group 'B' Officer on South Central S & T Department who was incharge of the sophisticated M.W.network. In execution of this highly technical job, I had acquitted myself meritoriously through the years in this work, which requires a high level of technical knowledge and initiative to debug mistakes, with a view to find real-time solutions to problems. Later, when I was posted as ASTE/Con. in 1982, I carried out very important jobs like Panel Interlocking and MAUQ Signalling works etc. My performance had won accolades from my superiors several times.

3. My promotion to Senior Scale in 1984, also was accompanied by conferment of independent charge in the Construction Organisation, as DSTE/Con.

4. Thus, against the back-drop of unblemished service records and all-round appreciation, I have earned from my superiors during my career, it had come like a bolt from the blue to see a huge batch of 13 of my juniors find a place above me in the Panel communicated in the Board's Notification cited above. As my service records and my past performance do not warrant such a wholesale degradation of my relative seniority. I am at a loss to understand that how a great number of my juniors, many of whom had worked under me, had ascended above me.

5. Further, I understand that if any decision which affects the seniority of a person, based on the annual reports had to be taken by the administration, instructions are that during the course of the years under consideration, he had to be counselled and informed about the assumed lack of performance-criteria-fulfilment, so that an opportunity is extended to him to remove any misgiving in the mind of the authority and improve himself to, if need be. In this connection, I humbly submit that during the course of my long years of service, there are no occasions where my performance had been adversely commented upon, not even obliquely, by the administration. On the other hand, I had hitherto won only accolades.

6. Though the notification had been issued nearly 2¹/₂ years ago, so far I have not represented, thinking that the time does not warrant it and possibly, the error may be corrected suo-motu. Since there is a real danger of my juniors now getting promoted above me, I feel that atleast now corrective steps should be taken to assign me my due seniority, warranted by my competent service and unblemished record. Otherwise, my interest would be permanently harmed.


7. Hence I request the Board to review the seniority list conveyed in the letter cited above and assign me the correct seniority placement above my juniors.

tion of delay. Moreover, the applicant is averring that he came to know of the contents of the OA No.574/93 only after Judgement is pronounced by the Principal Bench CAT, New Delhi. If a similar case like the present case is pending before any Tribunal, then the applicant can cite it as a reason for filing the OA at a later date. The instant case is not relevant to the case disposed off by Principal Bench in OA No.574/93. So the reasons stated by the applicant for condonation of delay is not untenable and it has to be rejected. Moreover the settled seniority cannot be disturbed after a lapse of years and the Hon'ble Supreme Court also held the same in several cases.

3. In reply to para 4(b) of OA, it is submitted that Shri R L Reddy, the applicant, herein was promoted to Group-B cadre as ASTE w.e.f 5.1.1981. He was subsequently promoted to Senior Scale on adhoc basis as officiating DSTE/C/BZA w.e.f 24.12.1994. The Railway Board vide its notification No.E(GOP)92/1/55 dated 15.9.92 appointed substantiatively 127 Group-B officers in Group-A service in JS of IRSSE w.e.f 23.7.1992, in which the name of

The lowest rank of Group-A service of IRSSE is Junior Scale in grade Rs.2200-4000 and appointment to this cadre is made from the following sources :

1. By Direct Recruitment through open competitive examination conducted by the UPSC.
2. By promotion of Group-B officers of S&T Dept. of Indian Railways.

The promotion from Group-B to Senior Scale is done through Selection conducted by the Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) convened by the UPSC. A Member of the UPSC is the Chairman of the DPC. Generally, three representatives of the Ministry of Railways form part of the DPC as members. A meeting of the DPC was convened by the UPSC on 6th to 8th and 13th to 15th July, 1992 to consider selection of Group-B officers of S&T Department into Group-A/Junior Scale of IRSSE against promotion quota of 153 vacancies pertaining to the recruitment years 1989 to 1991, a break-up of which is given below :.LS1

4. It is further submitted that the said DPC also considered the applicant against the vacancies of 1991-92 and recommended him for promotion. The other officer namely Shri C Maria Susai, who was empanelled against the vacancies of this year along with the applicant was even senior to the applicant in Group-B seniority. — In this connection, it is mentioned that in the cases of selection which are based on merit, supersession is not an uncom

mon feature. The Railway Board's notification dated 15.9.1992 cited above was challenged by Shri Anil Kumar Sanghi and others in OA No.574 of 1993 before Hon'ble CAT Principal Bench, New Delhi. The following reliefs were prayed for in the said OA :

- i) The impugned order dated 15.9.1992 (Annexure A-1) be quashed and set aside to the extent the number of departmental candidates promoted exceeds the quota of 40% vacancies for the year 1992.
- ii) Any other relief deemed fit and proper by the Hon'ble Tribunal in the interest of justice.

The Hon'ble Tribunal, Principal Bench/New Delhi by their order dated 4.8.1995 in OA No.574/93 directed the respondents as follows [REDACTED] :

" i) It is not competent for the Railways to appoint as many persons as by promotion as they like, in disregard of the provisions of the Rule 4 which stipulates the quota for promotion and direct recruitment. Repeated violent departure from the quota rule will lead to collapse of the quota rule (direct recruits case-supra) and therefore of the linked seniority rule (BS Gupta's case-supra).

ii) The principle of weightage in seniority will be limited to promotees appointed against their quota.

iii) As the rules stand at present, the maximum quota for promotees is only 40%. It cannot be raised further by relaxation, as Government has no such power.

