





The written statement filed in this case is not at all a transparent one. In all fairness of things, the Respondents should produce the records of proceedings of the CSC dated 24.01.2003. They should disclose what was the total vacancy position in the Direct Recruitment Quota for the year 2001 and for 2002. The Respondents have filed a document as Annexure-1 enclosed in the written objection filed in this case (in reply to the Rejoinder) but the said document is an incomplete one. Annexure to the said Annexure-1 should be produced by the Respondents in this case. The Respondents should disclose clearly the details of the persons appointed on compassionate grounds during 2001 and during 2002.

They should prepare the details of persons given employment on compassionate grounds in a format comparing the details relating to the Applicant. Without these details adverse inference shall be drawn against the Respondents of this case.

On the prayer of Mr G. Baishya, learned Sr. Standing Counsel, call this matter on 07.08.2008; when all the aforesaid details should be furnished before this Tribunal in the shape of an Additional Written Statement.

Send copies of this order to the Applicant and to all the Respondents in the addresses given in the O.A. and a free copy of this order be supplied to Mr G. Baishya, learned Sr. Standing Counsel; who should ensure that all details are furnished by the date fixed.





Mr A. Khaleque, learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant, and Mr G. Baishya, learned Sr. Standing Counsel for the Union of India, are present. Mr G. Baishya has produced materials to show that a large number of candidates (for compassionate <sup>appointments</sup>) received consideration of the Committee and, out of them, only six have been given compassionate employment as against <sup>57</sup> vacancies of the year 2001. He has produced materials to show that during 2002 vacancies were not enough to accommodate anybody on compassionate ground as against 5% quota. However, he has not been able to produce any materials to show that during the years 2003, 2004 and 2005 there were any vacancy available for granting compassionate appointment and as to whether anybody was considered as against vacancies of those years and as to whether the Applicant received consideration against vacancies of those years.

In the aforesaid premises, one more opportunity is given to Mr G. Baishya to obtain materials from the Respondents to show as to what was the vacancy position during the year 2003, 2004 and 2005 and the minutes of the proceedings (for compassionate appointment) for the vacancies of those years.

In course of hearing Mr A. Khaleque, learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant, disclosed that one Smt Parbati Das received compassionate employment during the year 2005 and another Smt Saroda Baishya got compassionate appointment during the year 2004. If that is so, then there was some consideration

ORDER (ORAL)


The Applicant applied for compassionate appointment on the ground that the Applicant's father Late Moina Ram Deka (while in service as a Mailman under Senior Record Officer/R.M.S.Guwahati Division at Rangia) died on 05.10.2001. The application for compassionate ground was rejected on 24.01.2003. The Applicant also alleged that others, who were similarly placed, were given appointment



to Group D post. Since representation of the Applicant was not decided, he filed O.A.232/2004; which was disposed of by this Tribunal, on 19.05.2005, with direction to the Respondents to consider the representation of the Applicant and to pass a reasoned order. The Respondents considered the representation of the Applicant and, vide order dated 26.08.2005, rejected the claim of the Applicant on the ground that the claim of the Applicant (on consideration as against the vacancy of 2001) having been rejected, his claim to consider his case "for the vacancies of 2002 does not arise as there is no provision to empanel earlier rejected candidate." Aggrieved by this order, the Applicant has filed this second round of litigation seeking mainly the following relief :-

"The Respondents may be directed to appoint the Applicant in any post, as a special "Cancer Patient's case, on compassionate ground, by relaxing the normal Rules."

2. The Respondents have filed a written statement stating therein that Chief Postmaster General of Assam Circle rejected the case of the Applicant as the same was not recommended by Circle Selection Committee earlier. His case was considered against vacancies of 2001. Therefore, the consideration of the case (in 2002) does not arise, as there is no provision to empanel earlier rejected candidates. It has been stated that Late Moina Ram Deka died on 05.10.2001 and his son Shri Hemanta Deka filed his claim for compassionate appointment. His case was duly considered by the Respondents and could not be acceded to, as sufficient number of vacancies were not available (which is limited to the extent of 5% of the vacancies for direct recruitment



quota) in the given year. Moreover, the widow of the deceased Smt Uttara Deka had received Rs. 2,19,503/- as retrieval benefits including GPF and she was getting family pension of Rs.3378/- p.m. plus Rs.10/- fixed medical allowance.


