JUDGMENT AND ORDER (ORAL)

P.G.AGARWAL,J.- Heard Mr. B.C. Pathak, learned counsel assisted by Mr. B. Pathak and Mr. D. Barua, appearing on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. G.K. Bhattacharyya, learned senior counsel for the respondent applicant Betha Ram Saikia.

2. The respondent applicant Betha Ram Saikia, a member of the Scheduled Tribe community, joined as Junior Engineer (Civil) under the Department of Telecommunications, Government of India on 3.7.72 and thereafter, he was promoted to the rank of Assistant Engineer with effect from 16.12.78. The applicant, thereafter, passed the requisite departmental qualifying examination for inclusion of his name in the All India Seniority List for promotion to the next post of Executive Engineer. However, the concerned authority failed to include his name in the said All India Seniority List and as such he was deprived from consideration of his name for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer and persons below him were considered and promoted vide order dated, 23.1.03. The applicant, thereafter, approached the Central Administrative Tribunal, Guwahati Bench, Guwahati by filing O.A. No. 24/ 2003. The said petition was contested by the present petitioner Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited, for short, 'the BSNL' and the said petition was disposed of by the Tribunal vide impugned judgment with the following directions:-

"(i) In view of the law laid down by the Bangalore Bench of this Tribunal, the respondents' objection that in the absence of notification issue by Section 14 (2) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the present application as the applicant is working under BSNL, is overruled;

(ii) In view of the respondents' statement made in paragraph 12 of the reply that the present application is premature as neither the provisional seniority list has been finalized nor the applicant has been regularly promoted to the grade of Assistant Engineer

(Civil) and on the other hand contending that the cause of action is time barred and therefore the present application is hit by delay and laches is found to be inconsistent and contradictory on the face of it and accordingly the said plea is rejected;

(iii) Since the applicant was promoted as Assistant Engineer (Civil) vide order dated 13.11.1978 (Annexure-I) and continues to be functioning in the said post without any break or reversion, is held to be holding the said post on regular basis particularly in view of the law noticed hereinabove;

(iv) As the applicant is functioning as Assistant Engineer (Civil) since 13.11.1978, the respondents' action in not including his name in the provisional seniority list issued for the said cadre is held to be illegal;

(v) accordingly a direction is issued to respondents to include the applicant's name at appropriate place in the seniority list of the said cadre with all consequential benefits including right to promotion to the next higher post of Executive Engineer or further promotion, if any. Consequently, the respondents no. 1-4 are directed to consider him for promotion to the grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) from the date his juniors were promoted vide order dated 23.11.2003. However, he will not be entitled to any back wages on the said account.

(vi) The aforesaid exercise shall be completed as early as possible and in any event within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the order.

(vii) No costs.

3. Feeling aggrieved, the BSNL has filed the present writ petition. Mr. Pathak, learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to a decision of the Division Bench of this Court dated 28.9.05 whereby a batch of writ petitions were disposed of by this Court wherein it was held that in the absence of any Notification u/s 14 (2) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction over the BSNL employees. At this stage, Mr. G.K. Bhattacharyya, learned senior counsel has submitted that the applicant was not absorbed by the BSNL when he had approached the Tribunal and he was serving on deputation only and we find that this fact has been noted by the Tribunal. However, Mr. G.K. Bhattacharyya was fair enough to submit that during the pendency of the application, the applicant was absorbed vide order dated 7.5.04 whereas the

impugned judgment was passed on 13.5.04. It is also submitted that the fact of absorption was not informed to the applicant and as such he was not aware of the same on that day. On the other hand, the present petitioner BSNL ^{also} did not inform the Central Administrative Tribunal about absorption of the applicant in the BSNL. Mr. G.K. Bhattacharyya further submits that the applicant had put in 34 years of service and now he is in the verge of retirement and even if the impugned order is set aside on the ground of lack of jurisdiction, the petitioner would have to approach this court again for necessary relief and by the time the matter is heard and disposed of, he will retire from service without any benefits.

4. So far the question of jurisdiction is concerned, the matter stands settled by the Division Bench decision of this court as quoted above and we reiterate the same. However, considering the facts of the present case and as submitted by the learned counsel for both sides, we propose to dispose of this writ petition on merit.

