



O R D E R

CHOWDHURY, J.(V.C.):

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In this application under section/19 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 the applicant has assailed the action of the respondents authority in cancelling the post of Junior Accounts Assistant advertised vide employment notice No.1/96 by the Railway Recruitment Board. The applicant also prayed for a direction on the respondents to declare the result of the written examination held 25.3.2001 for the aforementioned post. The basic facts relevant for the purpose of adjudication of the proceeding is outlined herein below:-

1. By employment notice No.1/96 dated 20.5.1996 the Railway Recruitment Board, Guwahati invited applications from the eligible candidates for 39 category posts including the post of Junior Accounts Assistant. The/Junior Accounts Assistant was listed in category No.37 for filling up 31 vacancies, out of which 15 were unreserved. The applicant

applied for the post within the period specified. The said post was re-advertised in a daily news paper "The Assam Tribune" on 29.4.1997. Thereafter call letters<sup>were</sup> issued for the written examination to the eligible candidates including the applicant. The written examination for category No.37 was held on 9.11.1997. The applicant asserted that he appeared well in the said examination, but the same was cancelled by the respondents authority and the <sup>notification</sup> was published in "The Assam Tribune" on 26.2.2001. By the said notification a fresh date for re-examination was fixed on 25.3.2001 and for that purpose call letter was also issued to the applicant. The applicant appeared in the said written examination, but this time also the respondents authority cancelled the same by a notice published in "The Assam Tribune" on 15.9.2001 on administrative ground. The applicant contended that though serious irregularities happened in the written examination in respect of category No.2 of Employment Notice No.1/2000 which was held on 7.4.2002 and complaint was lodged, but the same was not cancelled. As a matter of fact, the result of the written examination of category No.2 of employment notice No.1/2000 was declared and published in "The Assam Tribune" on 9.7.2002. The applicant alongwith other candidates, thereafter, made a <sup>dated 7.2.2002</sup> representation/before the authority for conducting re-examination of the cancelled written test. While the applicant was awaiting for response by the impugned notice dated 12.8.2002 published in "The Assam Tribune" on 14.8.2002 the respondents authority reduced the post of Junior Accounts Assistant along with some other posts to zero and consequently cancelled the written examination process conducted for the post. Mr.A. Chakraborty, learned counsel for the applicant strenuously contended that the respondents acted arbitrarily and discriminatorily in the matter of public employment and thereby denied the applicant equal opportunity in the matter of employment. The learned counsel for the applicant contended that the



authority conducted the examination and in the absence of any valid reason there was no justification for cancelling the examination and finally totally cancelling the process of employment.

2. We have heard Mr. J.L. Sarkar, learned Standing counsel for the Railways at length. The respondents in its written statement stated that in the Employment Notice No.1/96 there were 39 categories. Category No.37 was meant for Junior Accounts Assistant. There were 31 posts in category No.37 comprising of UR, SC, ST & OBC. The written examination was held on 9.11.1997 and the type test was held on 21.12.1997. Due to anomalies in the written test the said examination was cancelled vide Railway Board letter dated 23.5.2000. Subsequent written examination was held on 25.3.2001 and the same was also cancelled vide Railway Board letter dated 6.8.2001. In the written statement the respondents also asserted that in view of the review and for want of vacancies the Railway Board put restriction for issuing recruitment notices in respect of certain categories of posts including the post of Junior Accounts Assistant without prior approval of the Board and the said restriction was extended upto 31.7.2003.


3. The issue relates to legitimacy of the action of the respondents. The respondents being an employer issued employment notices inviting applications from the eligible candidates for filling up the post and steps were taken for that purpose. However, the examinations were cancelled due to anomalies committed by the concerned authority. The Recruitment Board upon considering the report of the Vigilance organisation of N.F. Railway cancelled the earlier written examination and ordered for re-examination. However, the said written examination for the post of Junior Accounts Assistant, <sup>that was</sup> held on 25.3.2001 had to be cancelled on consideration of the report/proposal sent by the Chairman, Railway Recruitment Board and the Chief Personnel Officer, N.F. Railway.. The said report

