In this application under Section 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, Shri Chandi Mal Jain has prayed that the respondents may be directed to promote the applicant from the date his juniors were promoted in H.S.G.II that is w.e.f. 1-10-91. He has also claimed maintenance of interse seniority vis-a-vis his juniors and certain other consequential reliefs.

2. During the arguments the learned counsel for the applicant produced before us a copy of the order dated 8-8-96 passed by the respondents granting promotion to the aforesaid post to the applicant w.e.f.1-10-91. This order states that the inter-se seniority of the officials in the lower grade would be kept intact for the purpose of eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade. The learned counsel for the applicant states that the reliefs sought by the applicant ~~has~~ have been granted to him.

3. In these circumstances, the OA has become infructuous. It stands disposed of accordingly with no order as to costs. A copy of the order dated 8-8-96 is taken on record.
