Some more clarification is required from the respondents in the matter. It is stated that the selection process for appointment of Goods drivers, 63 in number were stated in November 2003 and completed in March 2004 by conducting examination from Diesel drivers; a list of successful candidates prepared and approved in which the names of all the applicants are included but it was cancelled long thereafter by an order dated 16.9.2004 on the basis of certain letters received from Sr.DPO/LMG dated 17.5.2004 and 8.6.2004. It is alleged that the cancellation was made only to help certain employees whose names did not find a place in the empanelled list. There is no proper answer for the inordinate delay in the written statement filed. Hence the respondents will file an additional affidavit explaining the above position.</p> <p>Already there is an order in O.A.No.182 of 2004 that selection if any, made pursuant to the cancellation of the earlier list is subject to the result of the O.A. ORDER (ORAL)


SIVARAJAN. J. (V.C.)

There are 4 applicants in O.A. No. 182/2004 and 8 applicants in O.A. No. 11/2005. Now all the applicants in both these two cases alongwith 43 others persons have filed O.A. 188/2005 challenging the cancellation of the panel of 63 Diesel Assistant Driver prepared for appointment to the post of Goods Driver and the subsequent selection made pursuant to such cancellation. O.A. Nos. 182/2004 and 11/2005 are also filed earlier challenging the cancellation of the select list of 63 persons and the proposal to make fresh selection.

2. So far the applicants in O.A. No. 182/2004 and O.A. No. 11/2005 are concerned, they appeared in the written test conducted for fresh selection pursuant to the cancellation of the earlier panel during the pendency of the said two applications and they have passed the test and are in the select list. So, as on today, they cannot have any complaint against cancellation of earlier select list.

3. Mrs. M. Borah, learned counsel for the applicants, notwithstanding the above position, contended that the applicants want to argue the matter on principle, for, that would help other non applicants who were there in the earlier select list but did not pass the written test in the fresh selection. Counsel contended that it is for the said purpose O.A. No. 188/2005 is filed by the applicants in O.A. Nos. 182/2004 and 11/2005 jointly with 43 other persons.

4. As already noted, in O.A. No. 188/2005, apart from the 12 applicants in the other two O.A.s 43 more applicants are there. These 43 persons did not earlier challenge the cancellation order. They instead participated in the second selection by appearing in the



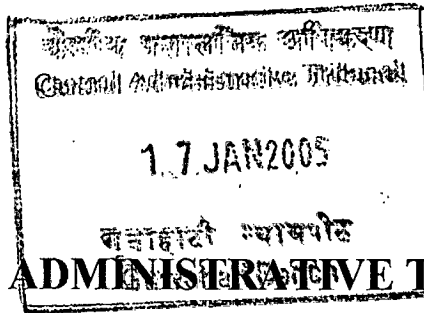
written test. Out of 63 persons in the earlier select list, except 10 persons all others got through. Now, only 10 persons amongst the 63 persons in the first panel could not be selected. Since these applicants have not challenged the cancellation of the earlier panel in which their names were also included and since they have participated in the second selection made subsequent to the cancellation of the earlier panel they cannot be allowed to raise the contention that the cancellation order of the earlier panel is illegal or unauthorized. Though Mrs. M. Borah, counsel for the applicants had strongly made submission on behalf of these 10 persons in the garb of the argument regarding the justification for cancellation of the earlier panel, we are not impressed, for the simple reason that the applicants in the first two cases are really not aggrieved at present since they are in the present panel also. O.A. No. 188/2005, in so far as other persons are concerned, according to us, it is highly belated also.

5. We have also heard Dr. M. C. Sarma, and Ms. B. Devi, counsel for the Railways in these cases. Mr. Sarma and Ms. Devi fairly conceded that the applicants in O.A. 182/2004 and O.A. 11/2005 succeeded in the second selection also and therefore they cannot have any grievance now.

6. In the circumstances, O.A. No. 182/2004 and O.A. No. 11/2005 are dismissed as infructuous. O.A. 188/2005 is also dismissed at the admission stage itself for the reason already stated.

### III. Particulars of the order against which application is made:

1. The applicants, Diesel Assistant Drivers, selected for the post of Goods Driver in the scale of Rs. 5000 – 8000/-. There were 63 posts of Goods Driver which were sought to be filled up by issuing necessary orders. While this process of filling up of 63 posts was going on the Railway Authority arbitrarily decided to cancel the process of filling up of these posts. Feeling aggrieved by this arbitrary action, an application, being O.A. No. 182 of 2004, was moved before this Hon'ble Tribunal. During pendency of this original application the Railway authority initiated a process of fresh selection and an order in this regard has been issued by the Divisional Railway Manager (Personnel) vide his letter No. E / 254 / I / LM/ (RG) / M dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: - G). In this fresh call letter the names of the Applicant No. 1 and 5 Sri Simanta Ranon Barooah and Sri Ranjit Chutia respectively were not included though previously they were selected and empanelled for promotion.

The applicants were duly selected in accordance with the procedure established by law. There is no reason for cancelling the posting of the applicants in the posts of Goods Driver. Initiating of fresh process of selection which is not based on any reason.

All the applicants are similarly situated having been selected for promotion to the posts of Goods Drivers and similarly aggrieved by the said Railway Board's circulars including the impugned letter dated 22.12.2004. They have the same cause of action for the purpose of the present proceedings and they pray for similar relief.

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Simantabharoah

The applicants, as such, crave leave of this Honourable Tribunal to allow them to join together in a single application under Rule 4(5) (a) of the Central Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1987.

**IV. Jurisdiction of the Tribunal:**

The applicants declare that the subject matter(s) of the application is/are within the jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Tribunal.

