ORDER

(PER HON'BLE SHRI RATAN PRAKASH, MEMBER (JUDICIAL))

This application has been filed under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunal's Act, 1985 by the applicant Shri Lehru Lal who is said to have been first appointed on the post of Field Collie by the Unit Incharge of G.S.I. Camp, Sindesar, Tehsil Belmagra, a unit of respondent No.3 in the year 1977-78. It is averred that the applicant has been continuously working in different capacities with the respondents department for over 18-19 years and at present is also working at Belmagra.

2. Relmagra is in Udaipur District. Rule 6 of the Central Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1987 provides where shall an application would ordinarily lie. It says that it shall be filed by an applicant with the Registrar of the Bench within whose jurisdiction:

- "i) the applicant is posted for the time being, or
- ii) the cause of action, wholly or in part, has been arisen ..."

Consequently, as is apparent from the facts alleged by the applicant in his OA the applicant is working at Relmagra which is in Udaipur district. As per Schedule of Jurisdiction demarcated for the Bench, Udaipur district falls under the jurisdiction of Jodhpur Bench. This OA, therefore, be returned to the applicant for presentation before the appropriate bench. Necessary pleadings be returned to the applicant as per rules within a week.

3. The O.A. is disposed of accordingly.
