In this OA filed u/s 19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, the applicant makes a prayer to direct the respondents to consider the candidature of the applicant for appointment on compassionate grounds on a suitable post.

2. In brief, the case of the applicant is that her husband was serving as Constable in the Custom Department at Jaipur but he expired on 8.2.98 leaving behind a widow and a daughter. It is stated that after the death of her husband family of the deceased employee is suffering from indigent conditions. Therefore, the applicant is entitled to be considered for appointment on compassionate grounds.
