The controversy in the present case is very narrow. The applicant (Ms Bulu Das), virtue of the present application seeks a direction to the respondents to appoint her on compassionate ground to the post of Gramin Dak Sewak.

2. ^{Shorn}~~Sworn~~ of all other details, it is relevant to mention that the father of the applicant died in harness

on 22.5.1995. The applicant had applied for a Group 'D' post on compassionate ground. The name of the applicant was approved on 11.11.1999 vide Annexure-1. Subsequently, on 13.3.2001 the respondent had written to the applicant the letter, which reads:

"Ref:- Your application dated 12-1-98

You were approved on 11-11-99 for appointment on compassionate ground under relaxation of normal recruitment rules as PA and you are in the waiting list since then. You could not be appointed so far due to non-availability of vacancy in this circle.

Therefore, you are asked to express your willingness whether you are agreeable to join in any other department within or outside Assam. On receipt of your willingness, other department will be consulted to consider your case."

The applicant had conveyed her willingness in this regard. In pursuance thereto, another letter dated 21.11.2001 was sent to the applicant offering her the post of Gramin Dak Sewak. The said post was stated to be vacant. The applicant had replied that she is willing to accept the said post till such time she is not offered a Group 'D' post.

3. Keeping in view the said condition that had been stated in the offer of appointment, the respondents did not offer the post to the applicant.

4. By virtue of the present application, the applicant now seeks that she should be appointed on compassionate ground to the post of Gramin Dak Sewak.

5. During the course of the submissions, Mr S. Sarma, the learned counsel for the applicant, has explained that since the applicant was waiting for an appointment letter to a Group 'D' post, therefore, the said condition had been imposed, otherwise she is willing to work as Gramin Dak Sewak. Once the applicant is willing to join


unconditionally.....



unconditionally the post of Gramin Dak Sewak, it becomes unnecessary for this Tribunal to ponder with any other controversy. Accordingly, we allow the present application and direct:

- a) If there is post of Gramin Dak Sewak available at present, the applicant should be appointed on compassionate ground against the said post.
- b) In case no such post is available presently, the applicant should be offered/appointed as soon as the next vacancy arises.

6. With this the application stands disposed of. No order as to costs.

PARTICULARS OF THE APPLICATION

1. PARTICULARS OF THE ORDER AGAINST WHICH THIS APPLICATION
IS MADE:

This application is directed against the
action/inaction on the part of the Respondents in not
considering the case of the applicant for compassionate
appointment even after the approval made by the competent
authority. This application is also directed against the
action of the respondents in appointing juniors to the
applicant superseding her merit position by issuing various
orders as reflected below in paragraph "facts of the case".

2. LIMITATION:

The applicant declares that the instant application has been filed within the limitation period prescribed under section 21 of the Central Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

3. JURISDICTION:

The applicant further declares that the subject matter of the case is within the jurisdiction of the Administrative Tribunal.

4. FACTS OF THE CASE:

4.1. That the applicant is a citizen of India and as such he is entitled to all the rights, privileges and protection as guaranteed by the Constitution of India and laws framed thereunder.

4.2. That the father of the applicant Late Harmohan Das working as a Postal Assistant in the Tamulpur Sub Post Office. On 22.5.95, father of the applicant died in the Sub Post Office itself on duty. At the time of his death the applicant left behind his wife and minor daughter and sons among which the applicant is the eldest one. Immediately after death of her father, the applicant preferred representations before the concerned authority.

4.3. That the respondents acting on the representations filed by the applicant directed her to submit all the necessary documents pertaining to her educational qualification etc. Accordingly, the respondents after due consideration of the matter and after scrutinizing all the

relevant documents the Chief Postmaster General approved the appointment of the applicant for her recruitment on compassionate ground relaxing the rules. The aforesaid approval has been made pursuant to a recommendation of Circle Selection Committee constituted for that purpose. To that effect the Respondent No.2 issued an order dated 11.11.99 by which the aforementioned recommendation has been made to 26 candidates in which applicant's name appeared at Serial No.3.

A copy of the order dated 11.11.99 (extract) is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-1.

4.4. That after issuance of the Annexure-1 order dated 11.11.99 the Respondents issued a communication dated 13.3.01 to the applicant stating that due to non-availability of vacancy she could not be given appointment in the Circle and apprised about the fact that subject to her willingness she can be accommodated in other Department or in Postal Department outside Assam. The applicant immediately on receipt of the said order placed her willingness accordingly.

