3. The applicants were appointed initially ^{and their date of} in the years between 1981 to 1983. Their date of absorption on regular basis ^{min} appointed as RTP are given in page-12 (Annexure-2) to OA. The applicants states that they have completed training and worked along with regular Postal Assistants for 8 hours per day and more than 240 days in a year.




5. Hence we follow the direction given in OA 798/97 and direct as follows :-

their initial appointment. If the existing seniority position is to be revised, that could be done only after notice to parties who may be affected.

6. Original Application is ordered accordingly at the admission stage itself. No order as to costs.