3. The Applicant has filed Rejoinder stating that the plea of "no vacancy" is not correct and has been made to mislead the Tribunal. It has specifically alleged that the case of one Smt Sarada Baishya was considered in the year 2002 (although it was a case of 2001) and that, similarly, the case of Smt Parbati Das was also considered 4½ years after the death of her husband and that therefore, the case of the Applicant merit consideration.

4. The Respondents has also filed a Reply to the Rejoinder stating that the compassionate appointment case of the Applicant was examined on the basis of selection conducted by Circle Selection Committee under relaxation of normal rules; but the case did not qualify for compassionate appointment. The allegation of arbitrariness against the Respondents has been denied.

5. This Tribunal in its order dated 11.08.2008 had observed as under :-

"One more opportunity is given to Mr G.Baishya to obtain materials from the Respondents to show as to what was the vacancy position during the year 2003, 2004 and 2005 and the minutes of the proceedings (for compassionate appointment) for the vacancies of those years."


The learned Sr. Standing counsel appearing for the Respondents has produced copies of the proceedings for the year 2003, 2004 and 2005 for perusal of the Tribunal.




Learned counsel for the Applicant, Mr Khaleque argued that the case of the Applicant merit consideration for at least 3 times as per Government policy and as the similar other cases have received consideration on more than one consideration (as in this case no further consideration was given) direction ought to be given to give further consideration to the case of Applicant.

6. Mr G.Baishya, learned Sr. Standing counsel in his argument stated that the case of the Applicant has been considered but it was not found indigent enough as compared to other cases where appointments have been given and that the cases referred to by the Applicant were more deserving as compared that of the Applicant.

7. We have considered the rival contentions of the parties and perused the materials placed on record. The case of the Applicant has been considered once in 2001 and the same could not be considered for the subsequent years 2002, 2003 and 2004. The other cases (referred to by the Applicant) are more or less similar to that of the Applicant. As per policy of compassionate appointment, the case of each individual should receive at least 3 considerations. Accordingly, we dispose of this case with direction to the Respondents to consider the case of the Applicant, again, on two more occasions (as against the available vacancies) to provide him compassionate employment.

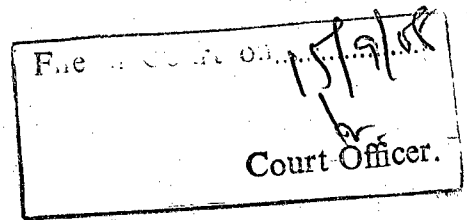

MINUTES OF THE CIRCLE SELECTION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 04.05.2005 FOR  
CONSIDERATION OF APPOINTMENT AGAINST DEPARTMENTAL  
VACANCIES UNDER RELAXATION OF NORMAL RECRUITMENT RULES

The Circle Selection Committee comprising the following members for considering the cases for appointment under relaxation of normal recruitment rules met on 4.5.2005 in the Chamber of the Chief Postmaster General, Assam Circle, Guwahati.

2. All together 42 (forty two) cases as per the register maintained in CO, are placed before the CSC for consideration for appointment on compassionate ground. The cadre-wise break up is as follows.

For PA cadre	-	17
For Postman cadre	-	17
For Group-D cadre	-	8

2.1 Besides the above 42 (forty two) cases, 6 (six) cases, which were recommended for re-consideration by the earlier CSC held on 2.4.2004 were also taken up with the above 42 (forty two) cases.

2.2 The case of Shri Rupak Dey, S/o Late Hrishindra Ch Dey, Serial No. 16/03 (as per register) which was rejected on the ground that there are more deserving cases, by the earlier CSC held on 2.4.2004, has been placed before the CSC again for Postman vacancy. In compliance with Hon'ble CAT order, reasoned and speaking order highlighting the various factors considered while examining applicant's case for compassionate appointment may be issued immediately to the applicant and intimation be sent to the Hon'ble CAT.