5. The broad facts of the case as stated above are not in dispute. The applicant Betha Ram Saikia was promoted as Assistant Engineer in the year 1978 and since then he is serving as Assistant Engineer without any break in service. The petitioner BSNL came up with a plea that the said promotion was on adhoc basis. There can not be any promotion on adhoc basis continuing for long 20 years and as a matter of fact, the applicant was given the benefits of assured career progression and all other consequential benefits of promotion. The applicant also participated in the qualifying examination. The applicant came up with the plea that he had cleared the qualifying examination in the year 1983-86 and from the pleadings made in the petition, we find that the above plea was never challenged or disputed.

6. Thus, we find that the applicant has been wrongly deprived of his right for promotion when the applicant had the requisite eligibility criteria and he had right to be considered for promotion. Whether promotion is given or not is altogether a different matter. The non

inclusion of the name of the applicant was due to the fault of the employer and for that the applicant can not be penalized. The fact that certain persons, namely, K.H. Ramappa, U.N. Naik and M.S. Rajmohan Prasad, who were junior to the applicant have been promoted vide order dated 23.1.03 is also not disputed before us.

7. In view of the above, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to the petitioner BSNL to consider the case of the applicant Betha Ram Saikia for promotion to the Grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) from the date when his juniors were promoted. The applicant will, however, not be entitled to any back wages.

8. The above exercise shall be completed within a period of two months from the date of this order.

9. The writ petition stands disposed of as aforesaid.

SHRI MUKESH KUMAR GUPTA, MEMBER (J)

In this application a challenge has been made to the action of respondent nos.1 to 4 in not including the applicant's name in the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) despite representations made by him and consequently not promoting him to the next higher grade of Executive Engineer (Civil), overlooking him, though several of his juniors were promoted vide order dated 23rd January, 2003.

2. The actual matrix of the facts are that: The applicant who belong to Scheduled Tribe community, after completing Diploma Course in Civil Engineering in the year 1971, joined as Junior Engineer (Civil) on 3rd July, 1972. During the course of service, he was promoted to the next higher grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil) with effect from 16.12.1978 vide P&T Board Order No.64-11/78-CW (P&T) dated 28.10.1978 (Annexure-I). In the All India Seniority List of Junior Engineers as on 1.10.1979, his name was included at sl.no.166. His name was also included in the All India Eligibility List of Junior Engineers for promotion to the grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil) issued vide memo dated 6.6.1989 at sl.no.125(A). Respondents 5 to 7 appeared at sl.nos. 171, 199 and 356 respectively in the said All India Eligibility List. It is contended that the applicant cleared all the departmental accounts papers for the

post of Assistant Engineer (Civil). It is stated that a notification dated 27th September, 1989 was issued by the Telecom Board, which did not include his name and as such he submitted a representation dated 17.10.1989 with a prayer to include his name but there was no response. He submitted several representations/appeal followed by various reminders like 22nd December, 1997, 1998, 29.11.99 and 26th June, 2000. He was assured by the authorities that the mistake in not including his name would be rectified but no positive action had been taken by the respondents. All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) was again issued on 15th March, 2001 but the same did not include his name. Another notification dated 15th March, 2002 was issued circulating provisional seniority list in the grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil) which also omitted the applicant's name. The applicant submitted representation dated 4.4.2001 which was duly forwarded to the concerned authorities but no action had been taken. In the meantime, based on DOP&T O.M dated 9th August, 1999, on completion of 24 years of service, the applicant was granted second financial upgradation under ACP Scheme vide order dated 27.12.2000. The respondents also issued a provisional seniority list of Assistant Engineer (Civil) on 21st September, 2001 which also omitted the applicant's name for no rhyme or reasons. Instead of rectifying the mistakes/omission, the respondents issued order dated 23rd January, 2003 promoting 21 officials to the next higher grade of

Executive Engineer (Civil), including respondents 5 to 7 who were juniors to the applicant. Being aggrieved with the respondents action, the present application has been preferred the present O.A.

3. Shri G.K. Bhattacharya, learned Senior Advocate assisted by Shri B. Choudhury contended that the action of the authorities in omitting the applicant's name from the All India Seniority list is illegal, arbitrary and discriminatory besides being violative of the principles of natural justice. Despite the fact that the applicant was allowed second financial upgradation on completion of 24 years of service, his name had not been included in the seniority list without any rhyme or reasons. Instead of rectifying the mistake/omission in not including the applicant's name in the seniority list, the respondents promoted 21 officials including 3 of his juniors to the next higher grade of Executive Engineer (Civil), which action under no circumstances could be justified.