**V. Limitation:**

The applicants further declare that the present application is within the limitation prescribed under Section 21 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

**VI. Facts of the Case:**

1. That the applicants are citizens of India and are entitled to all the rights and privileges guaranteed to the citizens of India by the Constitution of India and the laws framed under it. The applicants are employees of the North-East Frontier Railway (hereinafter referred to as the N.F. Rly.), serving in the rank of Diesel Assistant Driver in the Mechanical Department of N.F. Rly. posted at New Guwahati, Loco Shed, and are working under the control of Senior Divisional Mechanical Engineer/ In-charge ("Sr. DME/IC" for short) Lumding Division. The applicants belong to the Transportation (Power) Branch of the N.F. Railways.
2. That the service hierarchy in the Transportation (Power) branch of the Mechanical Department of N.F. Rly. in Lumding Division is as follows:-  
 Engine Cleaner-----Second Fireman – First Fireman  
 Or  
 Diesel Assistant Driver- Driver Goods –Passenger Driver – Mail Driver.

- 3.1 That the applicant No.1 (Sri S.R. Barooah) was appointed as First Fireman on 25.6.1991 and was converted as Diesel Assistant Driver on 6.12.91 in which post he is at present working.
- 3.2 That the applicant No.2 (Sri Gopi Goswami) was appointed as First Fireman on 25.6.91 and was converted to Diesel assistant Driver on 6.12.91 in which post he is working at present.
- 3.3 That applicant No.3 (Sri Dipak Chanda Sengupta) was appointed as Khalasi on 6.4.83 and promoted to Engine Cleaner on 28.1.87 and promoted to Second Fireman on 24.3.87 and promoted to First Fireman on 29.1.93 and converted to Diesel Assistant Driver on 21.3.94 in which post he is working at present.
- 3.4 That applicant No.4 (Sri Yankat Raona) was posted as Second Fireman on 26.10.89, converted as Diesel Assistant Driver on 30.3.89 in which post he is working at present.
- 3.5 That the applicant No. 5 (Shri Ranjit Chutia) was appointed as Engine Cleaner on 07.11.1989 and promoted to engine cleaner helper on 31.12.1992 and promoted to Diesel Asstt. Driver on 22.02.2000 in which post he is at present working.
- 3.6 That the applicant No. 6 (Shri Hem Chandra Deuri) was appointed as Engine Cleaner on 06.11.1989 and promoted to Engine Cleaner Helper on 31.12.1992 and promoted to Diesel Asstt. Driver on 22.02.2000 in which post he is at present working.
- 3.7 That applicant No. 7 (Shri Haranath Saikia) was appointed as Engine Cleaner on 06.11.1989 and promoted to Engine Cleaner Helper on 31.12.1992 and promoted to Diesel Asstt. Driver on 22.02.2000 in which post he is at present working.

3.8 That applicant No. 8 (Shri Upen Deuri) was appointed as Engine Cleaner on 06.11.1989 and promoted to Engine Cleaner Helper on 31.12.1992 and promoted to Diesel Asstt. Driver on 22.02.2000 in which post he is at present working.

4. That on 14.10.2003 Divisional Railway Manager informed that 142 vacancies of Goods Driver would be filled by selection through a written test etc.

A copy of said letter dated 14.10.2003 together with the list of eligible candidates are annexed herewith and marked as Annexure – A series.

5. That the respective seniority positions of the applicants in the grade of Diesel Assistant Driver were also indicated in the letter dated 14.10.2003 which were as under:

6. That the applicants were called to appear in a selection for filling up 142 vacancies of Goods Drivers in the scale of pay of Rs.5000/- to Rs.8000/-. Altogether 325 Shunters, Diesel Assistant drivers and senior Diesel Assistant Drivers of Lumding Division were called for the purpose of selection, in order of seniority vide letter dated 14.10.2003 and the prescribed syllabus for the selection was also circulated vide the said letter dtd. 14.10.2003.

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7. That the said selection was conducted through a written test held from 15.11.2003 to 02.12.2003 at Lumding, Badarpur and New Guwahati centres followed by a supplementary selection held on 19.1.2004 at Lumding.
8. That altogether 63 candidates were selected and they were empanelled in a panel in order of seniority vide Memorandum No. F/254/1/LM (RG)/LM Lumding dtd. 31.3.2004 of the Office of the Divisional Railway Manager (P), N.F. Railway, issued under the signature of the APO/II/LMG for Divil. Rly. Manager (P), N.F. Railway.

A copy of the Memorandum No. F/254/1/LM (RG)/LM Lumding dtd. 31.3.2004 of the Office of the Divisional Railway Manager (P), N.F. Railway, issued under the signature of the APO/II/LMG for Divil. Rly. Manager (P), N.F. Railway is annexed hereto and marked as Annexure - B.

9. That the names of all the applicants figure in this panel and their relative positions in the table are shown below:

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10. That on 9.6.2004, the DME (C&W)/LMG wrote to the SSE (LOCO)/LMG, NGC and BPB regarding posting of staff as Goods Driver on Promotion intimating that the 63 candidates selected were earmarked against sheds as under :

LMG-----Total in (nos) 23

NGC-----Do 14

BPB-----Do 26

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He further wanted to know the probable date by which they may be posted as Goods Drivers on promotion subject to passing Promotional Course (training Course) and Psychological test . Further information sought for was as regards the number of staff who have already passed the aforesaid tests so that their names could be intimated to HO/MLG within a week.

A copy of the said letter dated 9.6.2004 is annexed hereto and marked as Annexure -C.

11. That all on a sudden Divisional Railway Manager vide his letter dated 13.07.2004 cancelled the posting of 63 Goods Drivers on promotion without any reason.

A copy of the said letter dated 13.7.2004 is annexed hereto and marked as Annexure -D.

