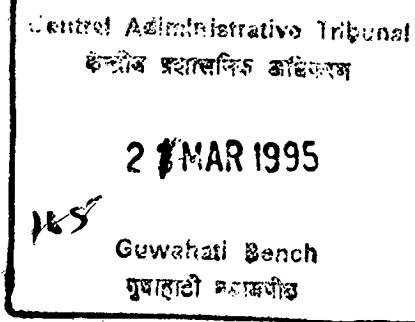

- (ii) passed by the authority and communicated by the Under Secretary to the Govt of India, Ministry of Agriculture (Department of Agriculture & Coopn) Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi.

5. Subject in brief :

- (a) That your applicant begs to state that he was appointed as Draftman in the Central Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Budni (M.P.) on 4.9.70.
- (b) That thereafter long long after his initial appointment he was promoted to the post of Technical Assistant in the said Institute and worked till 4.6.91 upto the full satisfaction of the authority concerned and also without any blemishes.



(c) That your applicant begs to state that the competent authority was again pleased to promote and appoint your petitioner as Assistant Engineer (Testing) on purely adhoc basis and posted at North Eastern Region Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Biswanath Chariali District Sonitpur (Assam) with effect from 4.6.91 and for a period upto 29.2.92 or until further orders whichever is earlier vide Notification No.9-18/90-MY(Admn) Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture dated September, 1991 and your petitioner was relieved of his duties from the Institute in the afternoon of 31.5.91 to take up his new assignment as Assistant Engineer (Testing) at North Eastern Region Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Biswanath Chariali, Sonitpur Assam after availing joining time.

(d) That your applicant begs to state that after completion of one year of service at Biswanath Chariali, Assam your petitioner submitted a representation on 11.5.92 requesting the authority to revert your petitioner to the post of Technical Assistant with parent department, i.e., Central Farm Machinery Training & Testing Institute,

Budni (M.P.) on the ground of his family troubles and ill health. But the competent authority without considering his aforesaid representation extended his service with effect from 1.3.92 to 28.2.93.

(e) That your applicant begs to state that he again submitted a representation on 29.1.93 to the competent authority for reversion to the post of Technical Assistant with the parent department at Budhi (M.P.) on the ground of ill health, ~~and~~ climatic condition and family troubles. But in reply to his representation the Director of the said Institute intimated your petitioner vide letter No.2-7 91 dtd 31.8.92 that his representation has been considered by the Ministry and as soon as a suitable substitute is selected his request for re-patriation will be reconsidered. But a considerable time has elapsed without any effect.

(f) That your applicant begs to state that on the recommendation of the D.P.C. (Group 'B') of the Department of Agril and Coopn held on 13.12.94, the Joint Secretary (Machinery) was pleased to promote and appoint your petitioner as Assistant

Engineer (Testing) on officiating promotion basis vide order No.6-8/93 MY9A dmn) dated 15.2.95, Govt. of India, Ministry of Agriculture and posted at Anantapur (A.P.) and communicated by the Under Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture, Department of Agriculture and Coopn, ignoring the representation submitted to the authority by your petitioner and letter No.2-7/01 dated 31.8.92 issued by the Director -(Annexure-V).

(g) That your applicant begs to state that while he was expecting of posting in the parent department - Central Farm Machinery Training & Testing Institute, Budni (M.P.) he has been transferred on officiating promotion basis as Assistant Engineer (Testing) to Anantapur (A.P.), inspite of several representations for transfer to the parent department at Budni (M.P.) on the grounds of ill health, climatic condition and family troubles.

6. Jurisdiction of the Tribunal :

The applicant declares that the subject matter of the order against which the petitioner wants redressal is within the jurisdiction of this Tribunal.

7. Limitation :

The applicant further declares that the application is within the period of limitation prescribed under Section 21 of the Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985.

8. Facts of the case :

(I) That your petitioner begs to state that he was appointed as Draftman in the Central Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Budhni (M.P.) and after rendering faithful and sincere service to the Institute without any blemish and he was promoted to the post of Technical Assistant in the said Institute and worked till 4.6.91.

(II) That your petitioner begs to state that he was again transferred and posted as Assistant Engineer (Testing) on purely adhoc basis at North Eastern Region Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Biswanath Chariali District Sonitpur, Assam for a period upto 29.2.92 or until further orders whichever is earlier vide Notification No.9-18/90-MY(Admn)

Govt of India, Ministry of Agriculture dated September, 1991 and accordingly he was relieved of his duties from the Institute on 31.5.91 to join his new assignment as Assistant Engineer (Testing) at North Eastern Region Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Biswanath Chariali, District Sonitpur, Assam after availing the joining time.

(III) That after the completion of one year of service at Biswanath Chariali Assam, the petitioner submitted a representation on 11.5.92 requesting the authority to revert him to the post of Technical Assistant to the parent Department, Central Farm Machinery Training and Testing Institute, Budni (M.P.). But the competent authority without considering the petitioners representation extended his service w.e.f. 1.3.92 to 28.2.93.