A copy of the order dated 13.3.01 is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-2.

4.5. That immediately after issuance of the order dated 11.11.99 the respondents have issued yet another order dated 21.11.01 by which decision of the Directorate has been conveyed regarding Compassionate appointment of the wait listed candidate against the vacant post of Gramin Dak Sewak

subject to willingness. By the said order dated 21.11.01 the respondent No.4 has intimated the applicant to place her willingness to that effect and accordingly present applicant placed her willingness to serve as Gramin Dak Sewak.

A copy of the aforementioned order dated 21.11.01 is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-3.

4.6. That the respondent No.4 in continuation to the aforesaid order dated 21.11.01 issued another order dated 27.2.02 indicating 4 vacancies of Gramin Dak Sewak under Nalbari-Barpeta Division. In the said order itself the Respondents sought for willingness from amongst the enlisted candidates claiming compassionate appointment. In the list according to seniority the name of the applicant appeared at Serial No.3 and since there were 4 vacancies she placed her willingness to serve as Gramin Dak Sewak.

A copy of the said order dated 27.2.02 is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-4.

4.7. That the respondents however without taking into consideration the claim of the applicant and without maintaining the seriatim of the list appointed one Sri Biswajit Das as Gramin Dak Sewak in Kachukata B.O. on compassionate ground. It is pertinent to mention here that by now the respondents have sought to fill up all the 4 posts as indicated in the Annexure-4 order dated 27.2.02. In respect of said Sri Biswajit Das the Chief Postmaster General, Assam Circle, Guwahati has already approved his

candidature for compassionate appointment as Gramin Dak Sewak in Kachukata B.O. and to that effect the CPMG issued a letter dated 10.6.02 where by Mr.Das has been asked to produce his Original Certificate/documents before 22.7.02.

A copy of the said letter dated 10.6.02 is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-5.

4.8. That the applicant highlighting her grievances made several representations to the concerned authority placing her willingness to serve as Gramin Dak Sewak anywhere but excluding her claim the respondents have sought to fill up the aforementioned 4 vacant posts by her juniors. It is noteworthy to mentioned here that the name of Sri Biswajit Das appears at Serial No.5 and under no circumstances he can be accommodated one of those 4 vacancies mentioned in the order dated 27.2.02. Highlighting those grievances applicant preferred numbers of representations but same yielded no result in positive and situated thus she has come under the protective hands of this Hon'ble Tribunal seeking appropriate relief.

The applicant craves leave of this Hon'ble Tribunal to annexed some of the representations and the option exercised by her as Annexure-6 colly.

4.9. That the applicant begs to state that in te matter of public employment the respondents being a model employer should set an example by adopting fair means but in the instant case deviation is seen apparently. All along the respondents kept on intimately regarding her willingness to serve as Gramin Dak Sewak and since the applicant is in need

of job accepted all the conditions laid down by the respondents. The respondents themselves has circulated the priority list wherein her name appeared at serial No.3 but ignoring her claim the persons whose name appeared at Serial No.5 has been given due approval ignoring her claim. Admittedly, said Sri Biswajit Das is not an approved candidate taking into consideration the Annexure-1 letter dated 11.11.99 and as such he is not entitled to get the benefit of compassionate appointment and thus order dated 18.6.02 conveying such approval is liable to be set aside and quashed.

4.10. That the applicant begs to state that presently respondents are making a move to fill up all these 4 posts mentioned in the Annexure-4 letter dated 27.2.02 by juniors to the applicant. The name of the applicant appeared at Sl.No.3 of the said list and she exercised all the options. The respondents on the other hand kept on assuring regarding her compassionate appointment but till date nothing has been done. The respondents now sought to fill up those posts by juniors and outsiders and apprehending that fact the applicant has come before this Hon'ble Tribunal seeking an interim direction towards the respondents restraining them from filling up those posts mentioned in the order dated 27.2.02 without the leave of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

5. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF WITH LEGAL PROVISION:

5.1. For that the respondents have acted illegally depriving the applicant from her legitimate claim of appointment on compassionate basis and as such same is not sustainable in the eye of law and liable to be set aside and quashed.

5.2. For that the name of the applicant being at serial No.3 of the approved list of candidates for appointment on compassionate basis the respondents ought to have maintained the serialim and appointed the applicant in the post of Gramin Dak Dewak in a near by post office.