12. That, the respondent authorities through a letter No. E/ 254 / I / LM (RG) / M dated 04.08.2003 from DRM (P) N.F. Railway Lunding called a group of candidate for selection of passenger drivers for filling up 64 Nos. of posts and has already empanelled the candidates successful in written test and viva-voce for promotion. The goods drivers and the passenger drivers are in the same footing in the scheme of restructuring of cadre as in both cases a reduction of percentage strength from the existing 80% to the revised 73% of the



cadre strength both for goods drivers and passenger drivers. The responding authorities by selecting a set of similarly situated servants through a selection process and omitting to give effect to the completed selection of the Applicants by promoting the other set of servants including the applicants as goods drivers are following a double standard though both the set of servants fall under the same rules.

This letter No. E / 254 / I / LM / (RG) / M dated 04.08.2003 from D.R.M. (P) N. F. Railway, Lumding is annexed here too and marked as Annexure: - E.

13. That it is stated here that the applicants are members of Group "C" staff of transportation (Power) department. The Government of India, Ministry of Railways/Railway Board issued a letter being No. RBE No. 177/2003 vide Memo No. PC-III/2003/CRC/6 dtd. New Delhi 9.10.2003 addressed to the General Managers/All Indian Railways and production Units regarding restructuring of certain group "C" and "D" Cadres. Such restructuring was undertaken with a view to strengthening and rationalizing the staffing pattern on Railways.

A copy of such letter dated 09.10.2003 along with the statement regarding restructuring of Group "C" staff of Transportation (Power) Department so far it relates to the applicants are annexed hereto and marked as Annexure: - F series.

14. That subsequent to the letter dated 9.10.2003 another letter was issued by the Director Pay Commission – II Railway Board vide No. P.C – III / 2003 / CRC / 6 dated New Delhi 06.01.2004 which was

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essentially issued in partial modification of the earlier letter dated 09.10.2003.

15. That cancellation of panel of selectees for the promotion to Goods Drivers including the applicants has been under challenge in O.A No. 182 of 2004 before this Hon'ble Tribunal. The applicants crave leave of this Hon'ble Tribunal to refer to and rely upon the said application at the time of hearing.
16. That when all the applicants were similarly situated and were expecting the outcome of the original application No. 182 of 2004 the letter No. E / 254 / I / LM / (RG) / M dated 22.12.2004 issued by APO II for DRM (P) Lunding has created a fresh situation by initiating a fresh selection for 142 No. (UR - 110, SC - 21 & ST - 11) of vacancies among which No. of vacancies the 63 No. of posts of goods drivers for which 63 candidates including the applicants were selected.

A copy of the said letter dated 22.12.2004 is annexed hereto and marked as Annexure: - G.

17. That in this fresh call letter dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: - G) names of applicant No. 1 Sri Simanta Rajon Barooah, Applicant No. 5 Sri Ranjit Chutia and three other empanelled candidates Sri Ajoy Chanda, Sri Dipak Kr. Roy and Sri Tamal Bhattacharjee do not figure while the names of the applicants No. 2, 3 and 4 each finds a place in the same. (Annexure: -G) Although all the applicants have been all along similarly situated in respect of their eligibility for promotion as goods drivers (Now re-designated as Loco Pilot - II Goods) as proved by their previous selection since abandoned.
18. That the omission of some of the applicants and inclusion of others in the said call letter is violative of Article 16(1) of the Constitution

of India and it reveals an illegal attempt of the respondent authorities to frustrate the claims of the applicants. It has subjected the applicant's No. 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 & 8 to the uncertainty of a fresh selection and applicant's No. 1 and 5 to deprivation forever from promotion to the next higher grade.

19. That the fresh bid for a new selection under the said letter dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: -G) is being taken when the matter was already subjudice under the original application No. 182 of 2004 before this Hon'ble Tribunal is in preparation by the responding authorities for totally giving the cancellation of the previous selection perpetuity.
20. That the letters by which the applicants are aggrieved are, Memo No. E/58 (training) dtd. 13.7.2004 by Sr. D.M.E. Lumding, Letter No. E/254/52/1(4)/Pt-I dtd. 16.9.2004 by General Manager (Personnel) N.F. Railway, Maligaon and also the Letter No. E/254/1/LM(RG)/M dtd. 21.9.2004 from Divisional Railway Manager (Personnel) Lumding and also letter No. E / 254 / I / LM / (RG) / M dated 22.12.2004.

**VII. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF WITH LEGAL PROVISION:**

- a) For that in the backdrop of such a situation this Hon'ble Tribunal will be required to adjudicate the rights of the applicants to be promoted to the post of Driver (Goods) on the following yardsticks/parameters:
  - i) Whether the selection of the applicants for promotion to the posts of Drivers (Goods) were de hors the Rules laid down and was made by authorities which had no jurisdiction to make such selection?

- ii) Whether the action of the respondent authorities in denying appointment by the respondent authorities even after due selection of the applicants can be construed as a valid exercise that can be used to initiate a fresh selection process?
- iii) Whether the respondent authorities acted within their powers in ordering the fresh selection process circumventing the Railway rule of allowing a selection panel approved by competent authorities to remain in force for the stipulated period?
- iv) Whether a call letter initiating the selection process by inviting unwillingness, if any, to participate in the selection to be intimated can be valid if it does not include names of eligible and similarly situated personnel in the feeder grade?
- v) Whether it is permissible to invade public interest by bringing about an inordinate delay in filling up the essential process concerned with the running of trains of goods driver by canceling a finalized panel of selecttees having fully blossomed right in the panel would conform to principles of service jurisprudence?
- b) For that the applicants state that they were selected against vacant posts which existed on 14.10.2003 and these posts are not yet filled up though all the Loco sheds at Lumding Badarpun and New Guwahati are grossly under staffed. The 63 nos. of posts lying vacant out of the 142 posts for which the impugned letter dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: -G) was issued can be filled up by the applicants among other selected candidates without harm to the railways.
- c) For that it is submitted that the respondents have acted quite contrary to this declared position by delaying the promotion of the applicants and taking recourse to a round about course of action in recruiting

byway of promotion to vacant posts. In Railway Board's circular dated 6.1.2004 and 24.6.2004 it has practically abandoned the straight road of promoting from ready panels existing on a particular date and seeks to resort to part use of panels valid on 1.11.2003 or on 5.1.2004 and part use of a modified selection which would surely be time consuming. It is submitted that nothing can be speedier than a ready panel in filling up vacancies.

