

2. The applicant applied for a Group 'D' post pursuant to an advertisement (Annexure - III) of the Railway Recruitment Board dated 28.06.2003. It is the case of the applicant that he had passed the departmental examination conducted on 09.11.2003 and also the physical efficiency test on 10.05.2005; he was called for verification of documents on 11.06.2005. His grievance is that he had not been called for medical examination. It is stated that the applicant had made representation dated 02.09.2005 (Annexure - VII(A)) before the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent, but no reply has been received.


3. According to the counsel for the applicant in view of the fact that the applicant had passed the written test, physical efficiency test and also produced the documents for verification, he is entitled to know the result and as to why he was not selected.

(1) PARTICULARS OF THE ORDERS AGAINST  
WHICH THIS APPLICATION IS MADE :

The application is made against the representation dated 21-9-2005 filed by the applicant/petitioner for not calling/allowing him to appear before the medical test/examination in spite of fulfilling the requisite qualification for the Group 'D' post as per Employment Notice No.1/03.

(2) JURISDICTION OF THE TRIBUNAL :

The application declares that the subject matter of the application in which the applicant seeks relief is within the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

(3) LIMITATION :

The application further declares that the application is within the limitation period prescribed under the Act.

(4) FACT OF THE CASE :

(a) That the applicant is a citizen of India and is the resident of New Colony, P.O.-Lumding, P.S.-Lumding, Dist-Nagaon, Assam.

(b) The applicant begs to state that he hails from a very poor family, comprising mother, one sister and one brother and he also belongs to the Yogi Community, and the same is recognized as

Other Backward Classes. The applicant after the death of his father late Sri Umesh Chandra Debnath could prosecute his studies till Class IX standard. After the death of his father he was compelled to leave his studies on account of financial hardship.

A copy of the Caste Certificate and School Certificate studying in 9th standard as issued by the Head Master B.M.B. High School, Lumding, is Annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-I & II respectively.

(c) That the applicant begs to state that Railway Recruitment Board published as advertisement on 28-6-2003 in the Employment Notice No.1/03 whereby the applications were invited in the prescribed format from the eligible candidates for Group 'D' post i.e. Trackman/Khalashi/Helper etc.

A photo copy containing important points of the advertisement dated 28-6-2003 is enclosed herewith as marked as Annexure-III.

(d) That the applicant begs to state that the humble applicant duly filled his application along with necessary testimonials and after due verification your humble applicant was

(j) That the humble applicant begs to state that your humble applicant did not find his roll number in the list of successful candidates as published in the Employment News in its issue dated 6 to 12 August, 2005 although the applicant successfully completed written examination, Physical Efficiency Test and also he was qualified in document verification conducted in the office of R.R.B., Guwahati. The applicant, in spite of possessing his due qualification for the post of Group 'D' (Trackman/Khalasi/Helper II) did not find place in the list of successful candidates qualified for the Medical Efficiency Test, for the reason best known to the respondent authority. The applicant, however, wanted to know the reason as to why he has not been qualified for Medical Examination but the respondent authority failed to give a satisfactory reply in his query.

(k) That your humble applicant begs to state that being aggrieved in such circumstances and greatly effected due to such irregularities your applicant submitted a representation on 21-9-2005 before the respondents authority highlighting his grievance. The humble applicant submitting representation pointed out the

the irregularities in omitting his roll number in the result as published in the employment News in issue dated 6 to 12 August, 2005. The respondent authority did not give any information your humble applicant for not empannelling him for medical Examination.

(1) That your humble applicant begs to state that the respondent Authority did not disposed of the representation and simply siting tight over the issue.

(m) That finding no other alternative and seeing no hope of a positive response from the respondents, the humble applicant has no other alternative but to file this application before this Hon'ble Tribunal for redressal of his grievances.

(n) That this application is being filed bonafide and for the ends of justice.

(5) DETAILS OF REMEDIES EXHAUSTED :

(b) For that when the humble applicant have fulfilled his due qualification it is the legitimate expectation of the applicant call for medical Examination/Test like that of other candidate who appeared for the same. Thus not calling the humble applicant is highly illegal and improper in the eye of law.

(9) INTERIM RELIEF PRAYED FOR :

During pendency of the original application your humble applicant prays that on direction may be issued to keep a post vacant for applicant and the respondents authority may be directed that the select list of the successful candidate may not be published without the leave of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

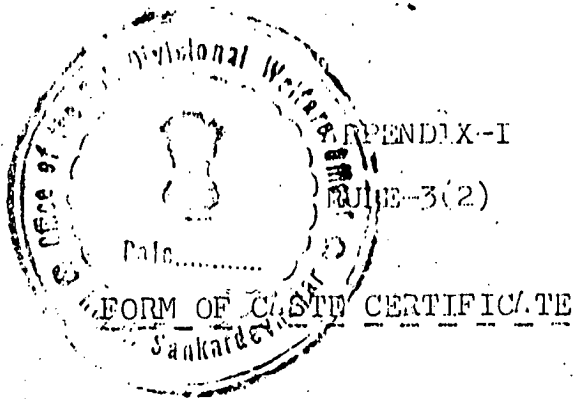

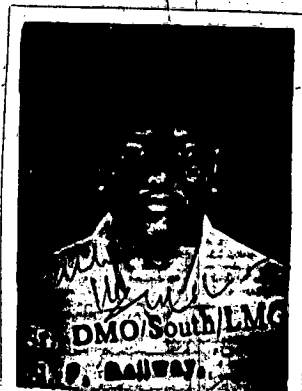