5.3. For that the respondents have acted illegally in filling up of 4 posts as mentioned in the order dated 27.2.02 ignoring the claim of the applicant.

5.4. For that the respondents have acted illegally in not considering the case of the applicant whereas there are sufficient vacancy taking into consideration the priority list.

5.5. For that the respondents have acted illegally in approving the name of the respondent No.4 who is not an approved candidate for compassionate appointment as reflected in Annexure-1 order dated 11.11.99.

5.6. For that the respondents ought to have taken into consideration the seniority list and they ought to have provided employment to the applicant. The respondents being a model employer should have acted fairly in the matter of public employment and ought to have provided employment to the applicant who is well within the zone of consideration taking into consideration the available vacancy.

5.7. For that in any view of the matter the action/inaction of the respondents are not sustainable in the eye of law and liable to set aside and quashed.

The applicant craves leave of the Tribunal to advance more grounds both legal as well as factual at the time of hearing of the case.

6. DETAILS OF REMEDIES EXHAUSTED:

That the applicant declares that he has exhausted all the remedies available to them and there is no alternative remedy available to him.

7. MATTERS NOT PREVIOUSLY FILED OR PENDING IN ANY OTHER

COURT:

The applicant further declares that he has not filed previously any application, writ petition or suit regarding the grievances in respect of which this application is made before any other court or any other Bench of the Tribunal or any other authority nor any such application, writ petition or suit is pending before any of them.

8. RELIEF SOUGHT FOR:

Under the facts and circumstances stated above, the applicant most respectfully prayed that the instant application be admitted records be called for and after hearing the parties on the cause or causes that may be shown and on perusal of records, be grant the following reliefs to the applicant:-

8.1. To set aside and quash impugned Annexure-5 order dated 10.6.02.

8.2. To direct the respondents to appoint the applicant on compassionate ground in the post of Gramin Dak Sewak as mentioned in Annexure-4 order or any other posts commensurating to her educational qualification.

8.3. To direct the respondents not to fill up any of these 4 posts mentioned in Annexure-4 order dated 27.2.02 or any posts presently lying vacant under the respondents without first considering her case for compassionate appointment.

8.4. Cost of the application.

8.5. Any other relief/reliefs to which the applicant is entitled to under the facts and circumstances of the case and deemed fit and proper.

9. INTERIM ORDER PRAYED FOR:

Pending disposal of the application the applicant prays for an interim order directing the respondents not to fill up any posts including the posts mentioned in the order dated 27.2.02 without first considering the claim of the applicant and suspend the operation of the Annexure-5 order dated 10.6.02 till finalisation of the OA.

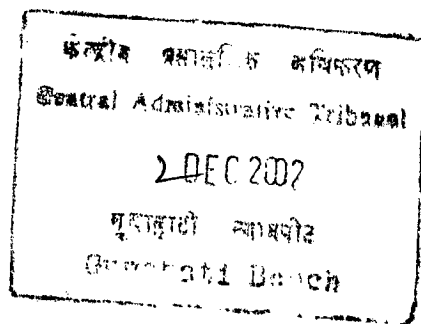

I, N. Das, Superintendent of Post Offices,
Nalbari Barpeta Division, Nalbari, do hereby solemnly affirm
and say as follows :

1. That I am the Superintendent of Post Offices,
Nalbari Barpeta Division, Nalbari and Respondent No.3 in
the case. I have gone through a copy of the application
served on me and have understood the contents thereof .
Save and except whatever is specifically admitted in this
written statement, the other contentions and statements
may be deemed to have been denied and the applicants should
be put to strict proof of whatever they claim to the contrary.
I am authorised and competent to file this written statement
on behalf of all the respondents.

2. That the respondents beg to state that the applicant was approved for appointment under relaxation of normal rules vide Chief PMG, Guwahati memo no Staff/16-1/98 dated 11.11.99. Due to non availability of vacancy the Postal Directorate decided to consider the cases of the candidates approved for appointment under Compassionate ground to prefer them in the vacant post of Gramin Dak Sewak, if they are willing as Such. Accordingly, the applicant was asked to offer her willingness, with the choice of station against GDS post till she is posted on selected post Postal of PA cadre. But as per the instruction of ~~Postal~~ Directorate, the candidate, with their acceptance of GDS post, would have no further claim for appointment on any special consideration against regular departmental vacancies and they require to furnish an undertaking in this regard. Under the above circumstances, the applicant could not be appointed against GDS post due to her conditional option.

