Learned counsel Mr B.K.Sharma moves this application on behalf of applicant, Shri Hari Sankar Singh, Assistant Engineer, Central Ground Water Board, Division-VII, Guwahati. Learned Sr.C.G.S.C Mr S.Ali is present and receives copy of this application. They are heard.

The applicant is aggrieved as after serving in the North Eastern Region from 30.6.89 till now and having submitted a number of representations for his transfer to one of his choice places of posting in terms of the office memorandum No. 20014/3/83-E.IV dated 14.12.83 the respondents have not issued any positive order for his transfer to any place of posting chosen by him. This application is admitted.

There is no ground for further scrutiny and decision in this case and therefore the application is disposed of at the admission stage. The applicant had submitted his

representations for his transfer to Varanasi, Bhopal or to any other place in Uttar Pradesh. The respondents in reply to the representation of the applicant had expressed their view in the letter dated 28.11.94 (Annexure-12) that the case of the applicant will be considered at an appropriate time alongwith others. The applicant has submitted that a post of Assistant Engineer will fall vacant as a result of retirement of Shri R.C. Bakshi, an Assistant Engineer in Bhopal on 28.2.95.

In view of their intention to consider the case of the applicant to transfer him to one of the places of his choice and in view of the fact that a vacancy is to arise soon in Bhopal one of the places of his choice, the respondents are directed to consider the case of the applicant for his transfer to one of the places of his choice on a priority basis in terms of the office memorandum dated 14.12.83 mentioned in para 2 of the application. The applicant has served in the North Eastern Region for a long time and even long after the expiry of his prescribed tenure of two years and has also expressed his personal difficulties before the respondents. It is hoped that the respondents will take a sympathetic view and consider the case of the applicant as a special case for redressal of his grievance at the

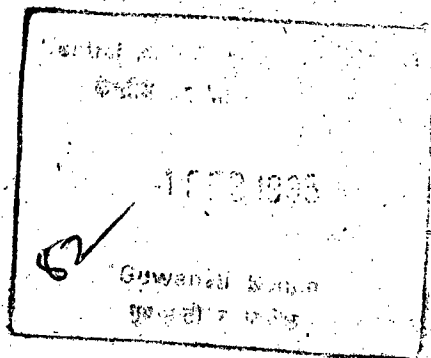

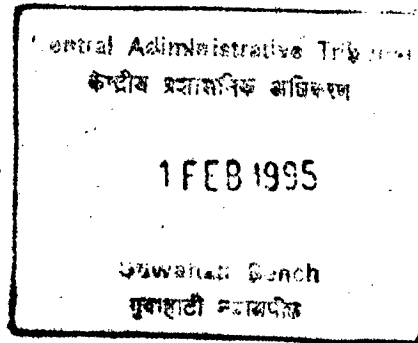

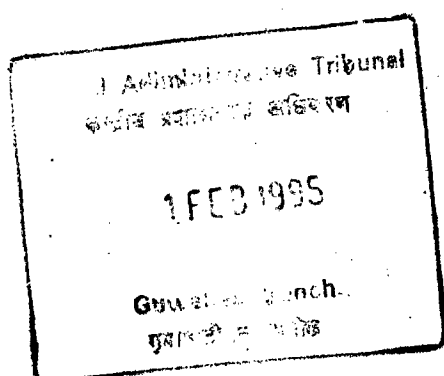

3. Particulars for which this application is made :

This application is made for choice station posting either at Vanarasi or in any Division under the Central Ground Water Board in the State of Uttar Pradesh or at Bhopal in the office of the Respondents in terms of office Memo dated 14.12.83.

4. Limitation :

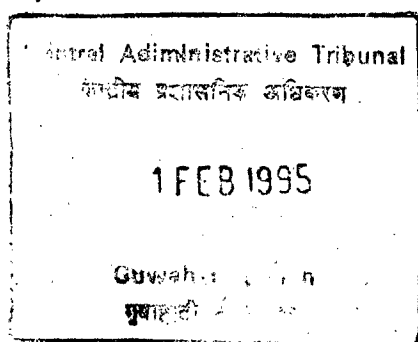
That this application is filed within the time period prescribed under the Central Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

5. Jurisdiction :

That the cause of action of this case is arisen with the jurisdiction of this Hon'ble Tribunal.