- d) For that the applicants state that the letter dated 13/7/2004 was issued without any rhyme and reason and no reasonable explanation has been furnished in support of the cancellation of the proposed promotions. In the backdrop of such a situation the applicants are constrained to observe that the action on the part of the respondents in issuing a faulty letter to initiate a fresh selection process are totally malafide, arbitrary, unreasonable and without any jurisdiction. Such actions are purely a colourable exercise of powers and as such the impugned order is liable to be set aside and quashed. And the applicants are to be promoted in terms of their regular selection.
- e) For that the respondent authorities cannot be allowed to go on with the fresh selection process unless cogent and lawful reasons are shown for initiating the same.
- f) For that applicants no. 1 and 5 cannot be kept away from the fresh selection process by omitting their names for the list of eligible candidates in the letter dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: - G) as that will lead to the violation of their fundamental rights under article 16(1) of the Constitution of India.
- g) For that another important aspect of the matter which cannot be lost sight of is that some of the applicants are likely to cross 45 years of

age if in the meantime their promotions are not given effect to in as much as the maximum age for qualifying for the post of Goods Drivers is 45 years only.

- h) For that unless the operation of the letter of APO II / LMG dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: - G) is stayed the very purpose of this application will be defeated and serious injustice and irreparable loss will be caused to the applicants. Therefore operation of the letter of APO II / LMG dated 22.12.2004 (Annexure: - G) is required to be stayed till disposal of the application.
- i) For that all the applicants are similarly situated having been required to forgo their selection for promotion and they are similarly aggrieved by the said impugned letter of APO II / LMG dated 22.12.2004. They have the same cause of action for the purpose of the present proceedings and they pray for similar reliefs. The applicants as such crave leave of this Hon'ble Tribunal to allow them to join together in a single application under rule 4 (5) (a) of the Central Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules 1987.

#### **VIII. DETAILS OF THE REMEDIES EXHAUSTED –**

That the applicants No.1 appealed to DRM / P / LMG N.F. Railway for inclusion of his name in the letter of APO II for DRMP Lumding dated 22.12.2004 and pending rectification to suspend the fresh selection process on 28.12.2004 but to no avail. That applicants No., 2, 3 and 4 exhausted departmental channel of remedies went to this Hon'ble Tribunal with O.A. No. 182 of 2004 and Applicants No. 5, 6, 7 and 8 having exhausted departmental channel of remedies have come before this Hon'ble Tribunal with the present application.

#### **IX. MATTERS NOT PREVIOUSLY FILED OR PENDING IN ANY OTHER COURT OR TRIBUNAL**

The applicants declare that the subject matters of this application with regard to the impugned order in letter No. E / 254 / I / LM (RG) / M dated 22.12.2004 are not pending before any court of law, any other authority or any other branch of the Hon'ble Tribunal.

**X. RELIEFS SOUGHT:**

That in the premises aforesaid the applicants pray that your Lordships may be pleased to call for the records, issue notice to the respondents to show cause as to why the impugned order under letter No. E / 254 / I / LM (RG) / M dated 22.12.2004 issued by APO II for Divisional Railway Manager (P) Lumding N.F. Railways (Annexure: - G) shall not set aside and quashed and upon hearing the parties may be pleased to set aside and quash the impugned order aforesaid or pass such further or other order(s) as your Lordship's may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

**XI. INTERIM ORDER IF ANY PRAYED FOR:**

That the applicants pray that this Hon'ble Tribunal may be pleased to pass Interim Order to stay the operation of the impugned order issued by APO II for DRMP Lumding N.F. Railways under No. E / 254 / I / LM (RG) / M dated 22.12.2004 till the disposal of the present application.

Sub. : Restructuring of certain Group 'C' & 'D' cadres.

The Ministry of Railways have had under review cadres of certain Group 'C' & 'D' staff in consultation with the staff side with a view to strengthening and rationalising the staffing pattern on Railways. As a result of the review undertaken on the basis of functional, operational and administrative requirements, it has been decided with the approval of the President that the Group 'C' & 'D' categories of staff as indicated in the Annexures to this letter should be restructured in accordance with the revised percentages indicated therein. While implementing these orders the following detailed instructions should be strictly and carefully adhered to :

Date of effect  
(hereinafter referred to  
as cut-off date)

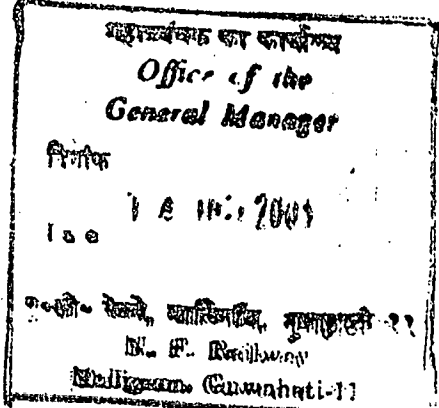
Applicability to  
various cadres

1. This restructuring of cadres will be with reference to the sanctioned cadre strength as on the date following the date on which the cadres in the headquarter offices of new Zonal Railways/new Divisions are closed. The benefit of restructuring will be restricted to the persons who are working in a particular cadre on the cut-off date.
2. These orders will be applicable on the regular cadres (excluding surplus & supernumerary posts) of the Open Line establishments including Workshops and Production Units. These orders will, however, not be applicable to staff of RDSO for which separate orders will be issued.
  - 2.1 These orders will not be applicable to ex-cadre & work-charged posts which will continue to be based on worth of charge.
  - 2.2 These instructions will also not be applicable to construction Units and Projects, where posts are generally created on worth of charge basis, though those should broadly be conforming to these percentage distributions.

