This is a Contempt Petition by petitioner Chhotu Singh stating therein that by not implementing the decision of the Tribunal in OA 534/92 dated 19.1.94, the respondents have committed contempt of court. The respondents have filed their reply stating therein that the arrears of allowances from 23.5.85 to 20.5.90 and an amount of Rs.2206/- through P.L.B. have already been paid to the petitioner on 4.5.95 vide Annexure R-1 and Annexure R-2 filed alongwith the additional reply. The directions given by the Tribunal in the OA aforesaid have been fully complied with. The applicant has himself accepted the aforesaid payment made to him vide Ann.R-1.