4. The respondents 1 to 4 on the other hand filed the reply and contested the applicant's claim. Shri B.C. Pathak, learned Additional Central Government Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents raised following contentions:

(a) That the present application is barred by law of limitation and suffers from laches. The applicant

remained silent for nearly 14 years and it is well settled law that the settled position after a long period of time cannot be unsettled.

(b) The next contention raised by the learned counsel was that this Tribunal has no jurisdiction as the applicant is working in BSNL. In the absence of specific notification under Section 14 (2) of The Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985, this Tribunal would have no jurisdiction to entertain the present application.

On merits it was contended that since the applicant was not a regular Assistant Engineer (Civil), his name did not appear in the seniority list and accordingly he was not considered for promotion to the next higher post of Executive Engineer. The provisional seniority list dated 21st September, 2001 would be finalised only after considering all the representations made including that of the applicant. The name of the applicant was not included in the seniority list of Assistant Engineer (C) as he had not passed the prescribed departmental qualifying examination which was essential for regularisation in the said cadre and the said fact was so admitted by the applicant in his representation filed as Annexure-A3 dated 17th October, 1989.

In para-12 of the reply statement the respondents stated as follows: "The application is premature as neither the provisional seniority list has been finalised nor the applicant has been regularly promoted to the grade of AE (C)." In view of the above, it was contended that the present application is time barred by delay and laches. Strong reliance was placed by Shri B.C. Pathak, learned counsel for the respondents on AIR 1999 SC 1510 (B.S. Bajwa and Another vs. State of Punjab & Others) & CAT Full Bench Decision, Vol.III, Page 206 (Kamal Kishore Narang vs. Union of India & Others), AIR 1990 SC 10 (S.S. Rathore vs. State of M.P.), 1993 (1) ATR 855 (SC) (Ratan Chandra Samanta vs. Union of India), 1998 SCC (I&S) 611 (B.S. Baweja vs. State of Punjab), 2002 (1) SLJ 352 - Delhi High Court (Shri Ram Gopal Verma vs. Union of India and Anr.) & 2003 (3) SLJ 251 - Lucknow Bench (Sudhir Sharma vs. Union of India).


5. We heard learned counsel for the parties at length and perused the pleadings carefully.

The first and foremost issue which needs determination is whether the present application is hit by limitation. In other words, is it time barred? As noted herein above, the respondents in reply para-12 have stated in specific that neither provisional

seniority list has been finalised nor the applicant has been promoted on regular basis in the grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil). Once the respondents contend that the application is premature, then how in the same breath they can be allowed to contend that the application is time barred. Such contradictory and conflicting contentions cannot be accepted on the face of it. Therefore, the respondents plea that the present application is time barred is misconceived and accordingly rejected.

6. The second fundamental issue which need determination is whether this Tribunal has jurisdiction over the issues raised, as contended by the respondents. It was vociferously contended by the respondents that the applicant even as on date is working in BSNI and in the absence of notification issued under Section 14 (2) of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985, conferring jurisdiction of this Tribunal over the employees of BSNI, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the present application. It is undisputed fact that the applicant as on date has not been absorbed in BSNI. It is also admitted that the applicant is neither a Group 'C' or Group 'D' employee but holding a Group 'B' post. It is also indisputed fact that that the applicant's basic grievance is non-inclusion of his name in All India Seniority list, for which inaction, cause arose




when he was working in the Department of Communication.

A coordinate Bench of this Tribunal at Bangalore in O.A. No.810/1996 decided on 5.6.2002, on a similar issue of jurisdiction over the employees of BSNI held as follows:-

"....If that is so, whenever the services of a person holding the civil post under the Central Government are placed at the disposal of such Corporation, this Tribunal has jurisdiction in view of Section 14(1)(b)(iii) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985 ('AT Act' for short). While considering Section 14(1)(b)(iii) of the AT Act, in O.A.No.58 of 2001 and connected cases, vide judgment and order dated 2-05-2002, this Tribunal, by following the judgment of the Central Administrative Tribunal, Delhi Bench in C.P. Mathur Vs. Union of India and others [(1992) 21 ATC 185] has held that under Section 14(1)(b)(iii) this Tribunal has jurisdiction regarding the service of a person placed at the disposal of any Corporation or Society 'owned' or 'controlled' by Government of India. In this view of the matter, we are of the considered opinion that this Tribunal has jurisdiction regarding the Central Government employees deputed to the Corporation which is under the control of the Central Government." (emphasis supplied)