**Pay Fixation (Rule  
1313 (FR 22)-RII)**

3. Staff selected and posted against the additional higher grade posts as a result of restructuring will have their pay fixed under Rule 1313 (FR-22)(I)(a)(1)-RII on proforma basis w.e.f. the cut-off date with the usual option for pay fixation as per extant rules. Actual payment based on the pay so fixed should be made from the date of taking over the charge of the higher grade post arising out of these restructuring orders. The benefit under this rule will, however, no longer be available in the case of movement from lower grade to higher grade in the non-functional situations where there is no change in duties as in the case of movement from Goods Guards to Sr. Goods Guards and Goods Drivers to Sr. Goods Drivers etc. In the case of such movement, the pay will be fixed under Rule 1313 (FR 22) (I) (a) (2)-RII. However, the benefit of fixation of pay under rule 1313 (FR-22)(I) (a) (1)R-II will now be admissible in the cases of functional promotions such as promotion from Sr. Goods Guards to Passenger Guards and Sr. Goods Drivers to Passenger Drivers etc. though in identical scale of pay.

**Existing classification  
and filling up of the  
vacancies**

4. The existing classification of the posts covered by these orders as 'selection' and 'non-selection', as the case may be, remains unchanged. Action should be taken to position the employees on the basis of selection/non-selection/suitability/Trade Test, as the case may be. However, the instructions contained in Para-13.2 should be followed in case of placement of Supervisors (erstwhile Mistries) to grade Rs.5000-8000.

5. Extant instructions for D&A/Vigilance clearance will be applicable for effecting promotions under these orders with reference to the cut-off date.

**Minimum years of  
service in each grade**

6. While implementing the restructuring orders, instructions regarding minimum period of service for promotion issued from time to time should be followed. In other words, residency period prescribed for promotions to various categories should not be relaxed.

**Basic functions, duties  
and responsibilities**

7. Since the cadres as detailed in the annexures to this letter are being restructured on functional, operational and administrative considerations, the posts being placed in higher scales of pay as a result of restructuring should include the duties and responsibilities of greater importance.

**Adjustment of excess  
number of posts**

8. If prior to issue of these instructions the number of posts existing in any grade in any particular cadre exceeds the number admissible on the revised percentages, the excess may

be allowed to continue to be phased out progressively with the vacation of the posts by the existing incumbents.

9. While implementing these orders, specific instructions given in the foot-notes for the relevant categories in the enclosed annexures should be strictly and carefully adhered to.

**Introduction of Multi skilling – merger of**

**i) SM/ASM + YM + TI**

**(ii) Personnel/ Welfare/**

**HOER Inspectors**

**(iii) ESM & MSM**

10. The concept of Multi-skilling is to be introduced by merging the different categories as mentioned hereunder. While the revised percentage distribution of posts as indicated in the annexures to this letter should be implemented in the unified cadres based on the integrated seniority list, the duties, responsibilities and functions being performed by the employees of the respective cadres will be combined in a phased manner. Each member of the cadre will have to be equipped with necessary skills and functions through proper training and development. The categories indicated herein will be merged by integrating the seniority of the employees working in respective grades with reference to length of non-fortuitous service in the relevant grade keeping the inter-se seniority in the respective group intact.

- 10.1 The category of Station Masters/Assistant Station Masters, Yard Masters and Traffic Inspectors should be merged into one unified cadre of SM/ASM. The recruitment and promotion pattern as prescribed for the category of SMs/ASMs should be followed in the merged cadre. In the initial stage of the merger, efforts should be made to post the employees in the categories in which they have been working. Accordingly, while the staff belonging to the erstwhile three categories will be working and enjoying the benefit of the unified cadre of SMs/ASMs, on their posting in the Yard, they will perform the duties of Yard Master retaining their designation as applicable to the category of Yard Master. Similarly, while performing the inspectorial job they will retain their designation as applicable to Traffic Inspectors. But at a later stage, when they are made fully equipped to discharge all the functions hitherto being discharged by SMs/ASMs, YMs & TIs, administration will have the flexibility to post a person as per the administrative requirement. While redefining the duties and functions, Railways may also review and rationalise the cadre keeping in view the administrative requirements.

- 10.2 The Personnel, Welfare and HOER Inspectors should be merged and a unified cadre of Personnel Inspectors introduced. After merger, 50% of the posts in the entry grade

of the combined cadre viz Rs.5000-8000 should be filled from amongst the optee Sr.Clerks of Personnel Department in grade Rs.4500-7000 with three years of service in the grade and the remaining 50% of the posts should be filled as per the instructions contained in Board's letter No.E(NG)-1/2002/PM4/1 dated 12-07-02.

10.3 The categories of Electric Signal Maintainers (ESM) and Mechanical Signal Maintainers (MSM) should be merged and a unified cadre of Signal Maintainers introduced. The recruitment and promotion pattern as applicable to the Electric Signal Maintainers will be followed in the unified cadre of Signal Maintainers.