3. That the respondents have no comments to the statement made in paragraphs 1,2, 3, 4.1, 4.2, 4.3 and 4.4 of the application.

4. That with regard to the statements made in paragraph 4.5 of the application the respondents beg to state that due to non availability of vacancy, the Directorate decided to consider the cases of the candidates approved for appointment under Compassionate ground to prefer them in the vacant post of Gramin Dak Sewak, if they are willing as such.

Accordingly such candidates, including the applicant were asked to offer their willingness with choice of station, against ~~transfer to~~ GDP Posts vide letter no. B/A-77 dated 21.11.01. But no willingness was received from the applicant.

A copy of letter dated 21.11.01 is annexed herewith as Annexure - 'A'.

5. That with regard to the statements made in para 4.6, of the application the respondents beg to state that it was admitted that since no willingness was received from the applicant in response of letter dated 21.11.01. A further willingness, showing the vacant post and nature of works as such posts, was called from all the approved Candidates for appointment as mentioned earlier vide letter no. B/A-77/ Statement Dated 27.02.2002. In this context, there was clear instructions from the Postal Directorate that the approved candidates with their acceptance of GDS post they would have no further claim for appointment on any special consideration against regular departmental vacancies and they require to furnish an undertaking in this regard. Further, the Directorate issued instructions for discontinuance of waiting list of the candidates approved for compassionate appointment. Hence in this instant case, the applicant furnished her option for GDS post under her letter dated 25.02.02 and 11.03.02 with a condition that she is willing to accept the GDS post & till she is posted on selected post of PA cadre. As the option of the applicant is conditional and against the policy of the Department, her case was not

taken into consideration for appointment against the vacancies in GDS post circulated vide letter dated 27.02.02. Copies of letter dt. 27.2.02, 25.2.02 & 11.3.03 are annexed as Annexure -B,C,D.

6. That with regard to the statements made in paragraph 4.7 of the application that. On the merit of the willingness of the said Shri Biswajit Das, he was ordered to work as GDS at Kachukata BO. The production of original testimonial before issue of appointment is a procedural matter. The applicant has nothing to object in this regard.

7. That with regard to the statements made in paragraphs 4.8 of the application the respondents beg to state that as per policy of the Department this has been made clear that with their acceptance of GDS post the approved candidate would have no further claim for appointment on any special consideration against regular departmental vacancies and they require to furnish an undertaking in this regard. Here the respondent beg to submit that the option/willingness of the applicant to work in GDS was conditional that she is willing to work in GDS posts till regular appointment in departmental vacancies. Thus, his case has not been taken into consideration for appointment in GDS post.

8. That with regard to the statements made in para 4.9, of the application the respondents beg to state that the respondent beg to deny the contention of the applicant regarding alleged non approval of Shri Bishwajit Das who stands

approved for appointment in the Postman Cadre earlier than the applicant vide Chief PMG Memo No. Staff/16/Misc/97 dated 03.02.98 and his position was at serial No.1 of the list for appointment in postman cadre. Thus the applicant without going to the facts tries to give a wrong information and as such her contention should be straight way rejected.

A copy of letter dated 3.2.98 is annexed as Annexure - E.

9. That with regard to the statements made in para 4.10, of the application the respondents beg to state that the approved list of the candidates for appointment on compassionate ground is being furnished by the Circle Selection Committee in each year. Accordingly their cases are being taken into consideration subject to availability of vacancies in the cadre approved for. Here in this case, the applicant was selected in the list prepared for the year 1999 and her name placed at serial 3 of the said list. The candidates selected earlier were asked to exercise their option to work in Gramin Das Sewak posts. Letter No. B/A-77/Statement dated 27.02.2002 was issued to all the candidates selected for compassionate appointment in continuation of the letter dated 21.11.2001 showing clearly the vacant post of Gramin Das Sewak. As mentioned earlier, the option furnished by the applicant was conditional and her case is not taken into consideration and her request for interim order restraining the respondent from filling up the GDS post is not at all justified in the eye of law and liable to be dismissed.

10. That with regard to the statements made in para 5 of the application the respondents beg to state that in view of the facts mentioned above the ground for relief sought for by the applicant has no base at all and liable to be dismissed.

11. That with regard to para 6 & 7 of the application the respondents beg to offer no comments.