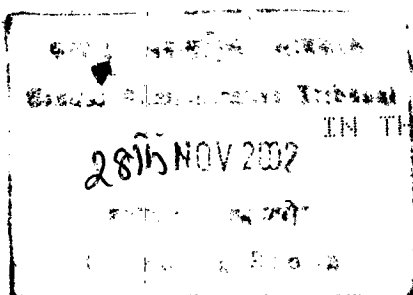
and the proposal sent through Confidential D.O. letter No. RRB/G/37/1/99 dated 25.3.2001 was considered by the Railway Board. On consideration of the report, the Railway Board instructed the CPO/N.F.Railway to call for explanation of the officer-in-charge and take up with him. Necessary instructions were issued accordingly to remedy the situation. By the said Communication Chairman, Railway Recruitment Board Guwahati was also advised to take necessary steps as remedial measure in conducting the examination. It also appears on the record that in view of the empanelled Junior Accounts Assistant scale Rs.4000-6000 (RPS) awaiting absorption for want of vacancies on the Railways, Board decided that all pending indents of Jr.Accounts Assistants received from Western, Central and N.F.Railways on RRBs need to be cancelled. In the light of communication dated 1.11.2001 by communication dated 6.11.2001 the Railway Board imposed the restriction on issuing Recruitment Notices. In the set of circumstances no illegality is discernible in the action of the respondents requiring judicial interference.

The application is accordingly dismissed.

There shall, however, be no order as to costs.

cancellation of posts of Junior Accounts Assistant by Notice dated 12.08.2002 published in the daily "The Assam Tribune" on 14.08.2002 and for quashing and setting aside the same, and for declaring result of the written examination held on 25.3.2001 for the post of Junior Accounts Assistant.

2. Jurisdiction:

The applicant declares that the subject matter of the application is within the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Tribunal.

3. Limitation:

The applicant declares that the application is within the period of limitation under section 21 of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

4. Facts of the case:

4.1 That the applicant is a citizen of India and as such is entitled to the rights and privileges guaranteed by the constitution of India. The applicant is a member of OBC community.

4.2 That the respondent authorities published an employment notice No.1/96 dated 20.05.1996 in the daily news paper "The Assam Tribune" on 22.05.1996 inviting applications from the eligible candidates for 39 category of posts including the post of Junior Accounts Assistants. The post of Junior Accounts Assistant was listed under the category No.37 and it carries scale of pay Rs.1200-2040/-.

The applications under category No.37 were invited for filling up 31 vacancies out of which 15 were unreserved, 4 were reserved for SC, 6 were reserved for ST and rest 6 were reserved for OBC. The application fees for the above post was Rs.30/- which required to be paid by crossed Indian Postal Order in favour of the Assistant Secretary, RRB/Guwahati. The closing date for all such applications was 30.06.1996.

Copy of the employment notice No.1/96 dated 20.5.1996 is enclosed as Annexure 'A'.

4.3 That the minimum educational qualification prescribed for the above post was Bachelors Degree. The applicant is a Commerce Graduate and being eligible he applied for the above post of Junior Accounts Assistant with a fees of Rs.30/- before the last date i.e.30.06.1996.

4.4 That in the year 1997 the new incumbent of the office of respondent No.3 published a Re-advertisement Notice No.RRB/GHY/2/1/Pt.-V in the daily news paper "The Assam Tribune" on 29.04.1997 in continuation to the advertisement of Employment Notice No.1/96 dated 20.5.1996 without mentioning reason for the same. By this re-advertisement notice applications were invited for all the earlier 39 categories including the post of Junior Accounts Assistant from the eligible candidates who have not applied previously i.e. in response to the Employment Notice No.1/96 dated 20.5.1996. It is submitted that the said

re-advertisement after the closing date for application i.e. 30.6.1996 was made for accommodating candidates who have not applied earlier.

Copy of the Re-advertisement Notice No.RRB/GHY/2/1/Ft.-V is enclosed as Annexure 'B'.

4.5 That thereafter, call letters for the written examination were issued to all the eligible candidates including the applicant. The written examination for Category No.37 was held on 9.11.1997 in which the applicant appeared and did very well. But most unfortunately the said written examination was cancelled on account of irregularities. The notification of cancellation of the said examination was published in "The Assam Tribune" on 26.2.2001. In the said notification fresh date for above written examination was fixed on 25.03.2001.

Copy of the Notification dated 26.2.2001 is enclosed as Annexure 'C'.