**Introduction of Direct recruitment**

- (i) Ministerial Staff  
(excluding Accounts staff)
- (ii) Personnel Inspectors
- (iii) Depot Material Superintendents

11. The implementation of restructuring scheme in the categories of Ministerial staff, Personnel Inspectors and Depot Material Superintendents is subject to the introduction of direct recruitment in these categories. After implementation of the restructuring in accordance with the revised percentage distribution of posts indicated in the annexures enclosed, the vacancies arising in these categories on or after the cut-off date should be filled through direct recruitment in the manner indicated hereunder:-

11.1 An element of direct recruitment of graduates with not less than 50% marks shall now be introduced at the level of Office Superintendent Gr.II in the pay scale Rs.5500-9000 in the Ministerial categories (Establishment & other than Establishment but excluding Accounts) to the extent of 20% of the posts. The remaining 80% of the posts in grade Rs.5500-9000 shall continue to be filled by promotion of staff from the lower grade Rs.5000-8000 as per the procedure in force.

11.2 20% of the posts in grade Rs.6500-10500 in the category of Personnel Inspectors shall be filled by direct recruitment from amongst the candidates possessing Bachelor degree with Postgraduate Diploma in Personnel Management, labour laws, etc. as mentioned in Board's letter No.E(NG)-1-2002/PM4/1 dated 12-07-2002. The remaining 80% of the posts shall continue to be filled by promotion of staff from the lower grade of Rs.5500-9000 as per the procedure in force.

11.3 20% of the posts in grade Rs.6500-10500 in the category of Depot Material Superintendents should be filled by direct recruitment from amongst the candidates possessing

qualification of degree in Engineering in any discipline. The remaining 80% of the posts shall continue to be filled by promotion of staff from the lower grade of Rs.5500-9000 as per procedure in force.

**Gatemen (Engg.)**

12. As a result of implementation of this restructuring, more number of additional posts will be available in the highest grade of this category. Henceforth, therefore, the posts of Gatemen (Engg.) should be operated in grade Rs.2750-4400. In order to ensure the full availability of Gatemen (Engg.) and rotation of the existing staff specially those who are working, as such, for a long period, the Trackmen etc. at the time of their promotion to grade Rs.2750-4400 should be posted as Gatemen (Engg.) subject to their fulfilling the requirement of prescribed medical standard and literacy level etc. as per extant instructions.

**Upgradation of the posts of Supervisor (erstwhile Mistries)**

- 13(a) Subject to provisions of Para-13.2 below, all the posts of Supervisors (erstwhile Mistries) in grade Rs.4500-7000 + Rs.100 Special Allowance (excluding Supervisors (P.Way) should enbloc be upgraded to the posts of Junior Engineer Gr.II in the pay scale of Rs.5000-8000 and merged with the respective cadre of Technical Supervisors with its spread effect in higher grades Rs.5500-9000, 6500-10500 & 7450-11500 as per the revised percentage distribution of posts prescribed for Technical Supervisors in these orders.

- 13(b) In case of Supervisor (P.Way), the posts being held by the erstwhile PWMs supervising more than one gang upto a maximum of 17.26% of the sanctioned cadre of PWMs shall be upgraded to and merged with the posts of Junior Engineer (P.Way) Gr.II in the pay scale of Rs.5000-8000 with its spread effect in higher grades of JE-I, SE & SSE in grades Rs.5500-9000, 6500-10500 & 7450-11500 respectively, as per the revised percentages prescribed for Technical Supervisors in these orders.

- 13.1 The financial implications involved in the upgradation covered by (a) & (b) above should be off set by surrender of posts of Supervisors of equivalent money value.

**Procedure for fitment**

- 13.2 The placement of the existing incumbents will be regulated as per the procedure given below:-

- (a) The existing regular incumbents of the posts of Supervisors (including Supervisors/P.Way to the extent of upgradation of

posts) will be placed in grade Rs.5000-8000 without subjecting them to normal selection procedure. Their suitability shall be adjudged by following modified selection procedure according to which the selection will be based on scrutiny of service records and confidential reports only.

(b) The Supervisors (other than P.Way) who do not get promoted to grade Rs.5000-8000 shall continue to hold the post in the existing grade Rs.4500-7000 + Rs.100 SA as personal to them. To this extent, the posts upgraded to grade Rs.5000-8000 will be operated in the lower grade Rs.4500-7000 + Rs.100 SA till the existing incumbents vacate the same by way of promotion, retirement etc. On vacation of the posts, the same shall automatically be operated in grade Rs.5000-8000.

**Specific provisions for Supervisor (P.Way)**

13.3 The remaining posts of Supervisors (P.Way), erstwhile PWMs which are not to be upgraded and shall continue to be operated in the existing scale of pay, should be redesignated as 'Track Supervisor'.

13.4 While the existing incumbents of the post of Supervisor (P.Way) redesignated as 'Track Supervisor' shall continue to draw the scale of pay Rs.4500-7000 + Rs.100 SA as personal to them, the future incumbents to the post of 'Track Supervisor' will be in the pay scale of Rs.4500-7000 without the Special Allowance of Rs.100/-.

13.5 The upgradation of posts of Supervisor (P.Way) as indicated hereinabove should not result in creation of posts of Trolleyman. In other words under no circumstances, additional posts of Trolleyman would be created.

14. The existing instructions with regard to reservation of SC/ST wherever applicable will continue to apply.

15. Direct recruitment percentages will not be applicable to the additional posts arising out of these restructuring orders as on the cut-off date. The direct recruitment percentage will apply for normal vacancies arising on or after the date following the cut-off date. Also the direct recruitment quota as on the date preceding the cut-off date will be maintained.

16. The administration should take steps to pin-point the additional posts arising out of this restructuring as per administrative requirements.

**Refusal of promotion**

17. Such of the Staff as had refused promotion before issue of these orders and stand debarred for promotion may be considered for promotion, in relaxation of the extant provisions as a one time exception, if they indicate in writing that they are willing to be considered for such promotion against the vacancies existing on the cut-off date and arising due to restructuring on that date. This relaxation will not be applicable to vacancies arising after the cut-off date.