The aforesaid law was recently followed by Bangalore Bench vide its judgement and order dated 7th October, 2003 passed in O.A. No.736/2002, G. Ramanathan vs. Union of India and Others. We may note that the applicant has not yet been absorbed in the BSNI and he continues to be on deemed deputation to BSNI. In view of the law noticed herein above, which squarely applies to the facts of the present case, we overrule the objection raised by the respondents and hold that this Tribunal has jurisdiction regarding the applicant's grievance who is placed at the disposal of BSNI owned/controlled by the Government of India.

7. Next and last issue which require determination is whether the applicant could be said to be promoted on officiating basis as Assistant Engineer (Civil) purely on adhoc and temporary basis, particularly when he has neither been reverted nor there is any break of any nature in the said post. Learned Senior Advocate Shri Bhattacharya strongly urged that under no circumstances a person who was promoted on officiating basis in the year 1978 could be treated on adhoc basis particularly when he has put in more than 25 years of service and he continues to work in the said post without any interruption or break. On the other hand, not only his annual increments were released, even he was allowed to cross efficiency bar. Not only these, he was even granted the second financial upgradation on completion of 24 years of service in terms of DOP&T O.M dated 9th August, 1999. Further, it was emphasised that the applicant had cleared all the departmental accounts paper of Assistant Engineer (C) as early as in the year 1983 - 1986. A specific averment to the said aspect was made in para-4.2 of the O.A. learned Senior counsel produced before us the result of Departmental Examination for Assistant Engineers (Civil)/(DR)/AEs and Asstt. Director of Hort. held from 20th to 24th December, 1982 to show that the applicant passed the Paper-B (i.e. Accounts Paper II) in the year 1983 for which the examination was held from 20th to 24th December, 1982. Similarly, vide communication dated

22nd January, 1987, which circulated the list of officials who had qualified in the departmental qualifying examination for the said post, show that the applicant had passed I and III paper. Similarly order dated 22nd December, 2000 granting applicant second financial upgradation in the pay scale of Rs. 10,000-15,2000 on completion of 24 years of service was also produced before us. On the query raised by the Bench; particularly to the said order, the respondents were unable to react to the said aspects.

8. We may note that it is well settled law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Narender Chadha & Ors. vs. Union of India & Ors.* (1986 2 SCC 157), that an appointment cannot be treated as adhoc or temporary especially when the official continues to work for fifteen to twenty years without any break. Paragraph 21 reads as follows:

"As observed in *D.R. Nim, I.P.S v. Union of India* [1967] 2 S.C.R. 325 when an officer has worked for a long period as in this case for nearly fifteen to twenty years in a post and had never been reverted it cannot be held that the officer's continuous officiation was a mere temporary or local or stop gap arrangement even though the order of appointment may state so. In such circumstances the entire period of officiation has to be counted for seniority."

9. The ratio laid down in the aforementioned case squarely applies to the facts of the present case. Following the ratio laid down in the aforementioned judgements, we are of the considered view that under no

circumstances the applicant who is working as Assistant Engineer (Civil) since 1978 could be treated as adhoc and temporary as projected by the respondents. At no point of time the applicant was ever informed about his being treated in the said post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) as adhoc and temporary. When the applicant was allowed all the increments which fell due, as well as allowed to cross the efficiency bar besides grant of second financial upgradation and also the fact that he was never reverted from the said post even for a day, i.e. technical break, it would not be justified to treat the applicant as Assistant Engineer on adhoc and temporary basis. When the applicant had passed the departmental qualifying examination in the year 1983-86, why he was not regularised, remained unexplained by the respondents.

10. In view of the discussion made hereinabove, we find merits in the applicant's contention that there was no justification in not including his name in the All India Seniority list of Assistant Engineer (Civil). Since the applicant's name was not included in the All India Seniority list of Assistant Engineer (Civil) without any justification, he was deprived of the right of consideration to the next promotional post of Executive Engineer (Civil). The placement of respondents 5 to 7 in the eligibility list dated 23.6.1989 was also not disputed. This being the

position, we find that had the applicant's name been figured at the appropriate place in the All India Seniority list of Assistant Engineer (Civil), he would not have been deprived of the right of consideration for promotion to the next higher post of Executive Engineer (Civil).

