The applicant shall also be entitled to interest 8% for delayed payment counting from his date of superannuation till the date of actual payment. No costs.”

2. Today when this matter was taken up, it was admitted by the parties that the order stands complied with and the petitioner has received payment of interest granted by this order as well.

3. In view of the aforesaid, this CP is closed and the notices issued to the alleged contemnors are discharged.