iv) Vacancies not filled in a year whether in the direct recruitment quota or promotee quota can be carried over, but all such vacancies have to be filled in the subsequent years by both methods on the basis of quota mentioned in Rule 4;

v) Out of the 127 appointments made by the Annexure A-I dated 15.9.1992, promotion should be deemed to have been made to the extent of 40% of the vacancies in 1992 which have been computed tentatively at 89 (para 34 supra) subject to departmental verification. They alone are entitled to weightage and seniority on the seniority principles (vii) and (ix).

vi) The remaining 38 persons subject to departmental verification have been promoted in excess of the promotion quota and they are not entitled to weightage in seniority on the basis of the Annexure A-I order. Their promotions shall be treated as adhoc only. They can be treated as regularly promoted against the quota for promotees in 1993 and thereafter. In that case, such promotees can be given weightage from the dates their promotions are regularised;

vii) The Annexure A-I order shall stand modified to the extent indicated above. "

5. It is submitted that in implementation of the Judgement and orders dated 4.8.1995 of the Hon'ble Tribunal in OA No.574 of 1993 notification No.E(GP)92/1/55 dated 21.9.1995, 10.11.1995 and 8.2.1996 (copies are filed as Annexure R-II, III & IV) have been issued in supersession of the notification dated 15.9.1992 cited above and all other subsequent notifications. While the notifi-

cation dated 21.9.1995 and 8.2.1996 are in respect of substantive appointment of 84 Group-8 officers of the S&T Department into Group-A Junior Scale of IRSSE w.e.f 23.7.1992 against the promotion quota vacancies in 1992, the notification dated 10.11.1995 is in respect of substantive appointment of 53 Group-8 officers of the S&T Department into Group-A/Jr. Scale of IRSSE w.e.f 21.6.1993 against the promotion quota vacancies in 1993. The date 21.6.1993 is the date on which the indent for direct recruitment was placed on the UPSC pertaining to the Exam Year 1993. The name of the applicant figures at Sl No.37 in the notification dated 10.11.1995. Regularisation of the balance officers who were recommended by the DPC convened by UPSC is also under process.

6. In reply to para 4(C) of OA, it is submitted that as submitted in the foregoing para, the applicant has been appointed to Jr. Scale of IRSSE as per the merit order assigned to him by the DPC. Therefore, the seniority order assigned to him is strictly in accordance with the extant rules.

7. In reply to para 4(D) of OA, it is submitted that the applicant at no stage was informed that the case before Principal Bench, New Delhi was for directions to decide the seniority among Direct Recruits and Promotees, as mentioned in his application. The circumstances under which the applicant was by-passed for induction in Group-A services was already explained in the above para and therefore the contention of the applicant that the

seniority reflected in the orders is totally illegal is denied. It is further submitted that the respondents have acted strictly in accordance with the directions given by the Principal Bench, New Delhi with reference to the induction of Group-B officers into Group-A for which the notifications mentioned above were issued by the administration.

8. In reply to para 4(E) of OA, it is submitted that as per extant orders, the DPC after thoroughly going into each case based on the performance and other relevant material recommended the Group-B officers for substantive appointment to Jr. Scale of IRSSE. In as much as the DPC has acted judiciously in the present issue, the contention of the applicant that the Committee had not applied their mind judiciously to the personal records in proper perspective is not in order. As explained above, the applicant was considered for the vacancies of 1991 and was bypassed by 14 of his juniors as the Committee did not find him suitable for absorption in JS of IRSSE based on his performance, as reflected in the records.

9. In reply to para 5 (i) & (ii) of legal grounds it is submitted that when the respondents have acted as per rules and as per the directions of the Hon'ble Tribunal in the question of seniority, the question of arbitrariness, illegality does not arise as alleged by the applicant. The allegations made in the legal grounds are denied as baseless.

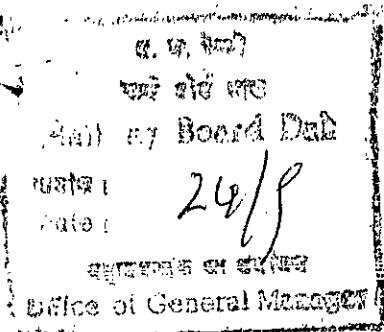





3. My promotion to Senior Scale in 1984, also was accompanied by conferment of independent charge in the Construction Organisation as DSTE/Con.

4. Thus, against the back-drop of unblemished service records and all-round appreciation, I have earned from my superiors during my career, it had come like a bolt from the blue to see a huge batch of 13 of my juniors find a place above me in the Panel communicated in the Board's Notification cited above. As my service records and my past performance do not warrant such a wholesale degradation of my relative seniority. I am at a loss to understand that how a great number of my juniors, many of whom had worked under me, had ascended above me.

5. Further, I understand that if any decision which affects the seniority of a person, based on the annual reports had to be taken by the administration, instructions are that during the course of the years under consideration, he had to be counselled and informed about the assumed lack of performance-criteria-fulfilment, so that an opportunity is extended to him to remove any misgiving in the mind of the authority and improve himself to, if need be. In this connection, I humbly submit that during the course of my long years of service, there are no occasions where my performance had been adversely commented upon, not even obliquely, by the administration. On the other hand, I had hitherto won only accolades.

6. Though the notification had been issued nearly $2\frac{1}{2}$ years ago, so far I have not represented, thinking that the time does not warrant it and possibly, the error may be corrected suo-motu. Since there is a real danger of my juniors now getting promoted above me, I feel that atleast now corrective steps should be taken to assign me my due seniority, warranted by my competent service and unblemished record. Otherwise, my interest would be permanently harmed.

7. Hence I request the Board to review the seniority list conveyed in the letter cited above and assign me the correct seniority placement above my juniors.