11. In view of the foregoing discussion, the present application is allowed by passing the following order:-

(i) In view of the law laid down by the Bangalore Bench of this Tribunal, the respondents' objection that in the absence of notification issue by Section 14 (2) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, the Tribunal has no jurisdiction to entertain the present application as the applicant is working under BSNI, is overruled;

(ii) In view of the respondents' statement made in paragraph 12 of the reply that the present application is premature as neither the provisional seniority list has been finalised nor the applicant has been regularly promoted to the grade of Assistant Engineer (Civil) and on the other hand contending that the cause of action is time barred and therefore the present application is hit by delay and laches is found to be inconsistent and contradictory on the face of it and accordingly the said plea is rejected;

(iii) Since the applicant was promoted as Assistant Engineer (Civil) vide order dated 13.11.1978 (Annexure-I) and continues to be functioning in the said post without any break or reversion, is held to be holding the said post on regular basis particularly in view of the law noticed hereinabove;


(iv) As the applicant is functioning as Assistant Engineer (Civil) since 13.11.1978, the respondents' action in not including his name in the provisional seniority list issued for the said cadre is held to be illegal;


(v) accordingly a direction is issued to respondents to include the applicant's name at appropriate place in the seniority list of the said cadre with all consequential benefits including right to promotion to the next higher post of Executive Engineer or further promotion, if any. Consequently, the respondents no.1-4 are directed to consider him for promotion to the grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) from the date his juniors were promoted vide order dated 23.1.2003. However, he will not be entitled to any back wages on the said account.

(vi) The aforesaid exercise shall be completed as early as possible and in any event within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the order.

(vii) No costs.

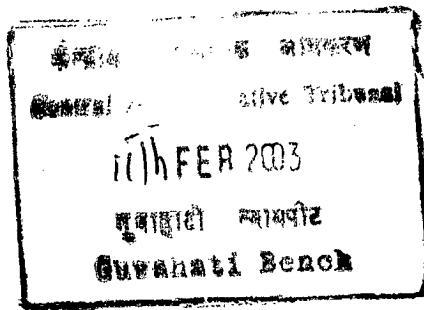

1. PARTICULARS OF THE ORDER AGAINST WHICH THE
APPLICATION IS MADE.

- i) Illegal and arbitrary action of the authorities in not including the name of the applicant in the All India Seniority list of Assistant Engineer (Civil) since long in spite of several representations.
- ii) Illegal and arbitrary action of the authorities in denying the applicant



advancement in career by not including his name in the All India Seniority list of Assistant Engineer (Civil) even after his name appearing in the Zonal Seniority List.

- iii) Order No. 3-2/2002-CWG dt. 23.01.03 issued by Under Secretary (CWG) whereby 21 Officers were promoted to the grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) including Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 who are juniors to the applicant.

2. JURISDICTION OF THE TRIBUNAL:

The applicant declares that the subject matter of the order against which he wants redressal is within the jurisdiction of this Tribunal.

3. LIMITATION :

The applicant further declares that the application is within the limitation prescribed under Section 21 of the Administration Tribunal Act, 1985.

4. FACTS OF THE CASE :

1. That the applicant begs to state that he belongs to Schedule Tribe Community and after completing his diploma course in Civil Engineering from Dibrugarh Polytechnic in the year 1971, he joined service under the Post and



Telegraphs Department as Junior Engineer (Civil) on 3.7.72 and was posted at Shillong. Thereafter the applicant in recognition of his faithful and commendable service was promoted to the post of Assistant Engineer (Civil) w.e.f. 16.12.78 vide P & T Board Order No. 64-11/78-CW (P&T) dated 28.10.78 through order dt: 13.11.78.

A copy of the promotion order is annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure-I**.

2. That the applicant begs to state that in the All India seniority of Junior Engineers on 1.10.79 published by the authority his name appeared at serial No. 166 and in eligibility list issued vide Memo No. 8 (9)87/TCC/SH/1215 dated 24.6.89 his name appeared at serial No. 125 (A) whereas the name of the Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 appeared at serial No. 171, 199 and 356. The applicant further states that he has also (cleared) all the departmental Accounts paper of Assistant Engineer (C).