4.6 That call letter for the written examination on 25.3.2001 was also issued to the applicant and Roll Number allotted to him was 14370470. The applicant appeared in the written examination on 25.3.2001 and this time also he did very well in the examination. But this time also the respondents cancelled the written examination dated 25.03.2001 of Category No.37 by a Notice published in "The Assam Tribune" on 15.9.2001, and the reason for such cancellation was said to be of administrative.

Copy of the call letter and Notice published on 15.9.2001 are enclosed as

Annexure 'D' & 'E' respectively.

4.7 That the applicant begs to state that the respondents have cancelled the written examination of category No.37 first time on the ground of irregularities and second time on the administrative ground. It is humbly submitted that some irregularities like snatching of question papers were happened in the written examination of Category No.2 of Employment Notice No.1/2001 and complaint was lodged against it but examination for the same was not cancelled by the respondent authorities. Similarly same incident happened in the written examination of Category No.2 of Employment Notice No.1/2000 which was held on 7.4.2002 and complaint was lodged to the respondents office as well as to the Bharalumukh Police Station, Guwahati. But surprisingly none of the above examinations were cancelled by the respondents. It is mentioned that the result of written examination of said Category No.2 of Employment Notice No.1/2000 has been declared and published in "The Assam Tribune" on 9.7.2002.

4.8 That the applicant begs to state that he fulfilled all the conditions and requirements of the offer of the respondents (payment of examination fees etc.) in Employment Notice No.1/96 dated 20.5.1996 and hence he has right to know the result of the examination in which he appeared and the respondents are also bound to declare the same.

4.9 That the applicant begs to state that a representation was made by 82 candidates including the applicant on 17.2.2002 to the respondent No.2 for conducting

re-examination of the cancelled written test of category No.37 of Employment Notice No.1/96 without any favourable result. The respondent No.2 has received the said representation dated 17.2.2002 and Acknowledgement Card was received back by the applicant on 19.4.2002.

Copy of the representation dated 17.4.2002 along with the Acknowledgement Card is enclosed as Annexure 'F'.

4.10 That thereafter, by a Notice dated 12.8.2002 published in "The Assam Tribune" on 14.08.2002 the respondents have reduced the post of Junior Accounts Assistant along with some other posts to zero and consequently the written examinations were cancelled. It is humbly submitted that the respondents have the right to reduce or increase posts with some reasonableness. The number of vacancies declared both in the initial advertisement and re-advertisement against said Category No.37 i.e. the post of Junior Accounts Assistant were 31. The position of vacancies were same all along from the date of employment Notice No.1/96 i.e. 20.5.1996 to the date of last written examination i.e. 25.03.2001. It is stated that even on 15.9.2001 when cancellation of said written examination was notified the vacancies in the post of category No. 37 existed, and now all of a sudden the respondents have decided and reduced the said post to zero in most colourable fashion. It is submitted that the respondents have reduced the said post to zero for the cause under camouflage and such colourable exercise is arbitrary and against the policy of administrative fair play. It is

also respectfully submitted that such colourable exercise of the respondents shall be found patent on the record if the Hon'ble Tribunal be pleased to lift the veil.

Copy of the Notice dated 12.8.2002 published on 14.8.2002 is enclosed as Annexure 'G'.

5. Grounds for reliefs with legal provisions:

5.1 For that the respondents have cancelled the written examination held on 25.3.2001 for the extraneous reason. ✓

5.2 For that the respondents have reduced the post of Junior Accounts Assistant in a most colourable fashion.

5.3 For that the respondents have most arbitrarily and in colourable exercise of power have cancelled the examination held on 25.3.2001 which offends Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India.

5.4 For that the respondents have reduced the post of Junior Accounts Assistant to zero for the cause under camouflage.

5.6 For that the actions of the respondents are against the policy of administrative fair play.

5.7 For that in any view of the matter the actions of the respondents are illegal, impropriety of power and bad in the eyes of law.

6. Details of remedies exhausted:

There is no other efficacious remedy under any rule and this Hon'ble Tribunal is the only forum for redressal of the grievance.

7. Matters not previously filed or pending before any other Court:

The applicant declares that he has not filed any other case in any tribunal, Court or any other forum against the impugned order.

8. Reliefs sought for :

Under the facts and circumstances of the case, the applicant prays for the following reliefs :

8.1 The Notice dated 12.08.2002 published in the daily "The Assam Tribune" on 14.08.2002 be set aside and quashed.

8.2 The result of the written examination for the post of Junior Accounts Assistant held on 25.03.2001 be declared.

8.3 Any other relief/reliefs the Hon'ble tribunal may deem fit and proper.

The above reliefs are prayed for on the grounds stated in para 5 above.

