respondents in not implementing the orders passed by the


Tribunal in OA 184/2003 on 4.5.2004.

3. Although, it is submitted that the judgment is in rem and even a third person similarly situated can come up with a contempt petition, we are not convinced about its relevance or sustainability. Applicant is not within his rights, according to us, to file this contempt application. Application is dismissed. MAs also stand disposed of.