**Matching Savings**

18. Entire scheme of restructuring is to be a self-financing and expenditure neutral proposition. Financial implications should be worked out taking into account the mid points of the scales of pay of the respective posts (mean of the minima & maxima of the scale), existing number of posts and revised number of posts in the grade on the basis of the revised percentage distribution of posts. After working out the financial implications, the matching savings should be effected from the category itself. Wherever it is not possible to do so from the category itself, the matching savings should be arranged from the department at the divisional/zonal level. But before restructuring the cadre as per the revised percentage distribution of posts, matching savings will have to be ensured and if the Department/Railways are not able to provide the matching savings, the particular category/department will not be restructured. While effecting surrender of posts of equivalent financial value, the existing vacant posts available in the categories on the cut-off date should be considered for the purpose of off-setting the cost of restructuring/financial effects of restructuring. Board desire that the General Managers should ensure that the restructuring is implemented expeditiously with matching savings without any exception and difficulty. There would be no restructuring without matching savings by surrender of posts.

**Re-organisation of Zonal Railways/ Divisions:**

19. Due to re-organisation of Zonal Railways/Divisions cadres are in a fluid situation. It may, therefore, take some time for the cadres in the headquarter offices of New Zones and New Divisions to stabilise. In the circumstances, new Zonal Railways are required to ensure that the staff transferred to headquarter offices of new Zonal Railways/new Divisions are not extended the double benefit of restructuring. In case an employee has been given the benefit of restructuring on the old (parent) railway in terms of these orders, he will not be allowed the benefit of restructuring again on the headquarter offices of new Zonal Railways/new Divisions. In other words, no railway servant will be considered for double

promotion as a result of this restructuring.

Annual review

20. As per instructions contained in Board's letter No. PC-III/91/FP-2 dt. 08.10.2002, the Annual Reviews for gradewise percentage distribution of posts in force were to be conducted from 01-04-03 taking into account the cadre strength as on 01.04.2003. It has now been decided that the next Annual Review will be undertaken from 01-04-2005 taking into account the cadre strength as on 01-04-2005. The Annual reviews, wherever conducted already as per instructions dated 08-10-02 will not be undone.



The applicant being un-successful in the selection processes now can not challenge the action and on this score alone the application deserves to be dismissed with cost.


4. That with regard to the statement made in para VI-1 to 2 the answering respondents does not admit anything contrary to the relevant records of the case.

5. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.3.1 to 3.2. the answering respondents begs to state that the date of their appointment as 1st Fireman and posting as Diesel Asstt Driver are on 26-6-91 and 4-1-92 respectively.

6. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.3. the answering respondents begs to state that ~~the~~ his date of appointment as Khalasi is on 8-4-83 redesignated as Engine Cleaner on 3-2-87 & his promotion as 2nd Fireman, 1st Fireman and posting as Diesel Asstt Driver happened on 25-3-87, 7-4-93 and 19-7-94 respectively.

7. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.4 of the OA the answering respondents begs to state that the applicant No.4 was appointed in Rly. as Diesel Khalasi on 17-9-86, re-designated as Engine Cleaner on 22-2-89 (on option) in Mech. Deptt. and date of promotion as 2nd Fireman & Diesel Asstt Driver are on 8-11-89 & 2-4-99 respectively.

8. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.5 of

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the DA the answering respondents begs to state that the date of appointment of the applicant No.5 as Engine Cleaner, promotion as Engine Cleaner Helper and Diesel Asstt. Driver are on 11-11-89, 21-7-92 and 23-3-2000 respectively.

9. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.6 of the DA the answering respondents begs to state that the date of appointment of the applicant No.6 as Engine Cleaner, promotion as Engine Cleaner Helper and Diesel Asstt. Driver are on 8-11-89, 15-7-92 & 23-3-2000 respectively.

10. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.7 of the DA the answering respondents begs to state that the date of appointment of the applicant No.7 as Engine Cleaner, promotion as Engine Cleaner Helper & Diesel Asstt. Driver are on 08-11-89, 22-7-92 & 23-3-2000 respectively.

11. That with regard to the statement made in para 3.8 of the DA the answering respondents begs to state that the date of appointment of the applicant NO.8 as Engine Cleaner, Promotion as Engine Cleaner Helper and Diesel Asstt Driver are on 8-11-89, 15-7-92 & 23-3-2000-respectively.

3.3.1 to 3.2

12. That with regard to the statement made in para 4 to 9 of the DA the answering respondents donot admit anything contrary to the relevant records of the case.

13. That with regard to the statement made in para 10 & 11 of the DA the answering respondents begs to state that the DME/C&W/LMG had desired to have the position in respect of

passing the promotional, course training and Psychological Test of the candidates for sending the same to HQ (Maligaon).

That the DME/LMG's and Sr.DME/LMG's letters dtd 9-6-04 and 13-7-04 respectively, are the internal correspondence of the Rly. administration. These are not conclusive as the entire selection process for the post of Goods Driver was under examination at Hd Qr. level by GM Maligaon who canceled the selection on the ground of irregularities as mentioned in GM(p)/MLG's letter No.E/254/5211(M)PU dated 11-9-04 (Photocopy enclosed). Accordingly selection held as per notification dtd 14-10-03 has been canceled and a fresh selection has been initiated vide Memorandum No.F/254/1/LM(RG)/M Dtd. 24-12-04 to fill up the 142 vacant posts of Driver.

It may be pointed out that the applicants' name have been included in the eligibility list attached with the notification dtd. 22-12-04 and in the letter dtd 27-1-05 (Copy enclosed). Rly. Drivers belong to top safety category. They are the persons upon whom the lives of thousands of passengers and safe transit of goods depend. Any kind lapses and irregularity in their selection would be fatal for the society.

14. That with regard to the statement made in para 12 & 14 of the OA the answering respondents begs to state that the selection and restructuring are two different matters. The applicants mixed the two matters with misconception.