## Threat to world health process

GENEVA, May 21— The overuse of medicines and abuse of nature have combined with the age-old problem of poverty and the modern luxury of international travel to produce a devastating upsurge in infectious diseases, a new report says.

The report by the World Health Organisation warns that the spread of untreatable forms of Malaria and tuberculosis and the emergence of killers like AIDS and ebola threaten to undermine recent advances in health care.

"We are standing on the brink of a global crisis in infectious diseases," WHO Director-General Dr. Hiroshi Nakajima said.

The optimism of a relatively few years ago that many of these diseases could be brought under control has led to a fatal complacency. This complacency

is now costing millions of lives. WHO issued the World Health report, 1996 on the opening day of its week-long annual assembly.

There is some good news. Globally, life expectancy is now 65. Three years higher than in 1985. Infant mortality has halved in 30 years to 60 deaths per 1,000 live births. This has encouraged women to have fewer babies an average three per family in 1995 compared to 3.2 in 1990 although the planet remains dangerously overcrowded.

Eight out of ten children are immunised against killers like measles. Polio is on the verge of following smallpox into history. Leprosy, too, may soon become an evil of the past.

But overall, the 137-page report makes gloomy reading—AP

## Lee sworn in as Taiwan President

TAIPEI, May 21— Lee Teng-hui was sworn in as Taiwan's first-popularly elected President and offered to meet with China's leaders for talks on ending their 49 years of hostility, reports AP.

Offering to take a personal lead, he said he wanted to meet and directly exchange opinions with the Chinese Communist leaders to open a new era in dialogue and cooperation.

In the future, if necessary for the country, I am willing to embark on a journey for peace to the Chinese mainland, carrying with me the common wishes of our 21 million people. Mr Lee told 50,000 people packing a stadium outside Taipei.

Mr Lee's eagerly awaited speech, at the stadium in

contained no specific offers of compromise, but sought to strike a conciliatory note.

He also flatly ruled out making Taiwan independent and dumping the doctrine that Taiwan and China are one country.

Calling independents unnecessary and impossible, he added, I am deeply convinced that the Chinese people shall complete the historical task of peaceful unification in the 21st century.

Meanwhile, he said, we in Taiwan have realized the dream of all Chinese. We have created an eye-catching economic miracle, and achieved world-acclaimed democratic reforms.

Those reforms, which led to the first presidential election by universal suffrage, were largely

## Pope-Dalai Lama meet at Vatican

VATICAN CITY, May 21—Pope John Paul II received Tibet's exiled spiritual leader, the Dalai Lama, at a private audience at the Vatican yesterday.

The Vatican press office confirmed the meeting had taken place without giving details. A Vatican source called it a spiritual meeting of prayer and of exchanges of ideas on religious themes.

The Holy See's official daily bulletin of the POPE's activities, which usually lists private audiences, made no mention of the meeting with the Dalai Lama.

The Vatican is keen not to anger Beijing and impede efforts to return to its fold China's state-controlled Catholic Church, whose followers are prohibited from paying allegiance to the Pope.

China accuses the Dalai Lama, who fled into exile in 1959 after an abortive uprising against Chinese rule over Tibet, of continuing to foster Tibetan independence from his home in India.

In recent days, China has ordered police to crack down on Tibetan separatists and residents in Tibet reported today that authorities had widened a ban on pictures of the Dalai Lama from monasteries and temples to include schools and homes.

The Dalai Lama, who is still widely venerated among Buddhists in the deeply religious region, has used his three-day visit to Italy to call for more autonomy for Tibet.

## Father kills 4 children

BAREILLY, May 21—A person killed his four children, aged between two and nine, before killing himself by consuming insecticide near Almora in Garhwal Region of Uttar Pradesh, reports reaching here said.

The 37-year-old Purnan Singh yesterday bolted his two sons and two daughters in a room and slit their throats with a sharp edged weapon. He later consumed large quantity of insecticide and was found dead at a little distance from his house in Khanerudhar village in Bageswar Tehsil, police said.

The cruel incident occurred when his wife had gone to the nearby forest to graze the cattle, they said.

The cause of the killings was yet to be ascertained. PTI
