PER HON'BLE MR. GOPAL KRISHNA, VICE CHAIRMAN

Applicant, Bharat Prakash Sharma, in this application u/s 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, has sought payment of Over Time Allowance or a direction to the respondents to take duty from him for 5 hours a day.

2. We have heard the learned counsel for the applicant. The applicant was initially appointed in 1988 in the P&T Department and he was absorbed against a vacant post of EDMC/ED Packer by order dated 12.11.90, at Ann.A-1. It is stated that the working hours of ED Packer are 5 hours a day but he is performing duties for 8 hours and, therefore, he has claimed Over Time Allowance or a direction to the respondents to take duty from him for 5 hours a day. He has represented to the concerned authorities vide Ann.A-1 dated 6.3.95. The matter is still under consideration.

3. In the circumstances, we direct respondent No.2 to decide the applicant's representation, at Ann.A-1, dated 6.3.95 within two months of the date of receipt of a copy of this order. If the applicant is aggrieved by any decision on the representation, he may file a fresh OA. The OA stands disposed of, as stated above, at the stage of admission.
