

ORDER (ORAL)


Learned counsel for the applicant submits that he had filed OA No. 12/2003 whereby he has prayed for quashing of the order dated 3/4.6.2002 (Annexure A/10) ordering retirement of the applicant with immediate effect. In the said order, it is nowhere mentioned that the applicant had been compulsorily retired, although it is written that applicant had been retired with immediate effect on having attaining the age of 55 years. Therefore, he has filed this OA for seeking appointment of his ward on compassionate grounds as order be deemed to be a normal retirement or retirement on medical grounds. The learned



counsel after perusing the order dated 3/4.6.2002 and arguing the matter for sometime submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this OA so that he can amend OA No. 12/2003 for grant of compassionate appointment to his ward as per rules as a consequential relief if it is held that applicant retired on normal superannuation or retired on invalid pension.

3. The OA stands dismissed as withdrawn with a liberty to file MA in the OA No. 12/2003, which will be considered at the appropriate time in accordance with Law.