3. As per Ministry of Personnel P.G. & Pension DOP&T No.14014/23/99-Estt.(D) dated 3.12.99 the committee for appointment on compassionate grounds should take into account the position regarding availability of vacancy for such appointment and it should recommend appointments on compassionate grounds only in a really deserving cases and only if vacancy meant for appointment on compassionate grounds will be available within a year and that too within the ceiling of 5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota. Accordingly, the committee examined the relevant records and found that following posts are to be filled up for appointment on compassionate ground under direct recruitment quota for the year 2003 and 2004.

That the Hon'ble Tribunal after hearing both the parties in O.A. No. 232/04 on 19.5.2005 directed the respondent to dispose of the pending representation Annexure "F" & "G" with a reasoned order. The respondent No.3 in that order dt. 26.8.2005 rejected the representation of the applicant. Annexure- "F" & "G". And being highly aggrieved by the said order the applicant prefer this O.A. before the Hon'ble Tribunal. 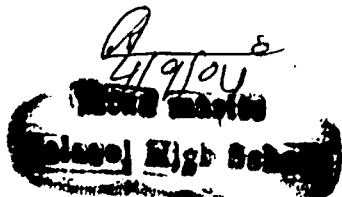

SIVARAJAN, J.(V.C.)

The applicant applied for compassionate appointment on the ground that the applicant's father Late Moina Ram Deka a Mailman (B.C.R.) under Senior Record Officer, R.M.S., Guwahati Division at Rangia died while in service in 5.10.2001. The said application was rejected by the Circle Selection Committee held on 24.1.2003 which was conveyed vide communication dated 24.3.2003 at Annexure-E stating that there is no vacancy in any cadre. The applicant then

submitted representations (Annexure- F & G) to the second respondent i.e. Chief Post Master General. Since there is no response this application is filed.

2. Respondents have filed their written statement. Nothing is stated in the written statement about the filing of Annexure F & G representations. Only attempt made therein is to say that the applicant is not entitled to compassionate appointment. Mr. A. Khaleque, counsel for the applicant submitted that third respondent did not say that the applicant is not eligible for compassionate appointment and that the impugned order only stated that there is no vacancy for giving compassionate appointment. Counsel for the applicant placed before us a communication No.Staff/16-CSC/2004 dated 13.5.2005 passed by the Assistant Postmaster General (Staff) O/o the Chief Postmaster General, Assam Circle, Guwahati giving compassionate appointment to the post of PA Cadre to 3 persons, Postman Cadre to one person and Group 'D' to another person and submitted that all these appointments were made with reference to the persons who died in employment subsequent to the death of applicant's father. He also pointed out that Smt. Sarada Bala Baishya was given compassionate appointment to Group 'D' post in the remaining vacancy of 2002 Grade 'D' Cadre alongwith the post of Guwahati Division diverted to CO/Guwahati. Mr.M.U.Ahmed, Addl.C.G.S.C. submitted that the applicant cannot be given posting of his choice and that he wanted appointment only in a Group 'D' post. Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant wanted compassionate appointment to any post to which he is entitled.

3. Having considered the matter we are of the view that impugned order is not a satisfactory one. However, since the applicant has

submitted Annexure - F & G representations before the second respondents, which has not been denied by the respondents in their written statement, we direct the second respondent to consider all these matters projected by the applicant and to pass a reasoned order on the representations made by the applicant and rejected by the third respondents. This will be done within a period of three months from the receipt of a copy of this order.

The Original Application is disposed of as above.

O R D E R

Shri Hemanta Deka, S/o Late Moina Ram Deka applied for compassionate appointment in SA/PA Group 'C' cadre under relaxation of normal recruitment rules in 2002. The applicant's father Late Moina Ram Deka was SG MM(BCR) in the Department of Posts and died on 5.10.2001 in hareness while he was working at SRO, Rangia.

2. The case of the applicant was duly considered and processed by the authorities concerned. After completion of all administrative exercises, the case of the applicant was placed before the Circle Selection Committee(CSC) which met on 24.1.03 against the vacancies of Direct Recruitment quota for 2001. The number of vacancies kept reserved in respect of PA/SA cadre under compassionate appointment was 3 only as per ceiling of 5% of direct recruitment quota for 2001. The case was considered with utmost sympathy but could not be recommended for appointment due to want of vacancy and there being other cases for compassionate appointment which were found more deserving. The applicant was informed through the concerned Divisional Head about the rejection of the case accordingly. The SSRM, 'GH' RMS Division conveyed the decision to the applicant vide letter dated 24.3.03 as intimated by the applicant.