6. Facts of the case :

i. That the applicant is a citizen of India as such he is entitled to all the rights and privileges guaranteed by the Constitution of India. The applicant presently working as Assistant Engineer in the Central Ground Water Board, Division VII, Zoo Road, Guwahati under the Ministry of Water Resources, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The applicant initially joined in the service in the year 1973 as Junior Engineer, and served in different places in India. He was posted at Guwahati in public interest in the year 1989 and joined at Guwahati on 30.6.89 in the



office of the Executive Engineer, Central Ground Water Board (in short C.G.W.B) Division VII, Guwahati and serving in this region continuously more than five years with satisfaction to all concerned.

ii. That the Govt.. of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, New Delhi under office Memo No. 20014/3/83-E.IV dated 14.12.83 made special provision for choice station posting for the Central Govt. Civilian Employees serving in the North Eastern Region, The relevant portion of the letter dated 14.12.83 is quoted below :

" Subject : Allowances and facilities for Civilian Employees of the Central Govt. serving in the States and Union Territories of North Eastern Region - improvement thereof".

i. Tenure of posting/deputation

There will be a fixed tenure of posting of 3 years at a time for officers with service of 10 years or less and of 2 years at a time for officers with more than 10 years of service. Periods of leave, Training etc. in excess of 15 days per year will be excluded in counting the tenure of service mentioned above, may be considered for posting to a station of their choice as far as possible.

The period of deputation of the Central Govt. employees to the States/Union Territories of the North Eastern Region will generally be for 3 years which can be extended in exceptional cases in exigencies of public service as well as when the employee concerned is prepared to stay longer. The admissible deputation allowance will also continue to be paid during the period of deputation so extended".

xxx. Thatxx

Under the above scheme a Central Govt. employee on completion of his tenure posting entitled to a choice station posting.

iii. That the present applicant joined in the office of the Executive Engineer, C.G.W.B., Guwahati on 30.6.89 and after completion of his tenure posting for two years the applicant submitted his first representation on 15.10.91 through proper channel addressed to the Chief Engineer and Member, C.G.W.B. N.H. IV, Faridabad, Haryana on the ground of the applicant's family problems and prayed for his posting at Varanasi. The application was forwarded on 24.10.91 by the Executive Engineer, In-Charge. The administrative officer, C.G.W.B., N.H. IV, Faridabad in reply to the applicant's application dated 15.10.91 vide his letter No. 3-895/89 - Engg.Estt. dated 23.1.92 informed that the request of the applicant for transfer has been noted in the request register and would be considered in due course. Be it stated that

the applicant with reference to his application dated 15.10.91 submitted another representation dated 23.1.92. The applicant again submitted another application dated 14.10.93 and further requested for his posting at ~~Vanarasi~~ which is nearest to his home town so that he can look after his family members particularly for arranging the marriage of his daughter and also for looking after his sons and aged father. The Executive Engineer forwarded the application dtd. 14.10.93 vide his letter No. DIB,VII/ESTT./P-383/93-1028 dated 20.10.93 whereby the Executive Engineer forwarded the application to the Chief Engineer and Member C.G.W.B., NH IV, Faridabad. The administrative officer again informed the applicant vide his letter dated 11.11.93 ~~xxx~~ that his case of transfer will be considered alongwith others.

Copies of the letter dated 15.10.91, 24.10.91, 21.1.92, 23.1.92, 14.10.93, 20.10.93 and reply dated 11.11.93 are annexed as Annexure 1,2,3,4,5,6, and 7 respectively

iv. That the applicant thereafter submitted representation dated 29.9.94 addressed to the Chief Engineer, and Member, C.G.W.B., Faridabad NH IV, wherein it is stated by the applicant that he has completed more that 5 years of service in the North Eastern Region and his aged father is suffering from

old age chronic diseases, therefore his posting is extremely necessary nearest to his home town either at Varanasi Division III or in any other proposed Division under C.G.W.B. in the state of Uttar Pradesh or Bhopal in Division No. XII where Sri R.C. Bakshi Assistant Engineer is going to be retired on 28.2.95 on superannuation. This representation is also forwarded by the Executive Engineer vide his letter No. DIB/VII/Estt/trans/94-1094 dated 4.10.94. The applicant further submitted representation dated 24.11.94 through proper channel which is also forwarded by the Executive Engineer vide his letter No. DIB/VII/Estt/P-383/94-341 dated 25.11.94. In this representation the applicant reiterated his earlier option for choice station posting. Surprisingly the administrative officer, Faridabad informed the applicant through Executive Engineer, ~~Guwahati~~ Guwahati that his case for transfer would be considered at appropriate time alongwith others. The applicant being highly aggrieved by this decision of the respondents. Be it stated that the case of the applicant should be considered on priority basis in terms of O.M. dated 14.12.83. Therefore question of consideration of his transfer case alongwith others does not arise as the other Assistant Engineer serving in C.G.W.B. in other parts of the country is not covered under O.M. dated 14.12.83 and the case of the applicant deserves special consideration in the light of O.M. dated 14.12.83.