(IV) That your petitioner again submitted representation on 29.1.93 and 25.10.93 supported by medical certificate to the competent authority for reversion to the post of Technical Assistant

to the parent department Budni (M.P) on the ground of ill health, climatic condition and family troubles. But in reply to my representation the Director of the said institution intimated your petitioner that vide letter No. 2-7/91 dated 31.8.92-PF that his representation has been under consideration by the Ministry and as soon as a suitable substitute is selected, his request for repatriation will be reconsidered. But a considerable time has elapsed without any effect.

( V) That your petitioner begs to state that on the recommendation of the D.P.C. (Group 'B') of the Department of Agri and Coopn. held on 13.12.94 the Competent authority was pleased to promote and appoint your petitioner as Asstt. Engineer (Testing) vide order No. 6-8/93 MY (Admn) dated 15.2.95 and posted at Anantapur (AP).

( VI) That in connection with the matter stated above your petitioner begs to state that before the D.P.C. was held on 13.12.94 your petitioner submitted several representations before the Competent authority requesting for reversion to the parent department to the post of Technical Assistant at C.F.M. & T.I., Tractor Nagar, Budni (MP) vide letter dated 25.10.93,

District Sonitpur, Assam - Respondent No. 1 for redressal as regards transfer to the parent department - Central Farm Machinery Training & Testing Institute, Budni (MP) (Choice of place) as per Rule, but no relief is given to the applicant till date.

11. Matter not previously filed or pending with any other Court :

The applicant/petitioner declares that he has not filed any application, writ petition or suit before any Court of law or any other authority.

12. Relief sought :

In view of the facts and circumstances stated above at paragraphs 3, 4 and 7, the petitioner pray for the following reliefs :-

- I) To direct the authority to consider his representation/appeal and post him to a place of his choice as mentioned in the Representation.
- II) To restrain the authority from giving effect to the impugned transfer order No. 6-8/93-MY(Admn), Govt. of India, Ministry of Agriculture (Deptt. of Agriculture & Coopn.) dated 15.2.93 till the disposal of the representation.

III) To any other relief or reliefs to which the applicant is legally entitled under law and equity may also be granted.

13. Grounds for Relief :

I) That the authority concerned has passed the impugned order of transfer without taking into consideration the several representations filed by the applicant for posting him in a place of his choice on the ground of his ill health, climatic condition and family troubles supported by medical certificate.

II) That as per provisions laid down under F.R. & S.R. Rule 8 and 9, the applicant is legally entitled to claim for posting him in a place of his choice. The appellant has already completed 21 years of service and also completed four years of service working in the North Eastern Region. The authority concerned while passing the transfer order has completely overlooked the said aspect of the matter.

III) That the applicant by submitting representations after representations made out valid and sufficient grounds for posting him.....



Sir,

Respectfully I am to submit that I was appointed to the post of Assistant Engineer (Testing) on purely adhoc basis at North Eastern Region Farm Machinery Training & Testing Institute, Biswanath Chariali (Assam) w.e.f. 4.6.91 vide Ministry's order No. 9-18/90-MY (Adm.) dated Sept. '91 for a period of one year or upto 29.2.92 whichever is earlier. Although the Ministry has extended the term of my adhoc appointment for another one year w.e.f. 1.3.92 to 28.2.93 but due to the circumstances prevailing at my native place including Budni where my family members are residing at present, I am unable to continue here for further period. I am submitting hereunder few points for perusal and sympathetic consideration of my case.

1. The climate of this area does not suit to my health and I am always ailing with one or other disease.
2. My father is of such old age and requires my presence near to him. In addition to this, I have to look after my family affairs.
3. My two children are studying in Secondary classes & requires my presence to guide them in their study. Both the children have lessened the position of their marks after my joining here.
4. My wife is also a B.P. patient and always requires my presence to manage her treatment from time to time.

It is, therefore, requested that my case may kindly be considered sympathetically and pass the order for my reversion from this Institute to the post of Technical Assistant at Central Farm Machinery Training & Testing Institute, Budni, (M.P.) as early as possible.





Period of leave, training, etc., in excess of 15 days per year will be excluded in counting the tenure period. However, the period may be extended in exceptional cases in exigencies of public service or when the employee concerned is prepared to stay longer. Deputation allowance will be admissible during the extended period also.

**9. Station of choice on completion of tenure.**—On completion of the fixed tenure, officers may be considered for posting to a station of their choice as far as possible.

**10. Weightage for promotion, etc.**—Eligible officers shall be given due recognition in the matter of—

- (a) promotion in cadre posts;
- (b) deputation to Central tenure posts; and
- (c) courses of training abroad.

The general requirement of at least three years' service in a cadre post between two Central tenure deputations may be relaxed to two years in cases of meritorious service.

**11. Entry in CR**—A specific entry shall be made in the CR of all employees who render a full tenure of service.