3. The CSC went through all the cases and decided to select the most deserving candidates based on the following criteria.

- i) First preference was given to these cases where there were maximum liabilities in the family. Education of minor children and marriage of daughters in the family of the deceased employee were considered as liabilities. Hence, the families having maximum number of minor children and unmarried daughters were given first preference.

- ii) In case where the liabilities of families were same. the case where applicant was widow herself, was given preference.
- iii) If the case still could not be decided on the above two criteria the family which received less terminal benefits and pension was given preference.

4. It is pertinent to mention here that the Hon'ble Supreme Court has determined guiding principles, yardsticks and parameters for deciding compassionate appointment cases which are as follows:-

- i) The only dependents of an employee dying in hareness leaving his family in penury and without means of livelihood can be appointed on compassionate ground.
- ii) That the whole object of granting compassionate appointment is to enable the family to tide over the sudden crisis to relieve the family of the deceased from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.
- iii) The High Court and Administrative Tribunal cannot give direction for appointment of a person on compassionate ground but can only direct consideration of the claim for such an appointment.
- iv) That the appointment on compassionate grounds can be made only if a vacancy is available for the purpose.
- v) The Scheme is not intended to ensure that each and every member of the family of deceased employee is employed. Such appointment can be provided only to fill up upto 5% of vacancies that arises for direct recruitment.

5. The above guidelines and parameters are determined by the Hon'ble Supreme Court while giving various judgements on the subject. As sufficient number of vacancies were not available in the cadre applied for appointment on compassionate ground at the time of considering the case, the applicant could not be recommended by the CSC for compassionate appointment which is very much limited to the extent of 5% of the vacancies for direct recruitment quota in the given year.

Accordingly, the CSC considered the cases with utmost care and due deliberation and selected other candidates against the vacancy available that year because the cases were more indigent in comparison to Shri Hemanta Deka who could not be selected because his liabilities were less. The particulars of selected candidates alongwith liabilities in PA/SA cadre for that year are as :-

<u>Particulars of candidates</u>	<u>Liabilities in the family</u>
1. Miss Hiramoni Haloi (daughter)-- 1)	5 unmarried daughters
2)	education of minors
2. Shri Babul Boro (son) - 1)	2 unmarried daughters
2)	education of 4 children
3. Miss Lalita Bora (daughter) -	four unmarried daughters

But in the case of Shri Hemanta Deka, the liabilities are one unmarried daughter and education of 2 minors. The compassionate appointment is considered to render immediate assistance for relief from financial destitution to the most indigent and deserving family left behind by the deceased employees.

The case of Smt. Sarada Baishya as cited in the representation dated 16.8.03 (Annexure-F) was recommended by the CSC held in 2.4.04 for the vacancies of direct recruitment quota for the year 2002. The candidate was a widow and applied for Group-D post. The dependents of the deceased official were the widow (candidate), one minor son and 3 minor daughters. The case of Shri Hemanta Deka was considered against the vacancy of 2001 and rejected so his case being considered for the vacancies of 2002 does not arise as there is no provision to empanel earlier rejected candidate. Moreover as vacancies are limited and cases of compassionate appointment being more, only few of the compassionate cases are approved and others are rejected. It will be observed that the order rejecting compassionate appointments covers the number of other applicants besides Shri Deka, which can only be shown as lack of that many vacancies.

dents begs to state that as the Circle, Selection Committee for the appointment, CPMG, Assam Circle has rejected the case of the applicant the question of mere fore appointment of the applicant does not arise.