The relevant extract of the All India Eligibility of Junior Engineers (C) is annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure-II**.

3. That, thereafter, the applicant came over the Telecom Board's notification No. 57/89-CWG dated 27.9.89 which shocked and surprise him when he found his name omitted in the list of All India Promotion list of Officers who were allowed to officiate on regular basis as Assistant Engineer (Civil) in the scale of Rs. 2000/- to Rs. 3500/-. Thereafter immediately on 17.10.89 the applicant filed a representation/objection before the Telecom Board with the prayer that his name be included in the list, but there was no response.

A copy of the representation /objection is annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-III.

4. That the applicant begs to state that as he did not got any response to his representation/appeal dated 17.10.89, the appellant again on 22.12.97, 1998, 29.11.99 and 26.06.2000 filed several representations/appeals before the Respondent No.4 for inclusion of his name in All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (C) which were duly forwarded to Respondent No.2 and 3 for necessary action and all the time the authorities assured him that the mistake will be rectified.

5. That the applicant begs to state that the authorities instead of including his name in the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) again on 15.3.01, the office of Respondent No.4 vide its notification No.1 (59) 2000/ CE-ASM/GH/43 dated 15.3.02 circulated Provisional Seniority List in the grade of Assistant Engineers (Civil) issued by the Joint Deputy Director General (B.W.) by its office memorandum No. 5-1/2001-CSE dated 27.02.01. The ~~applicant~~ was again surprised when he found his name omitted from the seniority list while the name of officers who are junior to him including the name of Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 appeared in the list. The name of Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 appeared at serial No. 285, 286 and 370. The appellant immediately on 4.4.2001 submitted his representation before the authority, which was duly forwarded by Respondent No.4 to Respondent No.3 for necessary action.

6. That the applicant begs to state that in the meantime the applicant got Assured Career Progression Scheme (known as ACP) after completion of 24 years service vide order No.3-1/2000-CWG dated 27.12.2000.
7. That the applicant begs to state that the authorities again on 21.9.2001 circulated a Provisional Seniority List of Assistant Engineers (Civil) in the P & T Civil Wing and there also the name of the applicant was omitted for no apparent reason. The applicant thereafter on 17.8.02 ~~and 28.11.2002~~ filed representation for inclusion of his name in the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (C) and allotment of Staff number, which ~~was~~ duly forwarded.

Copy of the representation ^{forwarding letters is} along with ~~annexed~~ herewith and marked as **Annexure-VII** (Series).



8. That the applicant was hoping that this time the authorities shall rectify the mistake/omission and grant him promotion to Executive Engineer (Civil) to which he is otherwise eligible. But the authorities instead of rectifying the mistake/omission has now issued impugned order No. 3-2/2002-CWG date 23.1.03 issued by Under Secretary (CWG) to the Government of India whereby ~~21~~ Officers were promoted to the grade of Executive Engineer (civil) including Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 who are junior to the applicant. This action of the authorities showed that they have rejected his representation/appeal dt. ~~17.02~~.2002 without assigning any reason.

Copy of the impugned order dated 23.01.03 is annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure-VIII.**

9. That the applicant has become highly aggrieved by the impugned actions of the authorities in not including his name in the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) thereby depriving him further advancement in career and as such he is approaching this Hon'ble Tribunal for relief. The applicant has come to know that the authorities are initiating process to fill up some more

vacancies in the Grade of Executive Engineer (C) and as such unless some interim orders are passed the applicant will suffer irreparable loss and injury.

5. GROUND'S FOR RELIEF WITH LEGAL PROVISIONS :

- I. For that the action of the authorities in omitting the name of the applicant from the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) is highly illegal, arbitrary, discriminatory and in violation of principle of natural justice and as such the impugned action of the authorities is bad in law and is liable to be set.
- II. For that the authorities by not including the name of the applicant in the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) has denied him promotional opportunities/advancement in career which amounts to violation of Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India and as such the applicant is approaching this Hon'ble Tribunal for appropriate relief.
- III. For that the action of the authorities in promoting 21 officers to the grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) including Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 who are Junior to the applicant without solving the genuine



grievance of the applicant is highly discriminatory and the same is bad in law.

IV. For that, the authorities did not make a fair assessment and instead of rectifying the omission/mistake on their part, the authorities by promoting 21 officers to the grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) including his juniors have rejected the appeal of the applicant without any reason and as such the same is bad in law and is liable to be set aside.