v. That the applicant after ~~received~~ receipt of the letter dated 28.11.94 submitted another application dated 13.12.94 wherein the applicant stated that the O.M. dated 14.12.83 has been totally ignored in the matter of his transfer and also stated that his transfer case cannot be tagged with the transfer of other employees of the C.G.W.B. Therefore ~~xxxxxx~~ his case of transfer should be considered in the light of O.M. dated 14.12.83. This is also forwarded by the Executive Engineer under his letter No. DIV/VII/Estt/P-383/94-1465 dated 15.12.94 to the Chief Engineer and member, C.G.W.B. Faridabad wherein it is also stated that if the case of the applicant is considered a suitable substitute may be provided in the interest of Government work. The Superintending Engineer, C.G.W.B., Eastern Circle, Calcutta vide his letter No. 551/SEEC/FA/94 dated 21.12.94 addressed to the Chief Engineer, CGWB, Faridabad requested that if the case of the applicant for transfer is considered a suitable substitute may be provided otherwise the work of the Division would be adversely affected. Be it stated that the C.G.W.B. under the Ministry of Water Resources is a very big establishment and there are presently 23 nos. of Assistant Engineers are serving in the different parts of the country but only a few Assistant Engineer of C.G.W.B.

had the test of serving in the backward N.E. Region. Therefore Govt. of India set up a Special Committee for improvement and facilities of Central Govt. Civilian Employees and the Govt. of India was pleased to accept the recommendation of the Special Committee and declare several concession and facilities under Office Memorandum No. 20014/3/83-E. IV dated 14.12.83. It may be stated that the Special Committee was set up at the initiative of the then Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. But the guidelines and instructions laid down in the said O.M. dated 14.12.83 not following in letter and spirit in the department of C.G.W.B. and thereby the applicant who is serving more than 5 years in this region not considered for his choice station posting which is arbitrary illegal and unfair. There are many officers in the cadre of Assistant Engineer serving in C.G.W.B. they should also be posted on rotational basis in this remote corner of the country. and the Hon'ble Tribunal be pleased to direct the respondents for immediate posting of applicant in terms of preference in terms of his option stated in letter dated 29.9.94.

Representation dated 13.12.94 forwarding letter dated 15.12.94 and Superintending Engineer's letter dated 21.12.94 are annexed as Annexure 13, 14 and 15 respectively.

vi. That the applicant further begs to state that the Assistant Engineer Sri G. Sengupta who is serving at present Vanarasi for last morethan 5 years and Sri R C Bakshi,

Assistant Engineer serving at Bhopal under C.G.W.B. is going to be retired on superannuation on 28.2.95. Therefore there is no difficulty on the part of the respondents to accommodate the applicant either at Vanarasi or in place of Sri R.C. Bakshi with effect from 1st March 1995. It may also be stated that there are also proposal for creation of New Divisions in the State of Uttar Pradesh. If there are existing vacancy in the proposed Division the applicant may be accommodated in those proposed Division. However, a clear vacancy of Assistant Engineer is going to be available at Bhopal in the event of superannuation of Sri R C Bakshi, Assistant Engineer. Therefore the applicant be accommodated at Bhopal if it is not possible at Vanarasi immediately in terms of O.M. dated 14.11.83. The applicant is apprehending that the respondents may consider the transfer of other interested Assistant Engineers for the resultant vacancy at Bhopal on March 1995. Therefore the Hon'ble Tribunal be pleased to direct the respondent that the case of the applicant be considered on priority basis in terms of O.M. dated 14.11.83 for his posting at Bhopal.

vii. That this application is made bonafide and for the cause of justice.

6. For the the establishment of the respondents totally ignored the guideline and instruction mentioned in O.Ml dated 14.12.83 in the matter of choice station posting and transfer.

8. Interim reliefs prayed for : -

During the pendence of this application the applicant prays for the following interim reliefs :

- i. That the respondent No. 2 be directed not to fill up the resultant vacancy in Division No. XII of C.G.P.B at Bhopal in the event of retirement of Sri R C Bakshi, Assistant Engineer, on superannuation on 28.2.95 till finalisation of this application.
- ii. That the respondents be directed to consider transfer and posting of the applicant in the C.G.P.B. Division No. XII at Bhopal on priority basis in terms of O.M. dated 14.12.83 inthe event of retirement of Sri R.C. Bakshi, Assistant Engineer, on superannuation on 28.2.95.

The above reliefs are prayed on the grounds explained in para 7 above.

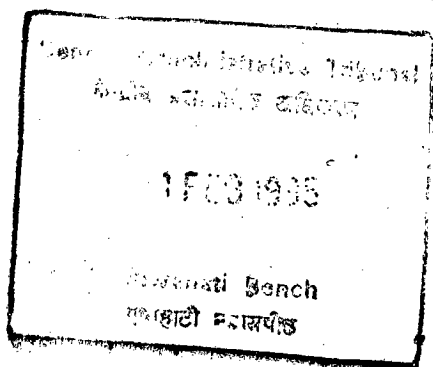