4. That as regards to the statements made in paragraph 4.6 of the application the answering respondents begs to state that as per recommendation of Circle Selection Committee Smt Sarada Bala Baishya was appointed. As the Circle Selection Committee did not recommend the case of the applicant, the Chief Post Master General Assam Circle rejected his case of appointment. The case of the Smt Sarada Bala Baishya was recommended by the CSC held in 2.04.2004 for the vacancies of direct recruitment quota for the year 2002 and the candidate was a widow and applied for Group "D" post. The dependents of the deceased officials were the widow (Smt Sarada Bala Baishya) one minor son and three minor daughters. But the case of Sri Hemanta Deka was considered against the vacancies of 2001 and the case of Hemanta Deka was rejected after the consideration. Therefore his case for the consideration of 2002 does not arise as there is no provision to empenal earlier rejected candidate.

5. That as regards to the statements made in paragraph 4.7 of the application the answering respondents begs to state that the case of the recruitment under relaxation of normal rules as compassionate ground

are examined and recommended by Circle Selection Committee. On the basis of Selection of Circle Selection Committee the Chief Post Master General, Assam Circle approves the appointments under relaxation of normal rule.

As stated earlier as the case of the applicant was not recommended by the Circle Selection Committee his case was not considered by the CPMG.

Moreover the appointment of compassionate grounds can be made only if a vacancy is available for the purpose that too limited to 5% of the vacancies for direct recruitment quota in a given year held by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its ruling in the case of H.R. Transport Corporation -vs- Dinesh Kumar (JT 1996(5) SC 319) on 7.5.96 and Hindustan Aeronautics Limited -vs- Smt. A. Radhika Thirumalai (JT 1996(9) SC 197) on 9.10.1996. It is pertinent to mention that the father of the applicant, Late Maina Ram Deka worked as a Mailman under SRO Rangia and died in Cancer on 5.10.2001 after completing 37 years of service in the Department. After considering all the facts and circumstances of the applicant the respondent rejected the case of the applicant against the vacancies of 2001.

6. That in respect of the statements made in paragraph 4.8, 4.9 and 4.10 of the application the answering respondents to offer no comments.

7. That with regards to the statements made in paragraph 4.11 of the application the answering respondents beg to state that the vacancies marked for the appointment under relaxation of normal rules is 5% of the outsiders quota of the vacancies. No case of relaxation of normal rules could be considered against other vacancies except the 5% of the vacancies of outsider quota marked for the purpose.

8. That as regards to the statements made in paragraph 4.12 of the application the answering respondents beg to offer no comment.

9. That in respect of the statements made in paragraph 4.13 of the instant application the answering respondents beg to state that all the cases under relaxation of normal rules are properly scrutinised by the Circle Selection Committee as the light of the existing rules and regulations on the subject. The case of the applicant was also properly examined by the Circle Selection Committee and did not recommend and thus the same was rejected.

10. That with regards to the statements made in paragraph 4.14 of the instant application the answering respondents beg to state that the averment of the applicant is not correct, hence denied. The respondents did

not violate any norms given by Supreme Court in considering the appointment of Smt Parbati Das.

11. That with regards to the statements made in paragraph 4.15 of the instant application the answering respondents beg to state that the averment of the applicant is not correct, hence the same are denied. It is denied that the respondent took discriminatory attitude or arbitrarily rejected the prayer of the applicant.

12. That with regards to the statements made in paragraph 5.i of the instant application the answering respondents beg to state that the case of the applicant was duly examined by the Circle Selection Committee but did not recommend and accordingly same was rejected. This does not violate any right of the applicant.

13. The applicant further begs to state that the respondent have every time referred to a Circle Selection Committee, which is a committee of 3 officers constituted by the Chief Post Master General to scrutinise the cases of compassionate appointment. 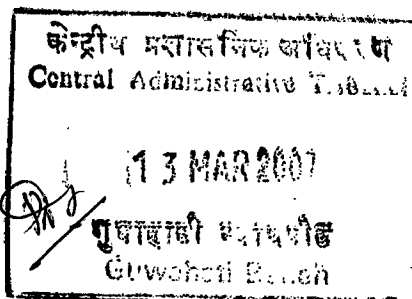



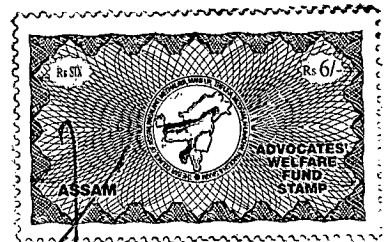
