Heard. A similar order as in this case has been passed earlier also in OA.No.361/2014 which went to the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka and vide order in WP.No.200807/2016 dated 20.9.2016 the Hon'ble High Court upheld that order. The same position is obtainable here also. The Hon'ble High Court clearly made in paragraph 6 of the judgement that the contention advanced by the applicant/respondents herein that the appointment for the post of Post Man and Postal Assistant were not by direct recruitment, were by promotion. The court held that the court is unable to appreciate this contention and explained it in detail. We are in respectful agreement with it. Therefore, the Review application lacks merit. Review application is dismissed. No order as to costs.
