
PER HON'BLE MR. S.K. AGARWAL, JUDICIAL MEMBER

In this OA, the applicant makes a prayer to direct the respondents to consider her case for appointment on compassionate grounds. The applicant is widow of Late Shri Dilip Singh Shekhawat, who was working as Postal Assistant at Shahpura and died on 17.12.98.

2. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant had filed a representation on 12.8.99, which has not been disposed of so far. He seeks disposal of the representation at this stage.