V. For that, in any view of the matter, the impugned action of the authorities is bad in law and is liable to be set aside.

6. DETAILS OF REMEDIES EXHAUSTED:

The applicant had submitted a representation dated 17.08.02 and the authorities by promoting 21 officers to the grade of Executive Engineer (Civil) including his juniors i.e. Respondent No.5, 6 and 7 have rejected the same.

7. MATTERS NOT PREVIOUSLY FILED OR PENDING WITH ANY OTHER COURT :


The applicant further declares that he has not previously filed any application, writ petition or suit regarding the matter in respect of which this application has been made before any Court or any other authority or any other Bench of the



Tribunal nor any such application, Writ petition or suit is pending before any of them.

8. PRAYER:

It is, therefore, prayed that Your Lordships would be pleased to admit this application, call for the entire records of the case, ask the respondents to show cause as to why the name of the applicant should not be included in the All India Seniority List and thereafter promote him to Executive Engineer (C) and after perusing the causes shown, if any and hearing the parties direct the respondents to include the name of the applicant in the All India Seniority List of Assistant Engineer (Civil) and thereafter promote him to Executive Engineer (C) from the date when his juniors were so promoted with all consequential benefits and/or pass any other order/orders as



Your Lordships may deem fit and proper so as to grant adequate relief to the applicant.

It is, further prayed that pending disposal of the applications, Your Lordships would be pleased to direct the Respondents not to fill up any future vacancies in the Grade of Executive Engineer (C) and/or pass any other order/orders as Your Lordships may deem fit and proper.

(WRITTEN STATEMENTS FILLED BY THE RESPONDENT NO. 1 to 4)

1. That the copies of the above noted O.A. No.24/2003 (hereinafter referred to as the "**application**") has been served on the respondents. The respondents have gone through the same and understood the contents thereof. The interest of all the respondents being common and similar, the written statements are to be treated as common to all of them.
2. That the statements made in the application which are not specifically admitted by the respondents are hereby denied.
3. That at the first instance, the answering respondents want to raise the preliminary objection that the application is barred by the law of limitation. The cause of action against which the application has been made before this Hon'ble Tribunal arose in the year 1989 as submitted by the applicant. The applicant remained silent for nearly 14 years and therefore, the application being time barred, it is liable to be dismissed with cost on this ground alone. The cause of action of the application is non-inclusion of the name of the applicant in the Provisional Seniority List of 1989. The seniority list was finalized and notified in June 1994. The applicant did not make any representation or raised any other objection at the relevant point of time against the said list. Hence, the application is hopelessly time-barred. In view of this fact, the seniority list finalized and notified in June 1994 has already attained finality and many persons have accordingly settled in their respective positions with seniority,

The law is well settled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court that a settled position after a long period of time can not be unsettled even if right of some one is prejudiced (reported in **AIR 1999 SC 1510 & CAT Full Bench Decision, Vol. III, Page – 206**).

PARA-WISE COMMENTS :

4. That with regard to the statements made in **para 1 (I) & 1 (ii)** of the application, the answering respondents state that the cause of action of the instant application relates back to the year 1989 and the same attained its finality by June 1994. At best, the matter could have been raised in the Court of Law on or before one and half years for the said date as provided under Section 20 and 21 of the Central Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"). But in fact, the applicant woke up only when the Provisional Seniority List was published vide O.M. No.5-1/2001-CSE dated 21.9.2001. The provisional list dated 21.9.2001 would be finalized only after considering all the representations. The representation, if any, submitted by the applicant shall also be taken into account before finalizing the list.

However, the law is well settled that when there are successive representations submitted after a lapse of time, such representations will not give any fresh cause of action if the matter is already time barred [AIR 1990 SC 10 – S.S. Rathore –vs- State of M.P. 1993 (1) ATR 855 (SC) – Rantan Chandra Samanta – vs- Union of India and 1998 SCC (L&S) 611 – B.S. Baweja –vs- State of Punjab].

5. That with regard to the statements made in **para 1.(iii)** of the application, the answering respondents state that ~~the promotion orders~~ were issued based on the seniority position in the Grade of Assistant Engineer (C) (hereinafter referred to as "AE(C)"). ~~Since the applicant is not a regular~~ AE (C), his name does not appear in the Seniority List and therefore he was not considered for promotion.
6. That the answering respondents have no comments to offer with regard to the statement made in **para 2** of the application.