All benefits were extended "to the eligible staff by modified selection for implementation of the restructuring in running category since the benefit had been made within the individual category itself (maintaining the percentage) such as Goods Driver to Sr Goods Driver, and passenger Driver to Sr.

Passenger Driver.


15. That with regard to the statement made in para 15 of the OA the answering respondents denies the correctness of the same.

16. That with regard to the statement made in para 16 of the OA the answering respondents begs to state that the earlier selection for the post of Goods Driver vide notification No.F./254/1/LM(RG)/M Dtd,14-10-03 was canceled as there were irregularities in the selection process. Accordingly a fresh selection vide notification dtd. 22-12-04 (Annexure-G to OA) was initiated to fill up the 142 vacant posts of Goods Driver.

There was no stay order from the Hon,ble Tribunal to hold selection. Moreover the Rly. Admn. cannot close its eyes as to the large number of shortage of Goods Driver in the Train movement. For up keeping the train operation~ filling up of the post of Goods Driver was felt highly necessary and accordingly a fresh selection was called vide notification dtd. 22-12-04.

17. That with regard to the statement made in para 17 of the OA the answering respondents begs to state that the names of S/Shri Simanta Rn.Barooah, Ranjit Chutia,. Ajoy Chanda, Dipak Kr.Roy, Tamal Bhattacharjee were not initially included in the eligibility list for non completion of requisite foot plate experience as prescribed. However, their names were included on completion of requisite foot plate experience vide order dated.

18. That with regard to the statement made in para 18 of the OA the answering respondents begs to state that the names of

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all the applicants have been included in the eligibility list vide No.E./254/1/LM(RG)/M dtd.22-12-04 and letter of even No. dtd.27-1-05. In this connection the Misc. petition for granting the stay order filed by the applicants were dismissed by the Hon'ble Tribunal.

19. That with regard to the statement made in para 19 of the OA the answering respondents beg to state that the fresh selection is initiated based on the cancellation of earlier panel. The administration had not received any stay order on the selection. Moreover, the administration cannot sleep over the issue having large number of vacancies.

20. That with regard to the statement made in para 20 of the OA the answering respondents beg to state that in the context of the preceding paragraph, the OA has got no merit at all and deserves to be dismissed with cost.

You are also requested to ensure that no irregularities in the selection process are occur this time. In respect of the selection under reference, it is requested to fix responsibility in respect of the following"

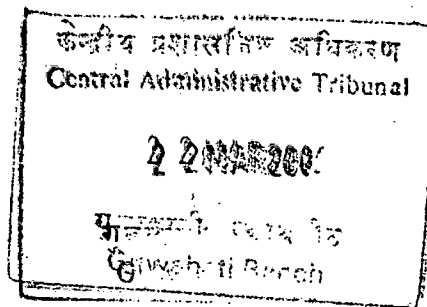
- (i) Non-setting up of bi-lingual question paper :

The Applicants in the above named applications most  
humbly and respectfully beg to state as under: -

- 1) That the preliminary objection raised in Para - 3 of the written statements that the applicants were unsuccessful in the selection and therefore cannot challenge the action is totally denied. That the applicants were declared successful in the last selection and they were empanelled for promotion to Goods Driver and the panel was duly approved.
- 2) That as to the statements made in Para 5 -11 to the Written Statement it is stated that the relevant dates are supported by official documents annexed to the Original Application.

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- 3) That as to the statements in Para – 13 of the Written Statement it is stated that the D.M.E, (C & W) Lumding through his letter No. G / 58 (Training) dated 09.06.2004 (at Annexure: - C) intended to prepare for posting of the selected candidates of the panel on promotion. That the D.M.E. Lumding's and Sr. D.M.E Lumding's letter were conclusive as to the postponement of the effect of the panel from being translated into posting on promotion to the long vacant posts of Goods Drivers.

That the General Manager, Maligaon in canceling the selection and initiating a fresh selection through his letter dated 16.09.2004 as indicated in the Para – 13 of the written statement did not act on relevant considerations and valid reasons and therefore cannot have an overriding effect on a positive act of selection long ago approved by the highest level authority of the division vested in Divisional Railway Manager, Lumding.

- 4) That as to the statement in Para – 15 of written statement it is stated that this statement is wrong and that the cancellation of the selection is part of the subject matter in O.A. No. 182 / 2004 before this Hon'ble Tribunal.
- 5) That the statement in Para – 16 of the written statement is rebutted with the statement that the supposed irregularities serving as the basis for cancellation of the selection by the General Manager led to an erroneous conclusion by the General Manager that the selection process had shortfalls because the pass percentage at 64 out of 273 is low. This was an extraneous consideration for the cancellation. That a cryptic order such as this by the General Manager is bad in law in that it has violated

the fully blossomed right of some 63 candidates for promotion the applicants included.

- 6) That the statement in Para – 17 of the Written Statement is not correct. Sri Simanta Rajon Barooah and Sri Ranjit Chutia had the requisite experience to be eligible for the selection and on that basis they were called for the previous selection and were selected.
- 7) That with regard to the statements made in the Para – 19 of written statement it is stated that initiation of a fresh selection is beyond the authority of law because the cancellation of the selection by the General Manager is bad in law as shown in Para 3 and 5 above.
- 8) It is stated that the impugned order issued by APO II dated 22.12.2004 and by implication impugned orders of Sr. DME Lunding dated 13.07.2004, General Manager (P) Maligaon's letter dated 16.09.2004 and dated 21.09.2004 for cancellation of the panel depriving the applicants from their due promotion was made with misapplication of mind and without any authority of law.

That under the facts and circumstances of the case as stated in the application <sup>Applicant</sup> are entitled for the reliefs sought for in the application. Further, the grounds shown in the Original Application are full of justification and having force of law and as such the application is full of merit. The application deserves to be allowed with costs.
