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ORDER

PER HON'BLE MR. GOPAL KRISHNA, VICE CHAIRMAN

Applicants, Lallu Ram, Madan Gopal, S.K.Sharma and Kailash Chand, have prayed in this application under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, for a direction to respondent No.3 to allow the same benefits of honorarium which are available to employees/peons of the Northern Railway at the same rate pursuant to a circular dated 21-7-1992.

2. We have heard the learned counsel for the applicants.

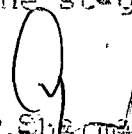
3. Applicants are employed as Peons in the Divisional Pay and Cash Section in the Divisional Accounts Office, Western Railway, Jaipur Division, Jaipur. In the Divisional Pay and Cash Office honorarium is being given to certain members of the staff in terms of the circular dated 29-12-1993 (Ann.A1). This honorarium is being given to them for the reason that they are performing their duties efficiently and effectively. The applicants

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are claiming honorarium on the ground that a great risk is attached to their duties as envisaged by the circular. The applicants, of course, have made a representation in regard to their grievance vide Ann.A3 but the same has not been decided till date.

4. In the circumstances, we direct respondent No.2 i.e. FAOAO, Western Railway, Churchgate, Bombay to decide the representation made by the applicants to him vide Ann.A3 dated 24-1-95 in the light of the circular dated 21-7-1993 (Ann.A2) on the subject of honorarium to the staff of pay side within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. A copy of the OA may be sent to respondent No.2 alongwith a copy of this order. This OA is disposed of with the aforesaid direction at the stage of admission.
