

Applicant has challenged the inaction on the part of respondents in not considering her case for appointment on compassionate ground. Applicant's husband late Shri Mangal Das died in harness on 1.8.98 while working as Clerk in the office of Director of Account (Postal). She has been informed vide letter dated 25.7.2001 that there is no vacancy in the department for appointment on compassionate grounds and her case has been recommended for appointment in other departments of Govt. of India. It is further stated in that letter applicant would be informed immediately when any information is received from other departments for her appointment. However, no final decision has been taken by the department so far.