7. That with regard to the statements made in **para 3** of the application, the answering respondents respectfully submit that the application is barred by limitation as provided under Section 20 and 21 of the Act.
8. That with regard to the statements made in **para 4.1** of the application, the answering respondents state that the statements made in the paragraph are misleading and incorrect. From the **Annexure I** (dated 28.10.78) annexed to the application, it is very much clear that the applicant was promoted to the Grade of AE (C) on purely temporary and ad hoc basis for a period of 4 (four) months only with a clear understanding that the said promotion to the Grade of AE (C) is purely on temporary and ad hoc basis and that the said promotion will not confer on the said promotees, in any manner whatsoever, any claim to seniority, promotion, confirmation or for counting of the said period towards regular service in the Grade of AE (C). The applicant has never been promoted to the Grade of AE (C) on regular basis. Hence, his claim for inclusion of his name in the Seniority List is not tenable.
9. That with regard to the statements made in **para 4.2, 4.3, 4.4, 4.5 and 4.7** of the application, the answering respondents state that as stated herein above, the cause of action and the subject matter of the application is barred by the law of limitation as the same occurred long back in the year 1989. Successive representations, including one dated 17.10.89, will not accrue a fresh cause of action as already stated hereinabove. The name of the applicant was not included in the Seniority List of AE (C) as he failed to pass the prescribed Departmental Qualifying Examination which was essential for regularization in the cadre of AE (C) during 1987 to 1992. The applicant admits that he passed the Accounts Examination held on 5th and 6th September 1989 (vide **Annexure 3** of his application). The applicant being aware of this fact, he kept quiet during the period 1989 to 1997. The applicant now tactfully wants to raise his claim with the representation dated 17.10.1989 purportedly sent to the respondents and the representation dated 22.12.1997 after a gap of about eight (8) years.

done well

As the applicant was not promoted to the grade of AE (C) on regular basis his claim for inclusion of his name on the Seniority List is untenable.

10. That with regard to the statement made in **para 4.6** of the application, the answering respondents state that the grant of benefit under ACP Scheme is not relevant so far as the case of the applicant for regular promotion to the grade of AE (C) is concerned.
11. That with regard to the statements made in **para 4.8** of the application, the answering respondents state that the applicant will be promoted to the grade of Executive Engineer (C) [hereinafter referred to as "EE(C)"] only after his regular appointment as AE(C) and considering the number of years of service required to be fulfilled for promotion to the grade of EE(C).
12. That with regard to the statements made in **para 4.9** of the application, the answering respondents state that as stated hereinabove, the application is premature as neither the provisional Seniority List has been finalized nor the applicant has been regularly promoted to the grade of AE(C). Moreover, the cause of action is time-barred by delay and laches on the part of the applicant.
13. That with regard to the statements made in **para 5.I to 5.V** of the application, the answering respondents state that the grounds shown on those paragraphs are neither legally valid grounds nor the same are supported by any cogent evidence. Therefore, the application is liable to be dismissed with cost as devoid of any merit or ground. There is nothing to show on records that the respondents have ever acted illegally, arbitrarily, discriminatorily or in violation of rules of natural justice. The respondents also submit that there is no such action on the part of the respondents which have violated any such fundamental right of the applicant. The non-consideration of the applicant, who could not come within the zone of consideration for promotion, and the consideration of those who could fulfill the required criteria for promotion, cannot be a

discrimination as the applicant is not similarly situated with the others. Hence, the grounds are not tenable in law.

14. That with regard to the statements made in **para 6** of the application, the answering respondents respectfully state that by mere submission of representation, a stale claim of the applicant cannot be revived and the settled position in law cannot be unsettled, which is barred by law.
15. That the respondents have no comments to make with regard to the statements made in **para 7** of the application.
16. That with regard to the statements made in **para 8 and 9** of the application, the answering respondents state that in view of the facts and circumstances of the case and the provisions of law, the applicant is not entitled to any relief, whatsoever, as prayed for, and the application is liable to be dismissed with cost as being devoid of any merit.

In the premises aforesaid, it is therefore prayed that your Lordship would be pleased to hear the parties, peruse the records and after hearing the parties and perusing the records shall be pleased to dismiss the application with cost.
