
: O R D E R :

This Contempt Petition is filed complaining the violation of the order of the Tribunal dated 21.11.1997. By that order we directed ~~XXXX~~ the respondents to pay the pay scale of Rs. 950-1500 of the post of Carpenter to the petitioner during the pendency of the petition. Now the learned counsel appearing for the respondents have submitted a letter dated 7.7.98 showing that in compliance of the directions of this Tribunal, the petitioner

has been accorded the pay scale of Rs. 950-1500 with a further direction that he continued to remain on the post of Khallasi. It is also stated that equivalent pay scale of Carpenter has been granted to the petitioner.

2. In the circumstances, this C.P. does not survive and the Contempt Petition is dismissed as infructuous and notices are discharged.
